

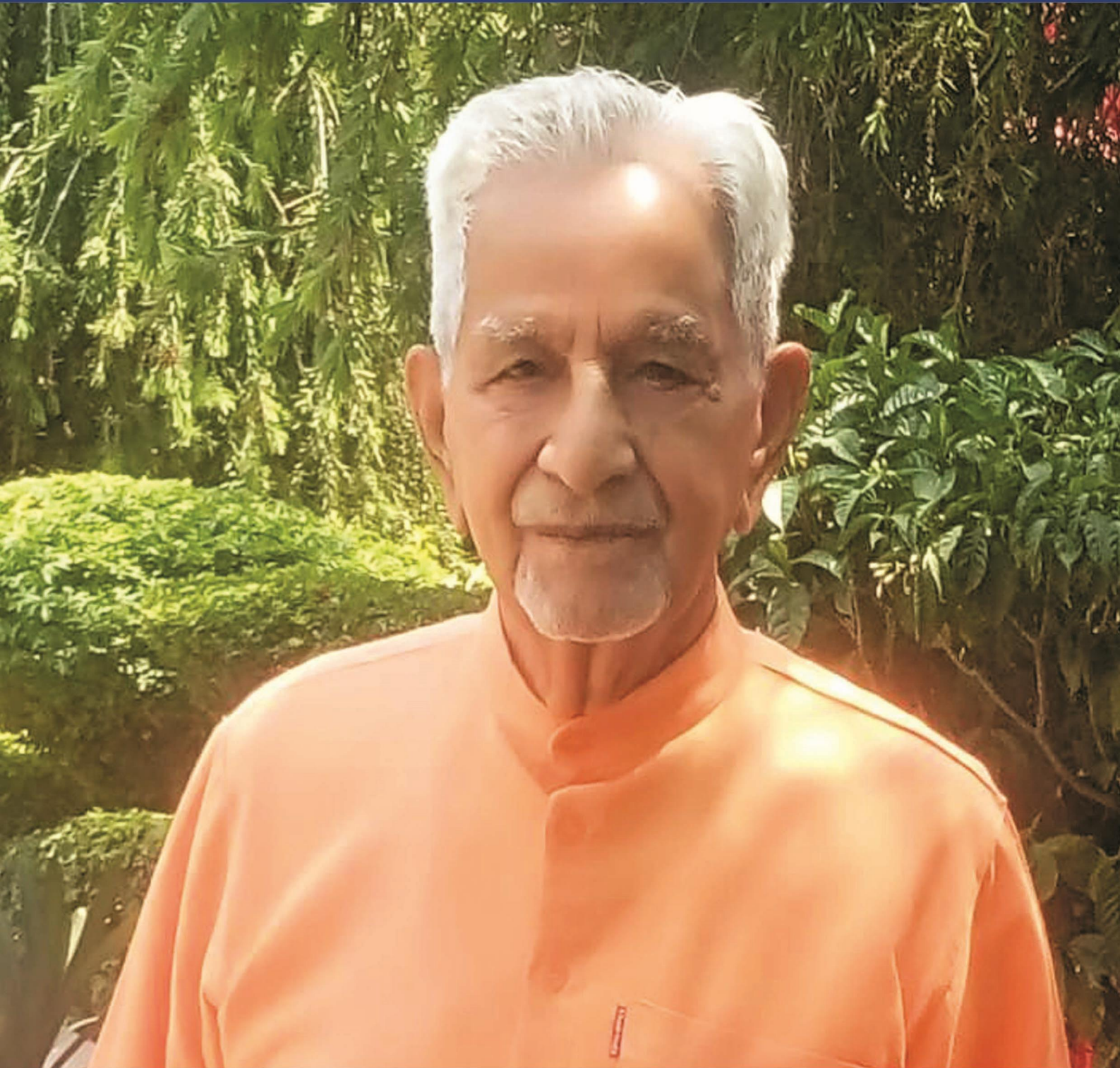

### READ WHILE CONFERRING AWARD OF “MOHYAL RATNA” TO SHRI O.P. MOHAN, FORMER SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT GMS AND PRESIDENT 52<sup>nd</sup> MOHYAL CONFERENCE, ON 13 NOV 2022 AT MOHYAL FOUNDATION NEW DELHI

Shri O.P. Mohan, son of Mehta Tirath Ram Mohan and Smt Ram Rakhi Mohan, was born on 6 Oct 1921 at Domeli, Pind Dadan Khan. He married, late Smt Shakuntala Mohan on 6 Dec 1945 and have been blessed with, son Shri Ajay Mohan, settled in Canada, and daughter Smt Amita Mohan, settled in New York, grandchildren and great grand children. He is a very religious person and is now residing in Chinmaya Tapovan Trust, Sidhbari, Kangra, Himachal Pradesh.

