Sdr Avtar Singh Datta and Smt Amrit Kaur Datta, Rohini, Delhi, donated Rs 50,00,000/- (Rs Fifty Lacs) to General Mohyal Sabha (Regd.) for construction of additional rooms at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar (Beant Sunder Viram Niwas). Sdr Avtar Singh Datta was born on 26 Oct 1935 at Chak 370, Ghaniya Singhan, Gojra, District Layalpur (now in Pakistan). His great grandfather, Sdr Bhadur Amar Singh Datta was allotted 10 Murabas of land in Gojra (one muraba = 25 acres), for his gallantry action in second Afghan war as VCO in Fifth Punjab Cavalry.

Sdr Sunder Singh Datta was son of late Sdr Sant Singh Datta, grandson of late Sdr Bhadur and Risaldar Amar Singh of Virum Dattan. He was married to Smt Beant Kaur Datta, daughter of late Bakshi Bhagwan Das Chhibber of Kotla Rawali Khan, Distt. Gujarat. When pre partition disturbances in Gujarat in Pakistan started, Sdr Sunder Singh Datta alongwith his younger brother Sdr Sohan Singh Datta had left his home in Lahore on 4 August 1947 and had gone to Kotla to find out about the welfare of his brother in law, late Bakshi Ram Lubhaya Chhibber.

In the mean while, situation at Lahore also became very tense and the families of both brothers staying at Mohini Road were shifted to Kila Gujjar Singh, Police Lines, Lahore on 8 August 1947 by their cousin Shri Dilbag Singh Dutta, who was in the Police. Both brothers never came back to join their families. The families were evacuated to India on 16 August 47. It was later learnt that both brothers had come back to Lahore on 13 August 1947, while their families were at Kila Gujjar Singh, and Muslims killed both of them. They left behind two young widows and small children.

Smt Beant Kaur, 38 years old widow of Sdr Sunder Singh Datta, fighting against all odds with immense courage, élan and dignity brought up her five small children in true Mohyali Spirit. She died on 30 November 1997. When Sdr Sunder Singh Datta was killed, the whereabouts of his eldest son late Kuldip Singh Dutta were not known. He being an activist was arrested and was repatriated with other prisoners. Sdr Avtar Singh Datta was just 12 years old. From the devastation of partition he rose from the ashes like phoenix and excelled himself, as a publisher and bookseller. He had established prestigious Datta Book Center at Bungalow Road, Delhi University, and is residing at 243, Plot No. 40, Sector 9, Rohini Delhi. His other siblings were two sisters and one younger brother, late Smt Santosh Bali, Smt Kamla Mehta and Col P S Dutta. He is married to Smt Amrit Kaur and is blessed with daughter Smt Arvind Kaur Datta, wife of Sdr Khushwant Singh and son Sdr Karanpreet Singh.

MOHYAL YOUTH CAMP 2022

General Mohyal Sabha organized a Youth Camp 2022 at Amritsar, which was held from, 25 November 2022 to 27 November 2022. The Youth Camp was generously organized with the help of our patrons, the GMS managing committee, and the wholehearted support and organizational help of Mohyal Sabha Amritsar led by Shri Devender Vaid and Shri Raj Bakshi. The youth camp was attended by more than 180 youth and their guardians coming from all over the country. We had people attending from the neighboring cities of Jalandhar and Ludhiana, all over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi/NCR, U.P. and to the northernmost parts of India like Rajouri and Poonch, J&K. It was truly an inspiring and hearing moment to see people from different walks of life coming together, discussing ideas of taking the community forward and celebrating the joy of being part of a welcoming community.

The GMS recognizes the need for youth engagement and facilitates their active involvement in the decision-making and organizational setup to further the noble cause of making the mohyalbaradari a healthy, forward, and wealthy community. Often leaders of the world say that the youth are the future leaders, but our office bearers at the GMS, in particular our Senior Vice President Shri P K Dutta Ji a contrary isa firm believer in the youth being leaders in making and for the same reasons this year's Youth Camp was themed "*Vibgyor Vibrant Youth*". That it truly was a rainbow in essence, because the youth of our baradari from different backgrounds, different careers, and different lifestyles all came together from a beautiful rainbow-like cheer and joy at the Youth Camp.

