A LEGEND PASSES AWAY

Lt Gen Zorawar Chand Bakshi, PVSM, MVC, VrC, VSM

It is with great grief and profound sorrow, we mourn the passing away of a legendary Mohyal, Lt Gen Zorawar Chand Bakshi, PVSM, MVC, VrC, VSM. He left for his heavenly abode on 24 May 2018 at the age of 97 yrs - a life totally dedicated in the service of the Country.

Gen Bakshi, son of Capt Bakshi Lal Chand, was born in 1921 at village Gulyana near Rawalpindi. After graduating from Gordon College Rawalpindi in 1942 he was commissioned into the Baloch Regiment in 1943 and later, he was transferred to 5th Gorkha Rifles and saw action during the Indo Pak War of 1947 - 1948. He held many important Instructional and Staff appointments during his 36 yrs of glorious service in the Army and he had the unique distinction of being in the battlefield in every rank from Lt to Maj Gen, and was the most decorated soldier of the Indian Army.

The Mohyal Community is very proud and feels greatly honoured by his achievements, and he has been a source of great inspiration to all of us. Gen Bakshi was closely associated with GMS, the Apex body of the Mohyal Community 1979 onwards. He was the Sr Vice President of GMS, in its formative years. During his visit to the Mohyal Foundation New Delhi in 2003, when the second phase of the building was inaugurated by him, he fondly recalled the earlier days of GMS, when for want of resources, the GMS was functioning from a Tin Shed with the office bearers and members seated on Hessian cloth spread on the floor -- from humble shed to the air conditioned office of the new building. He became emotional to see the tremendous progress made by the Community and complimented Rzd B D Bali, President GMS and his team of dedicated mohyals for the progress achieved over the years.

Gen Zorawar Chand Bakshi during his tenure as Sr Vice President was actively involved and participated in all community affairs and became as part of think tank of the apex body. Besides, he was Chairman of Smt Brij Rani Vaid Trust , proceeds from this property eventually provided seed money to the Community, towards its progress and prosperity. He was a strict disciplinarian, a very nice human being, a Great Mohyal, and his value systems will keep him alive for all times to come. He leaves behind a well settled family, son Rajeev Bakshi and family, daughters Anita Sharma and family and Shail Nanda and family. We share their sorrow.

Rzd B D Bali, President General Mohyal Sabha and members of the Managing Committee, convey their heartfelt condolences to the bereaved family and pray to God Almighty to grant eternal peace to the departed noble soul and to give strength to the close Knit family to bear with this irreparable loss.

Booking of Rooms at Mohyal Ashrams at Haridwar and Vrindavan

Ashrams have been made for the convenience of guests visiting the holy cities of Haridwar and Vrindavan. The Ashrams are being run on, no profit no loss basis. The Ashrams have limited number of rooms which are allotted on first come first served basis. Rooms cannot be left vacant, since vacant rooms means loss of revenue which is not desirable.

Recently there have been cases, where rooms have been booked and not utilized. The guests did not even bother to inform the Managers of the Ashram regarding the non utilization of the rooms booked by them, which resulted in loss of revenue to GMS and denial of rooms to other mohyal brothers and sisters.

In order to avoid such situations in future, it has been decided that booking of rooms on telephone, will be confirmed only after receipt of 50% of the room tariff. Confirmation of booking will be done through sms / e mail. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before the booking date. The deposit will be kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.

The procedure of booking of rooms has been streamlined after a lot of deliberation with the aim of avoiding inconvenience to the community and financial loss to GMS.

