REPORT ON PRESIDENTS AND SECRETARIES MEETING OF MOHYAL SABHAS HELD AT MOHYAL FOUNDATION, NEW DELHI ON 10 MARCH 2024

Meeting of the, Presidents and Secretaries of Mohyal Sabha's, was held at 1100 hrs on Sunday 10 March 2024, at Mohyal Foundation, A-9, Qutab Institutional Area, USO Road, Jit Singh Marg, New Delhi. Shri Rit Mohan, Secretary Public Relations GMS and President MS Panipat was the Stage Secretary.

On arrival members were served light refreshments. The programme started, with unfurling of the Mohyal Flag by Shri Vinod Kumar Dutt, President GMS and Shri P.K. Dutta, Sr Vice President GMS, followed by chanting of the Mohyal Prayer led by Smt Neelima Datta Mehta, Secretary Matrimonial GMS and roars of JAI MOHYAL. This was followed by Deep Prajawalan (lighting of the traditional lamp).

Members had been given the following subjects for discussion

- (a) Our Institutions** How to make our Institutions, financially self sustaining, without losing our charitable status.
- (b) Youth and Women Empowerment** Steps to be taken, to further empower Youth and Women of our Community.
- (c) Mohyalist** Schemes to be introduced, to promote welfare, progress and prosperity of our Community.

Shri Rit Mohan, Secretary Public Relations GMS and President MS Panipat, welcomed all the members who had come to attend the meeting. He said, we look forward to having a healthy interaction, with the aim, to help our needy members, and evolve programmes for the welfare and growth of our Community. He invited Shri P.K. Dutta, Sr Vice President GMS to give the opening address, who said that for growth of our organization, we look forward to positive suggestions. We can grow if we do the doable and move the movable and are financially strong. Resistance to change does not help any organization, each one of us should therefore think how to contribute for the growth of our Community.

- (d) Install ATM Machine at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
- (e) Streamline procedures, for grant of financial aid to widows / underprivileged persons.
- (f) Review room donations at our Ashrams, to be effective from 1st April 2024.
- (g) Youth Camps – members attending should make financial contribution.
- (h) Youth should take the initiative to organize youth activities.
- (i) Youth and young widows should be empowered by giving them skill training to help them become financially self sufficient.
- (j) Our Institutions should be made financially self sufficient.
- (k) Adopt a Child Education Scheme, be merged with the existing Education Fund Trust Account.
- (l) Promote use of Solar Energy at our Institutions.
- (m) As Mohyals we should be proud of our Nation, our Family, our History, our Heroes and our Organization.

Shri Vinod Kumar Dutt, President GMS, in his concluding address, complimented the members for their active participation and a very healthy interaction. He said that as Proud Mohyals, we should make a one time membership donation of Rs 100/- each. GMS Life membership has been revised to Rs 5100/, wef 1 April 2024. Adopt a Child Education Scheme, will be merged with the existing Education Fund Trust Account. The offer of MS Chandigarh and MS Jammu, to handover their existing Bhawans to GMS, is being considered. He also said that this meeting was very fruitful and recommended that we should meet at least twice a year.

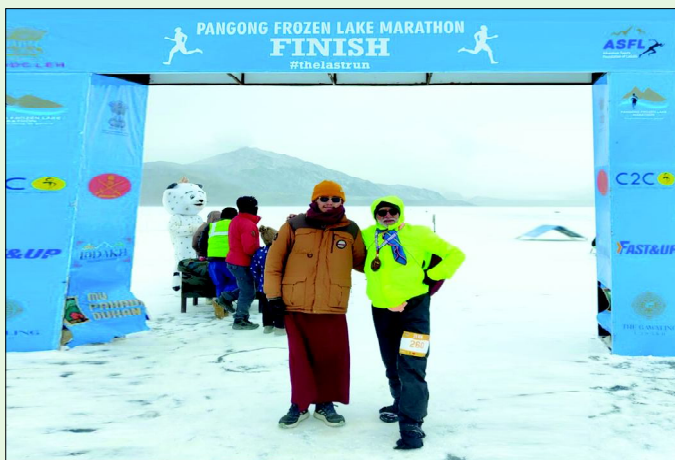

FINANCIAL AID GIVEN TO WIDOWS, UNDER PRIVILEGED PERSONS AND STUDENTS

Financial aid given to widows, under privileged persons and students will be sent through Bank, and not by Money order. A DAY AT NCMRWF



On the 23rd of February 2024, we set sail for, firstly, National War Memorial to honour Major Rohit Datta. A national hero of the unit 513 AD MSL Regt and son of our director Dr. Rattan K. Datta. After the tribute we took pictures.

By Noon we had set sail, two hours earlier than we expected, for NCMRWF (National Center for Medium Range Weather Forecasting) located at Noida Sector 62. The morale of the students was high and they demonstrated the same with continuous singing and dancing in the bus.

Arriving at the NCMRWF we were guided to the Conference Room through the backdoor to keep us in suspense of the super computer, commented Dr. Balakrishnan Athiyaman, the supervisor / head of super computer at NCMRWF.