The core agenda of organizing this Youth Camp was to foster healthy and meaningful connections among the Youth and their guardians, coming from all over India. The camp would give a strong platform to the youth of our community to share among themselves their ideas about the welfare of the community and present the same to the GMS. The schedule for the Youth Camp was as broadly as follows, on the first day of the Camp the families and youths would congregate at two hotels booked by the organizing team for the camp, thereafter post lunch the group proceeds for an excursion at Attari-Wagah border to watch the famous Beating Retreat ceremony, after returning to the campsite, a cultural event had been planned and finally day one comes to an end with dinner. Day two would entail a Plenary or Business Session which would welcome formal discussions among the youth and presentations by them to the presiding members of the GMS, followed by free time for everyone to explore the city of Amritsar, followed by an evening of cultural activities.

The detailed synopsis of the youth camp along with the reports and findings of the Youth are as follows;

The first individuals and groups began coming at 8 am 25 November 2022 on the first day of the camp. They were greeted by Shri Ashwani Bakshi, Shri Vijyant Bali & Shri Manu Mehta along with other team members of the Organising committee. The families and individuals were then allotted rooms at one of the two hotels that were booked by the organizing committee to accommodate over

180 plus individuals attending the camp. The Hotels were located in central Amritsar near the famous Shivala. The groups and individuals coming in were served breakfast and given some time to freshen up. A lovely and warm lunch was then served to everyone and was thoroughly enjoyed and appreciated by everyone. Post lunch every one was rounded up in the central hall and informed of the schedule for the rest of the day. Everyone was made aware of certain rules and safety regulations observed at the Attari Border by the BSF so that they can seamlessly enter and exit the viewing ground. Three Luxurious Volvo buses then awaited everyone to take them to the border. At approximately about 3:30 PM, everyone reached the Attari-Wagah Border to witness the famous beating retreat ceremony. It was a sight to behold, the entire viewing ground was filled with flag-yielding children, adults, and young people, who cheered to the tunes of nationalist songs and calls of VandeMatram by the ceremony usher. It was an exhilarating experience and everyone was filled with pride, cheering the bold officers of the Border Security Forces performing their coordinated and amazing choreographed marches. The chants of VandeMatram and Bharat Mata ki Jai filled the entire viewing ground and elated the hearts of thousands of Indians gathered there. Finally, the ceremony came to end with the dowing of flags by Indian and Pakistani border forces as the dawn came closer. Everyone of us now filled with nationalist pride and enthusiasm returned to the camp venue and quickly freshened up to join the cultural activities planned for the evening. The evening began with Shri Manu Mehta, Secretary of Youth & Cultural Affairs, GMS welcomed everyone to the event and thanked one and all present for joining and being part of this amazing Youth Camp 2022. He briefly explained to everyone the agenda for the plenary session that was to happen the next morning and then swiftly pivoted to the lighter and more fun activities planned for the evening.

The festivities kicked off with a bang, as our little champs took over the stage. We all witnessed amazing performances, beginning with Ms. Kanishka Mohan, from Delhi setting the mood straight with her amazing dance performance. It all continued when Shri Sidk Bali gave an equally stark performance, performing on the beats of pop cultural Punjabi songs. Shri Yogesh Mehta Ji, Vice President, GMS was quickly swallowed by the mood set by our Lil champs and he took over the stage to sing for everyone a classical Bollywood number of Shri Raj Kapoor. The amazing performance was followed by an amazing dance number by Ms. Ananya Vaid, from Kurukshetra who made everyone groove along with her on the song "Nakhra Tera Ni". It was followed by a standup performance by Shri Vishal Mohan Mehta, from Jalandhar, followed by his lovely song numbers, Shri Vishal Mehta is a huge star with a following of thousands over various social media apps. 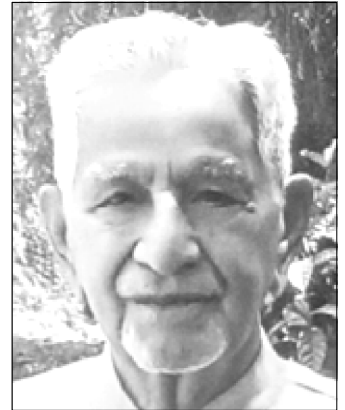

