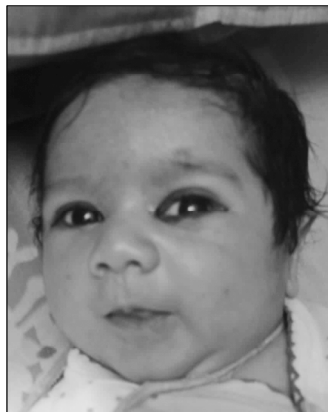

BAISAKHI CELEBRATIONS BY MOHYAL SABHA JALANDHAR

Mahila Wing of Jalandhar Mohyal Sabha celebrated Baisakhi on the eve of 13th April 2023 at Bhawan with great pomp and show and festival fervour. All the ladies and children came dressed in traditional Punjabi attire.



Smt Vandana Chhibber, Acting Convener of the wing welcomed all the participants with Baisakhi greetings and good wishes. Ms Vandana, Ms Sangeeta and Ms Vishakha made elaborate arrangements to make the function highly graceful. Heritage articles like earthen Kujja filled with Wheat Sitta, Brass utensils Pateela & Baalti and Chhajj so beautifully decorated were nicely displayed to reflect true Festival spirit. Ms Vandana requested the senior members Smt Kamla Vaid, wife of Shri Nand Lal Vaid and Smt Geeta Bali, wife of Shri G K Bali to occupy the stage.

At the outset she requested Smt Bali to come and bless the gathering. Smt Bali blessed the members with greetings and requested them to whole heartedly enjoy the evening. She explained the relevance of this Punjab Festival Baisakhi stating that Shri Guru Gobind Rai formed Khalsa Panth on this day 13th of April 1699. There was a large gathering of men and women at Takht Shri Keshgarh at Anandpur Sahab. Guru Ji came out of a tent with a sword in his hand and invited five men to the tent who would sacrifice their lives for Dharam and Nation. Five men of different castes and from different parts of Country followed the Guru into that tent. They were:

- A Baniya Daya Ram from Lahore
- A Jat Dharam Dass from Meerut Uttar Pradesh
- A water carrier Himmat Rai from Jagannath Puri Odisha
- A Tailor Mohkam Chand from Dwarika Gujarat
- A Barber Sahib Chand from Bidar Karnataka

After a while Guru Ji came out of the tent holding his sword soaked in blood. All were stunned to see this. Soon after that all the five men came out wearing turbans on their

heads to the surprise of the gathering. Guruji named the five men as Panj Piare adding suffix Singh to their names and made them to drink the holy water (Amrit Chhakna). Guru Ji added the suffix Singh to his name also and became Guru Gobind Singh from that time. And that was the birth of Khalsa. This was the greatest example of National Integration visualised by Guru Ji.

Smt Bali also told that on this day the farmers thank God for their plentiful yield and further pray for good harvest next season. Celebrations of Baisakhi include Dhol Beats, Giddha, Bhangra, Bollian, Tappey and Punjabi Folk Songs. Smt Bali also remembered the sacrifice of martyrs of Jallianwala Bag Amritsar who were brutally killed at the instance of British on 13 April 1919. Floral tributes were paid to them and silence of one minute was observed by all in their memory.

Smt Kamla Vaid also blessed the gathering with her energetic words. She motivated the gathering with a message to celebrate our traditions and heritage in full swing so that our younger generation also gets attached with the Sabha.

All the participants including Ms Sangeeta Mohan, Smt Neena Mehta, Smt Vishakha Dutta, Smt Anu Chhibber, Smt Komal Dutta and Acting Convener Smt Vandana Chhibber gave their superb performance in Giddha, Bollian, Tappey etc. All the members present cheered the participants with clapping and whistling.

Miss Himani Dutta a young girl regaled the audience with her scintillating dance performance on the occasion. Thereafter, Shri G K Bali was invited to say a few words. Shri Bali thanked the gathering and blessed them for making the function a grand success. MOHYAL HISTORY

History is a very important and strong foundation of a country or society on which a country or society can make its prosperous present and bright future. History is not a study of past but it is a study of change. Our present is shaped by our past. We can't change our past but can learn from the mistakes of past and can make a good road map for future. As far as the Mohyal History is concerned our ancestors tried to trace our roots and history time to time.

