of the Saraswati Vandana by Mrs. Rita Datta, sister of Sh. Ashok Chhibber ji, which added an enchanting musical dimension to the event.

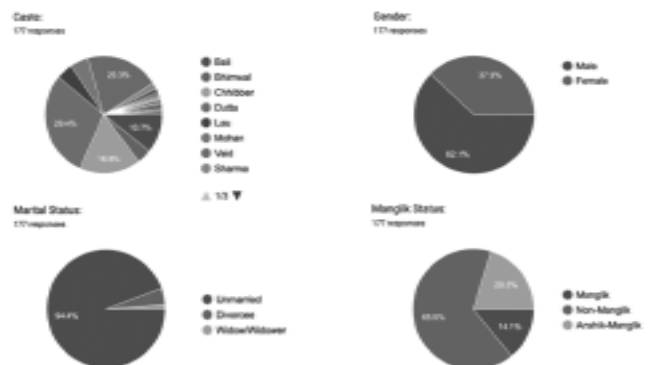

Shri Inder Bali, son of late Smt Bimla Bali and Shri Ram Sarup Bali of Rawalpindi, suddenly passed away on

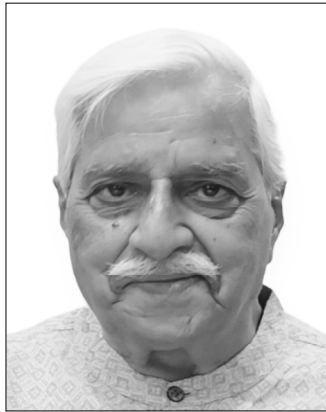

MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatri's, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams. There is no online booking at the Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after full payment of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran .
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation, only on written request by the senior citizens giving details of their permanent postal address and next of kin, alongwith their medical fitness certificate.
14. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar, is available only to yatri's staying in the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Yatri's and No other activity is permitted.
18. In case of any inconvenience, Yatri's are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / Office bearer of GMS. Yatri's are requested to fill the feedback form before their departure.
19. Yatri's are requested to help in keeping the rooms and the premises of the Ashram clean. Yatri's are also requested to maintain decorum, while dealing with the staff posted at the Ashrams.
20. Yatri's are requested to follow Covid 19 guidelines as per existing orders of the local government authorities.

IN MEMORIAM



Lt Puneet Nath Datt, Ashoka Chakra (29 April 1973 – 20 July 1997)

The 26th Martyrdom anniversary of Lt Puneet Nath Datt, Ashoka Chakra, was commemorated with a ceremonial guard of honor on 20 July 2023 at the Memorial in Defence Colony named after him. A wreath was laid by Maj Gen AS Gehlot, on behalf of Colonel 11 GR and Sikkim Scouts. Wreaths were also laid on behalf of CO, all men of 11 Gorkha Rifles. Floral tributes were paid by Defence Colony residents. Maj Gen Gehlot recounted Puneet's gallantry and how his valor and sense of duty were a continuing source of inspiration for every soldier of the 11 Gorkha Rifles and the Indian Army. Brig Amul Asthana (Retd), former CO 11 GR, remembered Puneet as a brave officer with exemplary leadership traits who was always at the forefront of initiative and ready to support his course mates, men, and friends, even if at the cost of personal comfort.

Lt Puneet Nath Datt, Ashoka Chakra (Posthumous), laid down his life combating militancy in the Kashmir Valley on 20 July 1997. He was alumnus of NDA and IMA and was commissioned into 1/11 Gorkha Rifles on 9 Dec 1995. He was instrumental in clearing a house infested with militants and laid down his life in a true act of valour. His mother, Smt Anita Datt, received the Nations highest peace time gallantry award, Ashoka Chakra (Posthumous), from the President of India on behalf of her dear son Puneet, on Republic Day, 26 Jan 1998.

The day was also commemorated by members of the Mohyal fraternity to which the family belongs. Mr. Sunil Kumar Vaid had planted a kadipatta plant in honor of Puneet 7 years ago and today, it has grown into a beautiful tree. In the evening, the family made a visit to the national war memorial to pay tribute. Friends and family members gathered at the Memorial to light candles and invoke the blessings of the Almighty. It is sad that we lost Puneet Datt, when he was in the prime of his youth. His supreme sacrifice, will always remind us of him as a very brave Mohyal Youth.

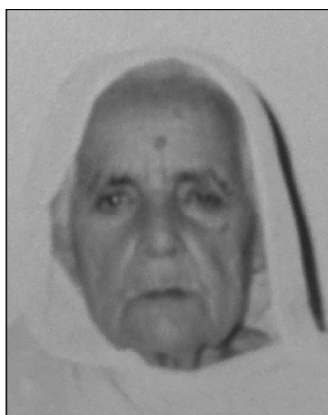

चातुर्मास चार महीने की अवधि के लिए मनाया जाता है। यह आषाढ़ के महीने में शयनी एकादशी के अगले दिन से शुरू होता है और कार्तिक के महीने की देवोत्थान एकादशी पर समाप्त होता है। 30 जून से शुरू होकर 23 नवंबर को समाप्त होगा। ये चार महीने प्रार्थनाओं अनुष्ठानों और पूजा अर्चना के लिए समर्पित है इसलिए विवाह गृह प्रवेश और किसी तरह के अन्य समारोह नहीं मनाए जाते। इन चार महीनों में लोग तीर्थ करते हैं जैसे वृंदावन, मथुरा, हरिद्वार आदि। इस अवधि में कोई मांगलिक कार्य नहीं किए जाते। श्रावण, भाद्रपद, अश्विन और कार्तिक के 4 महीनों में भगवान योग निद्रा में शयन करते हैं। आध्यात्मिक रूप से यह 4 महीने बहुत महत्वपूर्ण हैं। इन महीनों में उपवास, श्रवण, कीर्तन, तीर्थ यात्रा आदि करके भगवान श्रीकृष्ण के प्रति प्रेम भक्ति बढ़ानी चाहिए।

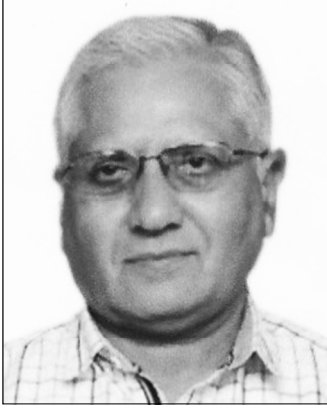

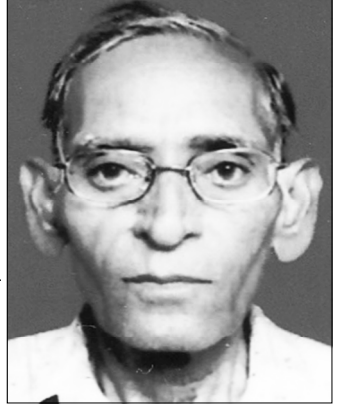

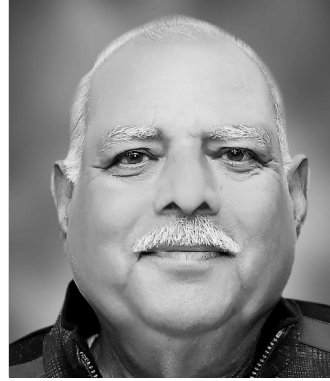