The outflow of loans advanced also fell down. There has been downfall in deposits. But now the things are improving slowly and we hope to achieve the desired levels soon. The Managing Committee report and audited balance sheet as on 31.03.2022 and income, expenditure

statement for FY 2021-2022 were read out and approved by the house unanimously. House also approved dividend @ 8% p.a. unanimously.

Society has already developed website and will share update to its members through adoption of Information Technology like SMS, Emails and shall initiate digital reach to its members. We offer attractive rate of interest of Fixed Deposits ranging from 6.5% to 9%p.a depending upon the period of maturity. Presently society is not accepting FDR term deposit due to lower demand of loan. However, fixed deposit under Monthly Income Scheme are being accepted from the senior citizen & widow members. The society is providing financial assistance of Ordinary/Regular loan upto Rs 2,00,000/- @13.2% P.A interest and emergency loan upto Rs. 20,000/-. The Society provides financial assistance of Rs 20,000/- on death of a member. Further on death of a member if loan is outstanding against him and he has been member of a society for the last 5 years, a sum upto Rs 20,000/- may be adjusted against loan. The member of the society has to contribute Rs 200/- yearly towards welfare fund and writes-off loan or bad debts in case of extreme compassion after approval of general body. A gift cheque of Rs 1100/- is given as Shagun to the son / self (male) and Rs 2100/- is given as Shagun to the daughter/self (female) member on her marriage. Students are given prizes worth Rs 1500/- to their parents who secure more than 80% marks in 10th and 12th standard examination. The society had introduced Sukanya Gift i.e to provide gift a cheque of Rs 25,000/- on birth of a girl child to member on attaining of the age of 18 years which is being discontinued. The amendment in Byelaws regarding Sukanya Gift Scheme was explained to the members and it was cleared that it is a long term scheme and difficult to operate. Hence it is being discontinued hence forth . The amount held shall be refunded to the beneficiaries. House approved the same unanimously. Thereafter cash awards to meritorious students namely 1. Parth Vaid, 2. Tushar Sharma, 3. Rathvic, 4. Vendansh Mehta, 5. Yash Mehta, 6. Taniya Katariya and 7. Yash Raj Vaid were given by the Chief Guest.