In the first decade of twentieth century Raizada Ratan Chand Vaid wrote *Islah-e- Mohyali*, it was in Urdu. At the same time Bakshi Ram Das Chhibber, a great Mohyal philanthropist with the consultation of other Mohyal eminent leaders of that time, felt the need of a systematically written history of Mohyals. At that time it was not easy for an Indian to consult Govt records as source material for writing their history. So as Bakshi Ram Das Chhibber was Urdu teacher to British Viceroys and high British officials, he approached a British officer Mr. T.Russll Stracey for writing our history on the basis of authentic sources. This way first Mohyal history came to light in 1911. This book is still considered as the most reliable account of our community. Some other Mohyal scholars also published their own versions of Mohyal history and worked hard for collecting research material for writing Mohyal history but many of them could not reach to our community. After Partition Late Shri P N Bali Ji, one of the stalwarts and strong pillar of our community published Mohyal History after deep research and hard work. We can name this work as an encyclopedia of Mohyals. In this book he has covered Ancient, Medieval and Modern period till the end of that century and who's who of Mohyals in detail.

Now it is a matter of great pleasure and proud that when we are celebrating the Amrit Mahotsava Kaal, the 75th anniversary of our freedom, our GMS, under the leadership of our President Shri Vinod Dutt has decided to start work on writing the Post Independence or Post Partition History of Mohyals. I personally feel that for this work Oral History is the most valuable source. We have living histories in each and every family of our community. Senior members of our families, who witnessed the disastrous Partition of India, can narrate their reminiscences about the partition of India, post partition struggle of Community and social changes which they observed. They can also narrate the chilly accounts of horrible migrations and rehabilitation. This is the valuable history which no Archive can provide us. Restructuring the fabric of community, and building of the great Institutions as Ashrams and educational Institutions was not a easy task. So we should also have a history of these Institutions as how this idea to build Ashrams and Educational Institutions were conceived, people involved in construction and anecdotes about that era. As Mark Twain once said "India is the mother of history, grandmother of legends and great grandmother of traditions".

After Partition we had to leave our mother land, our community migrated to different parts of free India. With this migration we lost our original language, traditions, folk songs and proverbs which were very common in our old social system. We should also trace our customs on the occasion of birth of a child in the family and other Sanskars, marriages, and on the last journey of a Mohyal. We can only follow our customs when we know it. Senior members of the families who used to give directions about our customs are going now. So we must record an account of our customs. This is a part of our cultural heritage. We should also preserve them for future generations. Apart from that our local Mohyal Sabhas played a very important role in unifying our community, so we would also like to trace their histories.

I appeal to each and every member of our community in India or abroad, if you have a family member who has good memories, please talk to them, write their reminiscences and send it to GMS. If you have other private papers of eminent Mohyal personalities, photographs, or any material of historical value, please send it to GMS so that with a collective effort and combined wisdom we can accomplish this work for future generations. MOHYAL BHAWAN INDERPURI

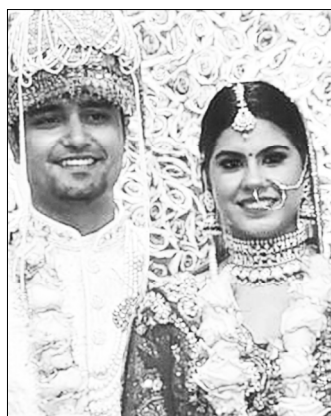

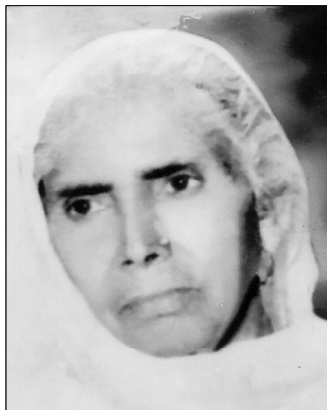

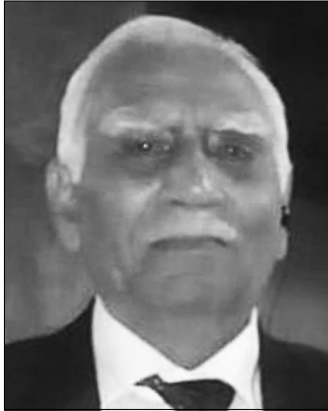

The forms duly filled should reach the GMS Secretariat, if not already done.