We were greeted by Dr. V.S. Prasad (current head of NCMRWF), Dr. Balakrishnan Athiyaman. They talked to Dr. Rattan K. Datta, reminiscing about the days they spent working under him. We presented them with the enlarged picture of the news article that covered the day the Super Computer - Cray X-MP - was inaugurated with, then Prime Minister of India, Mr. Rajeev Gandhi, at the Department of Earth Science (now, NCMRWF). They also honoured Dr. Datta with a golden coloured Memento.

Dr. Akhilesh Kumar Mishra, started the session by revisiting the topics explained to us by Dr. John P. George, but this time in a bit more depth. He explained the fundamental equations that are used - Newton's law of motion, Conservation of Mass (air and water), Conservation of Momentum, First Law of Thermodynamics, and last but not the least, the Ideal Gas Equation. The explanation was easy to follow because he incorporated some real-life examples to explain why these particular set of equations are used. Newtons law to calculate wind speed, conservation of mass to detect change in moisture, thermodynamics to check for temperature, and Ideal Gas Equation to check for atmospheric pressure.

Dr. Akhilesh also explained the various models that are used and how they differ from each other. He explained why the coupled model is used now because of the high accuracy of this model. And finally answers why a Super Computer is needed to perform these calculations.

After a quick Q&A session, the next presentation was started by Dr. Balakrishnan Athiyaman. He delivered on the history of all the super computers that the NCMRWF has had over the span of its existence, their features, advantages and disadvantages. After all the theoretical stuff, we finally got the chance to see the super computers we listened to so thoroughly about. The trip ended with a photo session with all the students, staff and Dr. Balakrishnan.

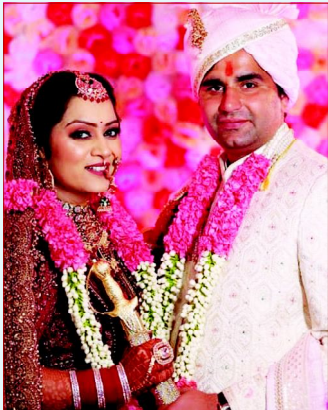

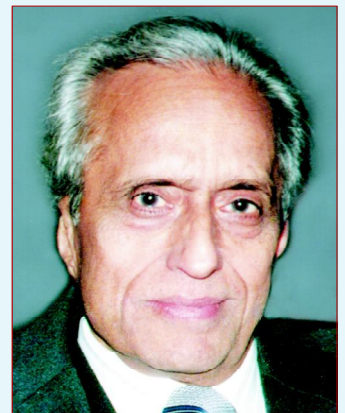

Smt Shanti Chhibber

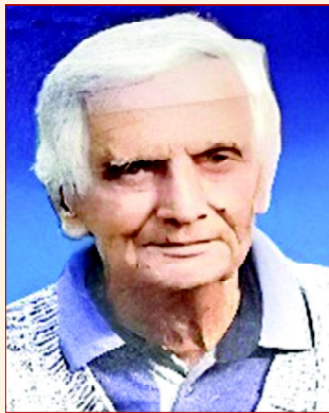

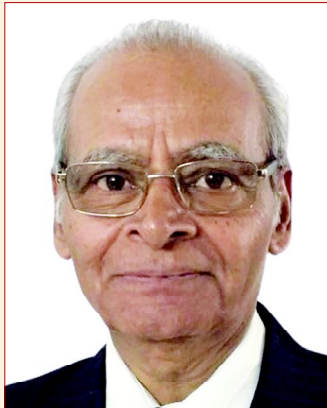


He was a staunch Mohyal and worked relentlessly to unite the Mohyal community. He passed away on

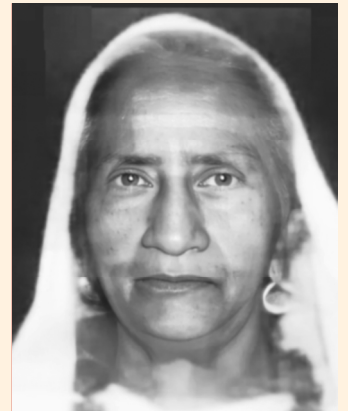
Smt Tripta Bali

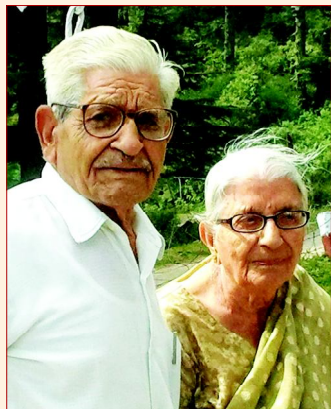

MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatri's, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams. There is no online booking at the Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after full payment of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran .
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation, only on written request by the senior citizens giving details of their permanent postal address and next of kin, alongwith their medical fitness certificate.
14. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar, is available only to yatri's staying in the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Yatri's and No other activity is permitted.
18. In case of any inconvenience, Yatri's are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / Office bearer of GMS. Yatri's are requested to fill the feedback form before their departure.
19. Yatri's are requested to help in keeping the rooms and the premises of the Ashram clean. Yatri's are also requested to maintain decorum, while dealing with the staff posted at the Ashrams.
20. Donors are requested to furnish their mobile numbers, and preferably PAN / Aadhar number, irrespective of the amount of the donation.
21. Yatri's are requested to follow Covid 19 guidelines as per existing orders of the local government authorities.