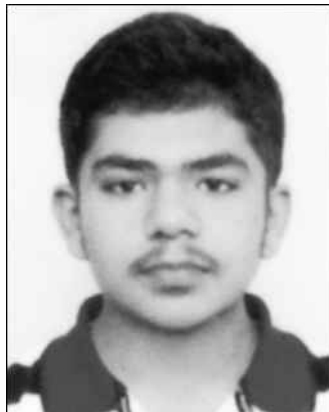

MARTYRS BANDA BAIRAGI AND BHAI MATIDAS SHARED A COMMON DNA

Lachhman Dev, son of Ram Dev a Mohyal Brahman of Chhibber Caste, was born on 27 October, 1670 in village Mendhar, District Poonch/Rajouri in J&K. As a Warrior-Brahman, he was fond of hunting.¹(Because of this, some scholars have assumed that Lacchman Dev (Banda) was a Rajput. Elsewhere also historians have tried, without justification, to ascribe Kshatriya *varna* to Mohyal Warrior Brahmanas.) Once when he killed a she-deer, he saw two off-springs falling from the womb of the female deer dying in pain. Deeply affected by the painful sight he reflected about the futility of his own life and activities. He decided to renounce the world and became a *sadhu*. Lachhman Dev was baptized as a *sanyasi* by Baba Janki Das at Rajauri and he performed *tapassaya*(austerities) near the bank of a river in the vicinity. Later he travelled from place to place, meeting saints and *jogis*. Finally coming to Nasik, on the bank of river Godavari, he came in contact with Yogi AugherNath. There, Lachhman Dev was baptized as a *Bairagi* under the name of Madho Das. After some time he moved to Nander (Maharashtra) where he established his own monastery and had stayed there for fifteen years, when he met a *karm Yogi* Guru Gobind Singh, in the last week of September, 1708.

Madho Das was deeply affected by the account of the Guru's struggle against Mughal despotism in Punjab. The Guru had witnessed two of his young sons being killed in a battle at Chamkaur and received news of the two younger sons being walled up alive in Sirhind. Madho Das must have seen the same pain in the eyes of Gobind as he had once witnessed in the eyes of the dying she-deer – and this encounter once again changed his life.

Guru Gobind Singh, a leader of men, immediately recognized “the fanatical gleam in the eyes” of the Bairagi and persuaded him to undertake to punish the men who had persecuted the Sikhs and murdered his sons. Being from North India it did not take long for Madho Das to grasp the situation.

Instant Commissioning of a Commander

Some scholars, like W. H. McLeod (*Essays in Sikh History, Tradition and Society*) and Khushwant Singh (*A History of the Sikhs*) have been wondering how the Guru entrusted this job to a person so recently acquainted: the Guru had stayed in Nanded for less than a month. The explanation is very simple

Bhai Matidas and Bhai Satidas who were martyred along with Guru Tegh Bahadur, the ninth Guru, both belonged to the Chhibber caste of Mohyal Brahmans, from village Karyala, District Jehlum (now in Pakistan). When Gobind Singh took over as the tenth Guru, he appointed Saheb Chand and Dharam Chand Chhibbers of the same family, as his Dewans: “*Dharam Chand liyakarkhazana, Saheb Chand Ghar bar dewna.*” Likewise Mukand Rai, son of the martyr Matidas was also appointed as a Dewan. All of them laid down their lives on the battlefield, fighting valiantly on behalf of the Guru. Sahib Chand (now Singh) died fighting with Hatai Khan, a little beyond Beas: *Jeetbhaitahi Khalsaki, Aru Saheb Chand kiloth uthayi*. Dharam Chand also met similar fate. Mukand Rai died fighting in the battle of Chamkor, along with two elder sons of Guru Gobind Singh. Pandit Kirpa Ram, of Datt caste of Mohyal Brahmans, was also martyred at Chamkor, from where the Guru managed to escape.

The Guru had great experience of the loyalty, valour and intrepidity of Mohyal Brahmans, particularly the Chhibbers of village Karyala. Banda was also a scion of the Chhibber clan of Mohyal Brahmans. Though not belonging to the Baba Praga's Chhibber family of Karyala, Bhai Mati Das and Lachman Dev (Banda) shared a common DNA: they had a common ancestry, being of the same *gotra*.

The biological parents of Lachman Das were Chhibber Mohyal Brahmans; he was baptized as a Bairagi and named Madho Das; Banda Bahadur of Guru Gobind Singh established the Sikh Raj in southern Punjab. His fraternity in each of the three incarnations can rightly claim him as one of them but there need be no controversy how the others remember him.

MOHYAL ASHRAMS AT HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked on line, 30 days in advance.
 - Haridwar web site: www.mohyalashramharidwar.in
 - Vrindavan / Goverdhan web site: www.mohyalashram.co.in
2. Bookings can also be done on telephone and at the counter.
3. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
4. Bookings can be done after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The deposit can be refunded or kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
5. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
6. Room donors will be charged 25% of the standard room rates (Non Mohyal rates)
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashram is strictly prohibited.
8. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall.
10. Pets (Animals) are not allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Guests are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant , of each room.
12. Guests are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to Guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Online booking facility for rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar is not available. Rooms can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
14. In case of any inconvenience Guests are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / GMS.
15. Guests are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
16. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram .
17. Facility of free langar is available , only to residents of the Ashram .
