MOHYAL YOUTH CAMP ORGANISED BY MS PREM NAGAR AND MS DEHRADUN ON 26 – 27 MAY 2023

It was a very happy moment for MS Dehradun and Premnagar when they were given an opportunity to organise a youth festival in Haridwar. After much consultation with Hon'ble President Sh Vinod Dutt Ji, Hon'ble Senior Vice President Shri P K Dutta Ji and Senior members of GMS Management Committee $26^{th} - 27^{th}$ of May 2023 were finalised for the youth festival to be held at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar. Everyone was excited and the countdown had begun and at last came the day when MS Dehradun and Premnagar under the aegis of GMS and blessings of Shri Vinod Dutt Ji and Shri P K Dutta ji sky rocketed the youth festival. Our Senior Vice President GMS Shri P K Dutta Ji though could not attend the youth festival personally due to health reasons but he promised us with every kind of help we wanted.

Morning session was busy for everyone as the Registration of Guests and Allotment of rooms was the main focus. After breakfast the guests who had arrived in the morning settled in their rooms. By the afternoon most of the guests had arrived. In all nearly 60 rooms had been blocked in Mohyal Ashram Haridwar, Sewa Sadan and neighbouring South Indian Ashram. After lunch everyone was very enthusiast & busy interacting with everyone with some known and some new to each other. By evening time the strength and picture regarding the participants was quite clear, all the blocked rooms were nearly allotted and in all around 19 Sabhas from all over had participated in the youth festival. The Sabha's that participated were viz MS Mehrauli, MS Najafgarh, MS Gurgaon, MS Naraingarh, MS Pitampura, MS Panipat, MS Yamuna Nagar, MS Ludhiana, MS Khanna, MS Rajpura, MS Patiala, MS Chandigarh, MS Ambala, MS Jammu, MS Amritsar, MS Dwarka, MS Jaipur, MS Dehradun and MS Premnagar. A total of 200 participants with nearly 70% youths accompanied by their Guardians participated in the festival. By the evening Hon'ble GMS President Shri Vinod Dutt Ji arrived and in his presence and with the blessings of Shri P K Dutta Ji the festival was unleashed with the flag hoisting and recitation of Mohyal Prarthana and after that everyone assembled in the hall at neighbouring South Indian Ashram for the Cultural Programme. The entire hall with nearly 125 persons sitting capacity was jam packed and a many were also standing. The youths gave rocking performances on the stage, songs on guitar, Punjabi Dhol, Mimicry, Dance, empowerment of Mohyal youth, flute and exciting games were performed by the Mohyal Youth. The atmosphere was so good that every mohyal participant was overwhelmed, proud and joyed to be a part of the festival. As I looked at my watch even I got jitters in my body that it was 11 pm in the night and even though no one has had the dinner still they are not ready to leave the hall. In the end our senior and dedicated Mohyal Maj Gen G D Bakshi Ji's documentary "Mohyal History" was played on projector and after that everyone was requested to have their dinner and finally everyone left for dinner at MS Haridwar. It was good to see hot and delicious food being served in Langar hall at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar evening. After dinner though the elders preferred to hit the

bed but the youth had not even a faint hint of sleep in their eyes though they were aware that they had to leave the Ashram at 7.30 in the morning for rafting (from Marine Drive to Shivpuri). At around 2.30 am I checked around in the Ashram if everything was fine and perfect and to my utter surprise I saw youths singing and clapping on Guitar at the steps below the meditation hall. I had to request them to go off to sleep as we all had to proceed for rafting next day early morning. Next day 27th of May early morning at around 6.30 am when I came out of my room I could smell the aroma of Mohyaliyat everywhere. By 7 am I could see everyone coming out of their rooms all ready and excited to go for rafting and I was just wondering "did they sleep in the night"? Cause they were active and fresh till 2.30 - 3 am in morning . In curiosity I asked them "How's the Josh" and they replied back as true Mohyal soldiers " High Sir". Breakfast was ready and two buses had also arrived to take everyone to marine drive (Tehri) for rafting. By 7.30 am I alongwith our respected Secretary General GMS Lt Col L R Vaid Ji and Shri Harshbir Mehta Vice President MS Premnagar left for Shivpuri - Marine Drive as advance party to make arrangements for rafting. Our Vice President of GMS Shri Yogesh Mehta Ji could not attend the festival for personal reasons but ensured to guide us with his valuable advise regarding safety of youth. By 8 am in the morning everyone after the breakfast boarded the buses and left for Shivpuri - Marine Drive for rafting. Finally we reached our rafting destination point marine drive by 11 am in all 10 rafts had been booked for rafting and each raft was to accommodate 8 rafters plus one rafting guide. 5 rafts sailed for rafting in the first round and we ensured that each raft had a responsible Senior Mohyal to ensure safety and security of youth. It took around three and a half hours for the rafts to go down for their journey and come back to the starting point for a second round and during this entire time our senior members, mentors and inspirations Shri Vipan Mohan Ji, Shri Rit Mohan Ji, Shri T.K. Bali, Lt Col L R Vaid Ji, Shri Ashok Chhibber, Shri Harsh Datta, Shri Munish Bali stood there as pillars at Marine Drive (the starting point of rafting) in scorching heat just to ensure that the second round of rafts took off smoothly. Meanwhile Organising Secretary of MS Dehradun Shri Sanjay Dutta reached the starting point of rafting with his car loaded with hot packed lunch, soft drinks and water for those who were present at the starting point of rafting & after serving them Shri Sanjay Dutta left for Shivpuri (the end point of rafting) just to ensure that those who had left for rafting in the first round got their food and beverages after they were done with rafting. I would like to mention here that the think tanks at the GMS office ensured that fresh and warm food is served to everyone at Marine Drive and Shivpuri and for that reason they did not put the packed lunch in buses but sent the same in a separate car later. As soon as the second round of five rafts left for sail these mentors and everyone who did not participate in the rafting left for Shivpuri (the end point of rafting) to ensure that the second lot of rafts also reached their destination safely. In all 80

