## National Symposium on "Big Data Analytics"

MERIT organized a two-day National Symposium on Big Data Analytics, at Mohyal Foundation, New Delhi, on July 6-7, 2017. The inaugural function on the 6<sup>th</sup> July 2017 was presided over by Rzd. B. D. Bali, President, GMS. The event commenced with the lighting of the traditional lamp by Rzd. B.D. Bali, Prof. K.K. Aggarwal and other dignitaries, followed by presentation of bouquets to them.

In his welcome address, Shri S Ranganathan, Chief Administrative Officer of MERIT, broadly defined what exactly was Big Data, in layman's language, and why the topic of the Symposium, i.e., Big



Data Analytics, was relevant in the present context. He especially stressed the need for security of the data, both at the individual as well as at the country levels. In this connection, he narrated as to how he, himself, and the Director, MERIT, were victims of credit card fraud in separate instances, recently. The incident where the website of Qatar was compromised leading to that country being isolated by other Arab nations was also touched upon. These incidents underlined the urgent necessity of having not only foolproof cyber security, but also the strict implementation of the laws framed.

After the welcome address, Dr. Rattan K Datta, Director, MERIT, introduced each of the dignitaries seated on the dais and gave a brief overview of the programme content of the Symposium. Mr. P.K. Dutta, Mr. B.L. Chhibber, Lt. Gen. G.L. Bakshi (Retd), Mr. Lalit Sawhney & Prof. V.P. Saxena then addressed the audience and shared their views on the topic of the Symposium. Thereafter, Prof. K.K. Aggarwal delivered the Inaugural address, followed by the Presidential address, by Rzd. B.D. Bali. The Key Note Address, in the form of an Audio-Video presentation, on 'Big Data Analytics', was then made by Prof. M.M. Pant, in absentia, which was well-received and appreciated by all present.

The inaugural function concluded with the vote of thanks by Ms. Ritika Jasrotia, followed by tea break. After the tea break, a Keynote Address was delivered by Prof. V.P. Saxena, chaired by Shri. Lalit Sawhney, followed by lunch. In the post-lunch session, a Keynote Address was delivered by Prof. K.R. Paradasani, chaired by Prof. V.P. Saxena. Papers were presented by Ms. Urvashi Sharma & Ms. Kamaldeep Kaur. This was followed by a Panel Discussion in which Prof. V.P. Saxena, Prof. K.R. Paradasani, Dr. Kavita Pabreja and Dr. V.H. Pradhan & Dr. Rattan K Datta participated. The panel unanimously concluded that all will extend their support for starting a course on Big Data Analytics in MERIT.

On the second day of the Symposium, i.e., the 7<sup>th</sup> July 2017, Shri Suresh Mehta chaired the pre-lunch session, when Dr. Kavita Pabreja delivered the Keynote Address, followed by paper presentations by Prof. Neetu Narwal and Ms. Ritika Jasrotia. ## MOHYALS A VIBRANT COMMUNITY KNOWN FOR PRODUCING EXCELLENT LEADERS FOR THE DEFENCE FORCES

The Mohyals are known for their convivial and lively disposition. They stand out in any gathering, often dominating the proceedings without being abrasive or over bearing. Hence, they come across as natural leaders and are accepted as such. In most situations, they naturally take charge, and willingly accept responsibility. They are also known for loyalty and dependability. A personable people, they hold their head high and exude marked self esteem. These qualities of head and heart make them ideal material for positions of responsibility and authority in a society. They excel as government officials and civil servants. Above all, they stand out as excellent 'officer material' for the armed forces and police, ie for positions demanding character, leadership, and a flair for handling situations involving an element of risk and danger.

Mohyal officers feature prominently in our defence forces and police. Vast numbers apart, the honour rolls are packed with names of high ranking officers. Even so, it would be safe to hazard a guess that, we would have had thousands of officers overall, and a very large number in the senior ranks. Currently and in the recent past, for instance, we can count more than 25 three star generals, including at least three army commanders (including one near miss as the Chief). From the ranks of Colonels to Brigadiers to Major Generals, there must be many hundreds of numbers. This is a very impressive achievement for a small community. Such prominent numbers have been achieved without a conscious or concerted effort on the part of the community, but only by a natural process of individual excellence. It is my conviction based upon nearly forty years of service that the Mohyals are capable of appreciably multiplying these numbers, only if we were to make a deliberate and targeted effort at the level of the community, and so prepare more of our youth for a career in the armed forces and that it can be done. The material is there, we only have to identify the boys and then train them to make the grade. It will raise the standards and lives of thousands of Mohyal families, particularly in the villages and some of our diaspora reduced to penury consequent upon the tragedy of the Partition in 1947.

We have done a lot for our community in the cities by way of welfare measures for the needy widows etc. We have done a lot to revive the identity of the community and to revive the mohyali spirit. Every issue of the Mohyal Mitter is ablaze with pictures of get-togethers and functions at GMS and outlying Sabhas as also of activity concerning the educational prowess of our boys and girls. I remember the recent concourse celebrating the 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the 'Stapna' of our community, which was superbly conceived and organized by the GMS and the Talkatora Stadium resounded with shouts of 'Jai Mohyal'. It was hard to imagine that the same community had shown such remarkable resilience after having being shattered by the holocaust of Partition. It show-cased the excellent work done by the GMS and others Sabhas. So far so good, but a lot remains to be done for our scattered communities in the interior, many living in straitened circumstances, subsisting on small holdings, and lack of employment in the rural areas. The opportunity to serve as an officer should be welcome to them. Indeed, it would also benefit our boys in the cities despite the pulls of corporate world. In any case, in Delhi and other big towns, there is intense competition in academic and the IT world where the big ticket jobs are. So unless a boy is at least a 95 percenter, it would be wise for the parents to head their children towards the armed forces.

Often lack of knowledge and zero / negative motivation at parental level or peer pressure, prove to be the dissuasive factors. In my time, a career in the services was considered honourable and prestigious. Now the lexicon driving the younger generation is that of, "compensation packages", "promotion policy", "stock options" and the like. Old world values of "honour, Izzat o Iqbal and patriotism", are passe. This kind of wrong thinking is often at the root of unemployment and frustration amongst our youth. Whereas, the fact is that mohyal boys are cut out for a role in the armed services by temperament, natural inclination and leadership qualities. They take to it like duck taking to water. They thrive in this millieu, earning recognition and high ranks. I think there is need for positive propoganda and encouragement at all levels to increase the numbers. There is need to educate our boys regarding the dates of selection events and requisite qualifications pertaining to different categories. Quite possibly we would have some serving or retired mohyal officers who have served at the selection boards and are conversant with the system. If so, we should locate and coopt such officers for help and guidance , ideally to be made incharge of the project to prepare the new hopefuls . Special effort will be needed to reach out to our boys in the villages. I am confident that a well organized effort and cooperation from all, will produce results. It will be a win-win situation for all ,our boys , the services and the community and what is more, we would have done meaningful welfare work for the Biradari.