Further among any other point Secretary informed that the managing committee has found two cases of Shri Venkata Sasha Giri Rao and Shri John Korah Chandy where all efforts have been made by the society to recover the loan advanced to them but it could not be recovered and recommended for writing off their loan and closing their accounts as their whereabouts are not known. This has been unanimously approved. Shri P.K. Datta, Chief Guest spoke about the good work being carried on the management of the society. 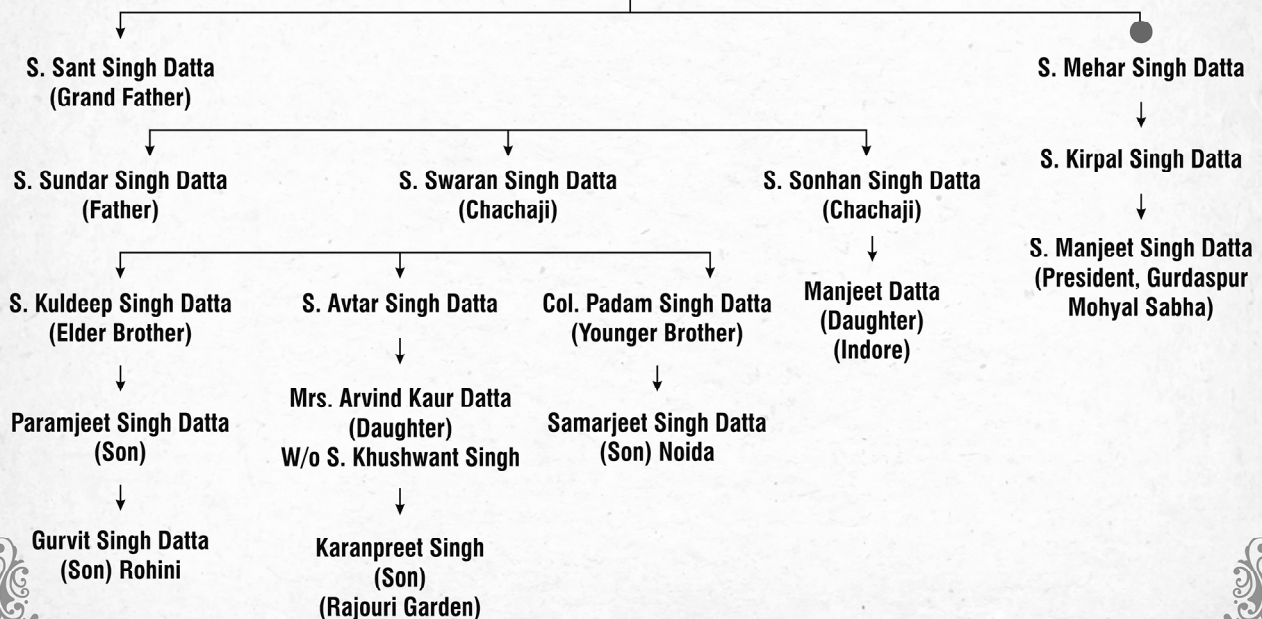

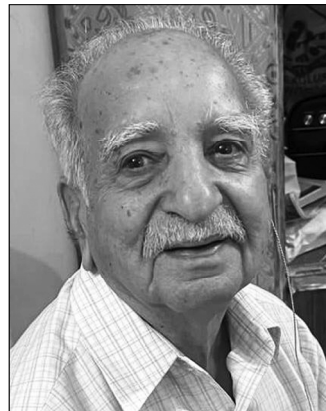

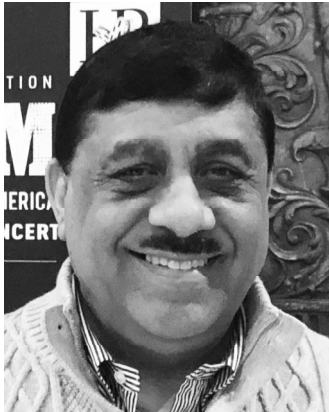
Smt Sharda Bali

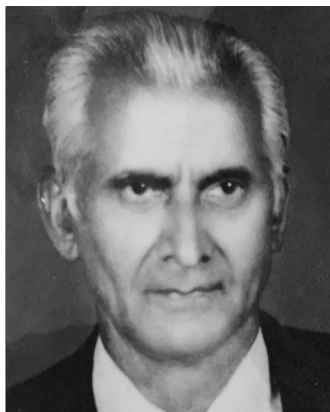

MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatris, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran .
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Online booking facility for rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar is not available. Rooms can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
14. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar, is available only to yatri's staying in the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Yatri's and NO other activity is permitted.
18. In case of any inconvenience, Yatri's are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / Office bearer of GMS. Yatri's are requested to fill the feedback form before their departure.
19. Yatri's are requested to help in keeping the rooms and the premises of the Ashram clean. Yatri's are also requested to maintain decorum, while dealing with the staff posted at the Ashrams.
20. Yatris are requested to follow Covid 19 guidelines as per existing orders of the local government authorities.
