A LEGEND PASSES AWAY



(16 July 1929 – 6 Jan 2018)

Padma Shri Brig (Dr) Kapil Mohan, VSM (Retd)

It is with great grief and profound sorrow we mourn the passing away of a legendary Mohyal, late Padma Shri Brig (Dr) Kapil Mohan VSM, Chairman and Managing Director of Mohan Meakin Ltd. He left for his heavenly abode on 6 Jan 2018 at the age of 88 yrs – a life totally dedicated to the service of the humanity.

He was son of a great legend, late Padma Shri N N Mohan, founder of Mohan Meakin Ltd and brother of late Padma Bhushan Col V R Mohan, late Shri Sukhdev Mohan and Mrs Nita Bali wife of Mohyal Ratna Rzd B D Bali, President General Mohyal Sabha. He was born on 16 July 1929 at Rawalpindi, and after a brilliant academic career, was deeply involved alongwith his illustrious father and elder dynamic brother in planning and expanding the company's manifold operations over the years. In 1973, when his elder brother suddenly passed away at the young age of 47 yrs, he took over the reins of the vast Industrial empire and steered it through successfully till the end.

He was a devoted Mohyal and Patron of General Mohyal Sabha and in true Mohyali spirit he was full of vigour and valour. Despite his manifold activities, he joined the Territorial Army and attended many courses alongwith regular Army Officers - in two of which he won the first prize for shooting. Brig Mohan showed exemplary courage when he overpowered the four hijackers and made them to surrender when he was on board Indian Airlines Flight with 52 passengers on 10th April 1993 from Lucknow to Delhi, for which act of bravery he was highly commended.

Despite his multiple activities, he was a deeply religious person and ardent devotee of Divine Mata Durga. He was a rare example of a business tycoon wearing a necklace of Rudraksh and performing marathon kirtans whenever he got an opportunity to do so. In his spiritual pursuits he established various temples at Mohan Nagar and elsewhere, of which Mata Durga Temple at Mohan Shakti National Heritage Park near Solan (Himachal Pradesh), is an outstanding marvel of architecture, spread over many acres and took over 20 years to complete, which is to be seen to be believed. Brig Kapil Mohan's spiritual values will keep him alive for all times to come.

General Mohyal Sabha, Members of Managing Committee and entire Mohyal Community convey their heartfelt condolences to Mrs Pushpa Mohan, Mrs Nita and Rzd B D Bali, Mr Rakesh Mohan, Mr Hemant Mohan, Mr Vinay Mohan, Mr Pankaj Mohan and Padma Shri Rakesh Bakshi and the entire bereaved family, and pray to God Almighty to grant eternal peace to the departed noble soul and give strength to the closely knit family, to bear with this irreparable loss.