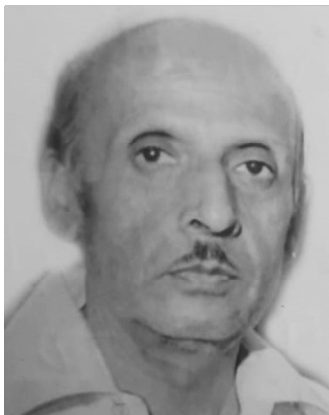

MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatri's, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after full payment of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran .
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dining Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
14. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar, is available only to yatri's staying in the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Yatri's and No other activity is permitted.
18. In case of any inconvenience, Yatri's are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / Office bearer of GMS. Yatri's are requested to fill the feedback form before their departure.
19. Yatri's are requested to help in keeping the rooms and the premises of the Ashram clean. Yatri's are also requested to maintain decorum, while dealing with the staff posted at the Ashrams.
20. Yatri's are requested to follow Covid 19 guidelines as per existing orders of the local government authorities.

इतिहास की ओर

आजादी के बाद स्वर्गीय श्री पी.एन. बाली ने अपने अथक परिश्रम और शोध के बाद मोहयाल हिस्ट्री लिखी जिसे मोहयाल विश्वकोष कहा जा सकता है। इसमें वैदिक काल से 2000 तक का इतिहास बड़े विस्तृत रूप से प्रस्तुत किया है।

इसके अतिरिक्त उस वक्त की और भी कोई ऐतिहासिक सामग्री जैसे उस वक्त की चिट्ठियाँ या कागजात या फोटो यदि उनके पास हों तो हमें भेजें। स्थानीय मोहयाल सभाओं के अध्यक्षों से भी अनुरोध है कि अपनी सभाओं के इतिहास की जानकारी दें। वे लोग जिन्होंने मोहयाल संस्थाओं को बनाने में सक्रिय भाग लिया है, अपने संस्मरण लिखकर भेजें। इसके साथ ही मोहयाल रीति-रिवाज, परंपराएं, जो जन्म से मृत्यु तक हमें बांधती हैं, को हम अपनी सांस्कृतिक विरासत का हिस्सा बनाना चाहते हैं। हमारे लोकगीत, कविता, मुहावरे जो हमारे परिवारों में बुजुर्ग अक्सर कहते थे, वो भी हमारे इतिहास का हिस्सा है जिन्हें हम संजो कर रखना चाहते हैं तो इस इतिहास लेखन में सबके सहयोग से स्रोतों का उपयोग करते हुए अपने आजाद इतिहास को लिखने का प्रयास करेंगे। कृपया इसमें हमारा सहयोग करें।

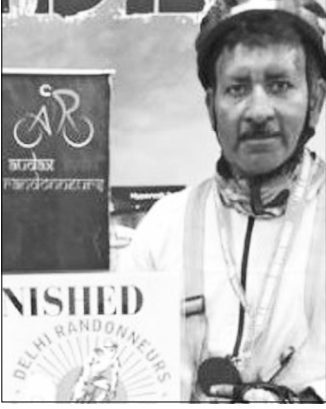

विदित रहे कि एस आर टाइटल के लिए पहले ऑडेक्स इंडिया में रजिस्टर करना होता है। उसके बाद अलग-अलग निर्धारित दिनों में 13.5 घंटे में 200, 20 घंटे में 300, 27 घंटे में 400 और 40 घंटे में 600 किलोमीटर की राइड करनी होती है, तब जाकर एस आर का टाइटल मिलता है।

जिसमें भारत रत्न भारत का सर्वोच्च नागरिक सम्मान है। जिसकी स्थापना 2 जनवरी 1954 में तत्कालीन माननीय राष्ट्रपति श्री राजेंद्र प्रसाद जी ने की थी। जिसे राष्ट्रीय सेवाओं के लिए दिया जाता है। जिनमें कला, साहित्य एवं संस्कृति, विज्ञान, खेल, सार्वजनिक सेवा इत्यादि प्रमुख हैं। यह सम्मान एक वर्ष में अधिकतम तीन व्यक्तियों को ही दिया जा सकता है।