people did rafting. After the rafting was over the seniors ensured that everyone had boarded the bus and by 7 pm the buses left for Mohyal Ashram Haridwar. The buses reached the Ashram at around 10 pm and again to my utter surprise rather than having their dinner everyone loaded with energy assembled in the hall at neighbouring South Indian Ashram to share their experiences of rafting and Bus journey and their stay at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar. Till 12 in the night everyone was in the hall to share their experiences with no sleep in their eyes. We all had to request them to have their dinner and go to sleep as they must be tired. After having dinner at around 12 in the midnight the youth rather than sleeping again assembled at the staircase below the meditation hall with a few laughing and joking and a few playing hide and seek and a few sharing their memories. Everyone was unwilling to part and wished they had one more day of togetherness at youth festival. Next day on 28th of May at 7 in the morning the interested ones assembled in the hall alongwith Hon'ble President Shri Vinod Dutt Ji for Yoga. OPPORTUNITIES LIKE THIS COME ONCE IN A 100 YEARS





Life is what happens to you while you are busy making other plans. Col Man Mohan Bakshi's Centenary Birthday Celebrations were planned a couple of months ago, but God wanted him to celebrate his birthday in heaven. The planning for a mega Centenary Birthday were discussed with the Chief Guest Lt Gen PN Ananthanarayanan AVSM, SM the Colonel of the 8 Gorkha Rifles, Daddy's Regiment. He was graceful to travel from Mhow by taking an early morning flight to New Delhi. Because late Col M M Bakshi was celebrating his 100th Birthday in Heaven, there was a little bit of Heaven on Earth at the solemn Thanksgiving function at Arun Vihar Community Centre (AVCC) at Noida.

How do you have a solemn Centenary birthday on Earth for your Father in Heaven, who was with us on Earth just one month ago? The spiritual ritual of lighting a Candle to pay tribute, shortens the distance between Heaven And Earth. Keeping a light burning in remembrance would signify that his memory still lives on and burns bright. The Chief Guest Lt Gen PN Ananthanarayanan lit the first lamp as a tribute to Goddess Saraswati to invoke her blessings.

In the short time after the mourning period the family had hurriedly put together a century's worth of unforgettable moments and compressed them into a 15 minute Film which was screened.

We thought we would honor our Father by upholding the Birthday traditions we have followed for the last decade. The Noida Chapters of the Gorkhas and the Mohyals were invited home to surprise my Father, since he felt that birthdays in your 90's are not a time of celebration but Thanksgiving. However, he was very happy to welcome everyone at home and wholeheartedly participated with enthusiasm, so long as we called them Thanksgiving, just as he would have been delighted while looking down from Heaven at AVCC. So on his 100th Thanksgiving Birthday we had gathered there to count our blessings, and someday make our blessings count.