परमवीर चक्र भारत का सर्वोच्च सैन्य पुरस्कार है। जिसे शत्रु की उपस्थिति में अर्थात् युद्ध में उच्चतम शिखर की शूरवीरता और त्याग के लिए दिया जाता है। इस पुरस्कार की स्थापना 26 जनवरी 1950 को की गई थी। जिसके लिए भारतीय सेना के तीनों अंगों अर्थात् जल, थल एवं वायु सेना का कोई भी कर्मचारी या अधिकारी इस सम्मान को प्राप्त करने का पात्र होता है। यह देश के सर्वोच्च नागरिक सम्मान भारत रत्न के बाद सबसे प्रतिष्ठित पुरस्कार माना जाता है।

साहित्य के क्षेत्र में भारतीय ज्ञानपीठ न्यास द्वारा भारतीय साहित्य के विकास के लिए दिया जाने वाला ज्ञानपीठ सम्मान सर्वोच्च सम्मान होता है। जिसके लिए भारत का कोई भी नागरिक जो आठवीं अनुसूची में सम्मिलित समस्त भाषाओं में से किसी भी भाषा में लिखता हो उक्त सम्मान के योग्य अर्थात् पात्र होता है। जिसमें ग्यारह लाख रुपए सहित प्रशस्तिपत्र और वाग्देवी की कांस्य प्रतिमा दी जाती है।

उपरोक्त सम्मानों की श्रृंखला में भारत रत्न के उपरांत पद्म सम्मान आते हैं। जिन्हें तीन श्रेणियों अर्थात् पद्म विभूषण, पद्म भूषण और पद्म श्री में बांटा गया है। जिनकी स्थापना भी 2 जनवरी 1954 में तत्कालीन माननीय राष्ट्रपति श्री राजेंद्र प्रसाद जी की थी। जो निम्नलिखित है:

(1) पद्म विभूषण: यह पुरस्कार उन विशेष महानुभावों को दिया जाता है जिन्होंने किसी क्षेत्र में विशिष्ट कार्य कर प्रसिद्धि पाई होती है।

(2) पद्म भूषण: यह सम्मान भी उन विशेष महानुभावों को दिया जाता है जिन्होंने किसी क्षेत्र में विशेष कार्य किया होता

है और प्रसिद्धि प्राप्त की होती है। यह सम्मान कला, विज्ञान, साहित्य, खेल, शिक्षा, सामाजिक कार्य, औषधि इत्यादि किसी भी क्षेत्र में किसी व्यक्ति ने अपने व्यक्तित्व से कृतित्व पर कोई विशेष उपलब्धि प्राप्त की होती है, तो वो इस पुरस्कार के लिए योग्य माना जाता है।

(3) पद्मश्री: यह पुरस्कार उपरोक्त पुरस्कारों से निम्न स्तर का सम्मान होता है। जिसमें किसी क्षेत्र में किसी व्यक्ति द्वारा प्राप्त उपलब्धियों के लिए ये पुरस्कार प्रदान किया जाता है। जिसके लिए प्रतिवर्ष 120 नागरिकों को उक्त सम्मान से सम्मानित किया जा सकता है। जिनके नाम भारत के राजपत्र में प्रकाशित किए जाते हैं और यह निर्देश भी दिया जाता है कि वह अपने नाम के पहले अथवा नाम के बाद "पद्मश्री" नहीं लगा सकते हैं।

उल्लेखनीय है कि माननीय राष्ट्रपति जी उपरोक्त लाभार्थियों का नाम भविष्य में कभी भी किसी भी समय किसी भी अनुचित कार्य में लिप्त होने पर रद्द कर सकते हैं। जिसके आधार पर उक्त "सम्मान" सम्मान प्राप्तकर्ताओं के लिए कांटों का वह राजमुकुट बन जाता है जिस पर उपरोक्त लाभार्थियों को अपने भविष्य के जीवनकाल में इतनी सतर्कता बरतनी पड़ती है। अर्थात् उन्हें जीवन भर उक्त सम्मान के सम्मान हेतु संवैधानिक मौलिक कर्तव्यों को निष्ठापूर्वक करने के अलावा कुछ नहीं सूझता। वह असंवैधानिक कृत्यों अर्थात् भ्रष्टाचार तो क्या भ्रष्टाचारियों की छाया से भी दूर रहने के प्रति वचनबद्ध रहते हैं और उन्हें प्राथमिकता के आधार पर स्वार्थी तत्वों एवं भ्रष्टाचारियों से सदैव दूरी बनाए भी रखनी चाहिए। क्योंकि यदि उनका नाम किसी भी अनुचित कार्य में लिप्त होने पर न्यायालय में प्रमाणित हो जाता है तो सर्वप्रथम उनका नाम भारत राजपत्र से रद्द कर दिया जाएगा और दिया गया सम्मान वापस ले लिया जाएगा। जिससे उनका सम्मानित व्यक्तित्व अपमानित व्यक्तित्व में परिवर्तित हो जाएगा।

अतः उपरोक्त सम्मान प्राप्तकर्ताओं को राष्ट्र के राष्ट्रीय प्रहरी कहना अतिशयोक्ति नहीं होगा। चूँकि उन्हें देश का प्रथम नागरिक अर्थात् माननीय राष्ट्रपति जी सम्मानित करते हैं। जिनके बाद चुन्नु-मुन्नुओं द्वारा आयोजित सम्मानित समारोहों का कोई महत्व नहीं रहता। जिनसे बचकर उन्हें स्वार्थी एवं भ्रष्टाचारियों से दूरी बनाते हुए अपने शेष जीवन में नागरिकों के प्रति उत्तरदायित्व निभाते हुए संविधान के प्रति सदैव निष्ठा एवं कृतज्ञतापूर्वक संवैधानिक मौलिक कर्तव्यों का निर्वहन कर जीवनयापन करना चाहिए।

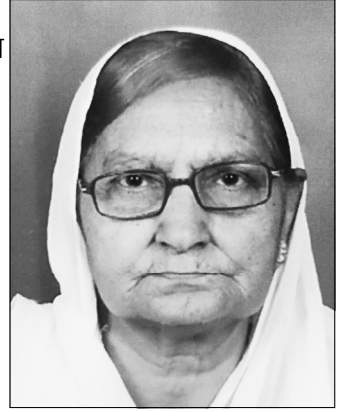

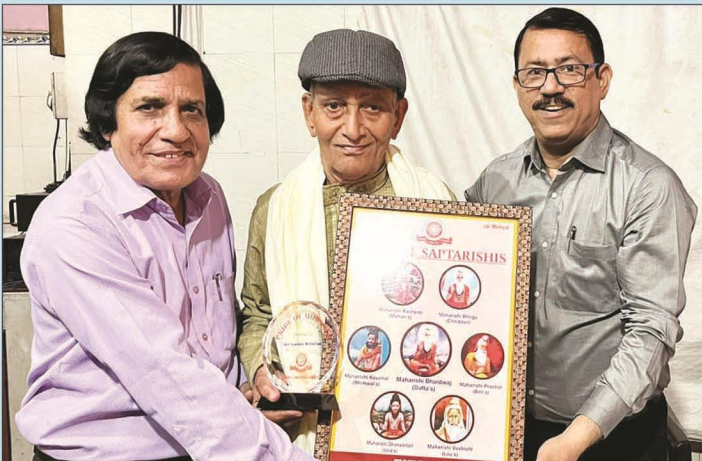

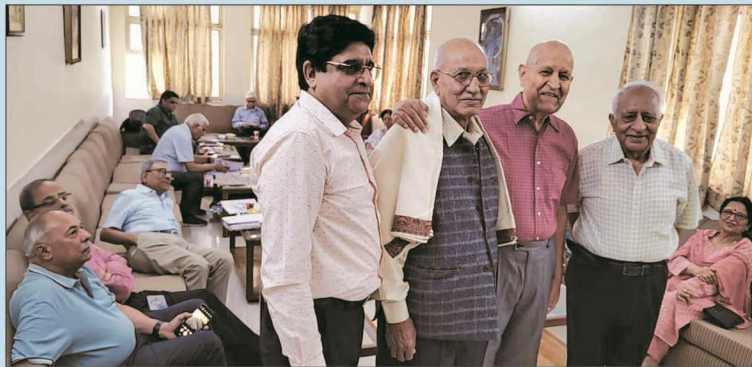