We were lucky to have with us two senior office bearers of GMS, Shri P K Dutta, Senior Vice President and Lt Col L R Vaid (Retd), Secretary General. Lt Col Vaid said, GMS is the apex body of the Mohyal community and was established on 24 May 1891 at Lahore and is a charitable organisation. It is managed by skilled members who are elected and work in an honorary capacity. He then invited Lt Gen Guru Bakshi (Retd), former President GMS and Lt Gen Randhir Kumar Mehta (Retd), President Noida Mohyal Sabha to join Shri P K Dutta, Sr Vice President GMS, who was introduced as a Philanthropist with a very large heart. Shri Dutta opened his remarks, saying "late Col Bakshi's name reflects him perfectly Man Mohan which is his personality. He was a distinguished soldier of the 11 Gorkhas who later commanded the 5/8 Gorkha Rifles. Post retirement he became a social activist and gave free but effective homeopathic treatment. This made him popular as he lived for others and made the Mohyal Community very proud in the field of social service. Shri P K Dutta said that, in recognition of late Col Man Mohan Bakshi selfless, dedicated services to the Community, GMS honours him with the award 'Pride of Mohyals' posthumously on his 100th birth anniversary on 1 June 2023, and as a token of love, "Star of Mohyal Biradari". Lt Gen Guru Bakshi and Lt Gen Randhir Kumar Mehta were part of the Award Presentation which was received by his two Sons, Ranjan and Rakesh Bakshi. While accepting the Award Ranjan Bakshi said "Daddy blesses you from Heaven for bestowing the Honor of "Pride of Mohyals." Now that he is with God, He would request him to give what you deserve, and not what you desire. That's because your desires may be few but you deserve a lot."

Lt Gen Guru Bakshi PVSM, former President GMS, who has also been a good neighbour in Noida in his talk shared, "was very fortunate and privileged to know late Col Bakshi well as part of our community post retirement since 1994. There are two aspects post retirement—How were you rated as a soldier since that is our profession and the second and more important aspect is how is the person rated as a human being. When you leave the world your position, money, status etc don't count. What makes the memory everlasting is the kind of person you are. Everybody lives for themselves and how many live for others and Jeena isi ka naam. Have not seen a person as dedicated, as emphatic as sympathetic, as caring and as concerned as him. Everybody had a lot of respect for him as he met everybody with a smile and had an open door policy. There is no doubt that he made a place in everybody's heart." Gen Bakshi also thanked, Shri P K Dutta and Col Vaid, who came all the way to honour late Col Bakshi and deeply appreciated their gesture. He also complimented Lt Gen P N Ananthanarayanan came all the way from Mhow as that speaks volumes for men in uniform, since for them such things matter.

Lt Gen Randhir Kumar Mehta, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, VSM, who has been the President of the Noida Mohyal Sabha since 2015, started his speech saying "We are here to celebrate Col Man Mohan Bakshi's 100th birthday and I would like to start by thanking office bearers of the GMS. GMS had earlier honoured him with Lifetime achievement Award in 2017, which Gen Bakshi and other office bearers with me had presented it to him at his residence. One more Award has being given today- Pride of Mohyals by Shri P K Dutta, Senior Vice President and Lt Col L R Vaid (Retd), Secretary General of the GMS. Gen Mehta also explained, how we came to be called Hussaini Bramhins in the Middle East because of the sacrifices of the Mohyals in the Battle of Karbala. There is also a Book published about our biradari in 1920 titled "Punjab in World War 1." Lord Haley Governor General of Punjab felicitated the 400 odd warriors who participated in the War and asked, what can I do for you, do you need Money, Zameen or some other help. The seniors said, Governor General, we express our thanks but we want nothing. Can you give us a Cannon at the entrance of the village to inspire future generations? Sanskaar bahut jaroori hote hain. A song that reminds me of late Col Man Mohan Bakshi, "Kisi ki muskurahaton pe ho nisaar, kissi ka dard mil sake toh le udhaar, Kisi ke vaaste ho tere dil mein pyar, Jeena isi ka naam hai. All these qualities were there in late Col Man Mohan Ji."

Late Col M M Bakshi was the 1st Second in Command of the 11 Gorkha Rifles when the Regiment was raised at Palampur in 1948. Incidentally, the wonderful Bagpipers are here courtesy the 11 Gorkha Rifles. Interestingly, bagpipes are the only known musical instrument in history to have been used as a weapon of war overseas, while we are using them as an instrument of Peace.

The afternoon ended with the Chief Guest, Lt Gen PN Ananthanarayanan handing over Alikati, Rakshi from Bakshi, to the two Bagpipers of the 11 Gorkhas after which everybody joined the Langar Khana in Honor of Daddy in Heaven.



MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

- Rooms can be booked by Yatris, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams. There is no online booking at the Ashrams.
- Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
- Room bookings will be confirmed, only after full payment of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
- 4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
- Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
- Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
- Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
- Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran.
- There is no room service meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
- Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
- 11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity same is required for each occupant, of each room.
- 12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
- Rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.