He received his primary education at Queta and S D School, Lahore and finally went to Hailey College of Commerce, Lahore and graduated in Commerce and Banking (B.Com) in 1943. During student days he was actively involved in, Freedom Movement and was interned in Lahore Fort during Quit India Movement in 1942. He started his career with BCR Ltd, pioneer manufactures of carbon paper and office stationery as Sales Representative and rose to the position of General Manager (Marketing) and Director of the Company. He started his own company, Kiran International in 1972 and has travelled extensively in India and abroad, like UK, Germany, France, Italy, USA, Canada, Australia, Japan, Malaysia, Singapore, Hongkong, Indonesia and entire Middle East and West Asian countries on business tours. He earned award for best exporters of Handicrafts in 1974 from President of India. He started his Packaging Industry in 1982. He was member of FCBM Managing Committee over 15 years and President of UP Corrugated Box Manufactures Association. He has been associated with Indian Institute of Foreign Trade, Small Industries Service Institute and with many social, cultural and educational organizations.

Shri O P Mohan, former Sr Vice President GMS, a fatherly figure, is a very kind hearted, caring and understanding person, a philanthropist, above all a very good human being, who is immensely popular in the Community. He is still a very active member of General Mohyal Sabha, and has worked with dedication and selflessly to uplift the mohyal community for over four decades, for which he has been honoured earlier by GMS. He took over as President of 52<sup>nd</sup> All India Mohyal Conference from Lt Gen G.L. Bakshi, PVSM (Retd) on 12 March 2017, on 125<sup>th</sup> Sthapna Divas and 52<sup>nd</sup> Mohyal Conference held at Talkatora Indoor Stadium, New Delhi.

Shri O P Mohan, has made the Mohyal Community very proud by his achievements in the field of social service. We bow our heads in utmost reverence to one of the greatest Mohyal of our times and in recognition of his meritorious services and bringing glory to the Mohyal Community, the Managing Committee of GMS and the entire Mohyal Community, honours Shri O P Mohan, 102 yrs, with the highest award of the Community – MOHYAL RATNA, and seek his blessings and guidance for times to come.

## PROCEEDINGS OF ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING HELD AT MOHYAL FOUNDATION ON SUNDAY 13 NOVEMBER 2022

Annual General Body meeting was held at Mohyal Foundation, A-9, Qutab Institutional Area, USO Road, Jeet Singh Marg, New Delhi, on Sunday 13 Nov 2022. The programme started at 0900 hrs, with Registration, wherein members signed their attendance on arrival at the venue. Refreshments, were served to the members after which flag hoisting ceremony was held. Shri Ashwani Bakshi (Lau), Secretary GMS and Stage Secretary, requested Shri Vinod Dutt, President GMS, to unfurl the Mohyal Flag, which was followed by chanting of the Mohyal Prayer by the members, led by Smt Neelima Datta Mehta, Secretary Matrimonial GMS, with roars of 'Jai Mohyal'. Shri O P Mohan, former Sr Vice President GMS and President 52<sup>nd</sup> Mohyal Conference and other dignitaries, were escorted to the dais after Deep Prajwalan (lighting of the traditional lamp), by Shri Vinod Dutt, President GMS and honourable members of GMS.

Lt Col L R Vaid (Retd), Secretary General welcomed the members and said that it was a matter of great honour for him, for being part of this prestigious gathering of the Community. Our heartiest welcome to each one of you. We are pleased to see amongst us, members coming from various Sabhas having travelled long distances. It is a matter of great honour for me, for being part of this prestigious gathering. We look forward to having a healthy interaction and finding workable solutions for the welfare, progress and prosperity of our community. I will now update you on the events which have taken place, since the last AGM, which was held at Mohyal Foundation New Delhi on 19 Dec 2021, details of which have been published in Mohyal Mitter Jan 2022 issue.

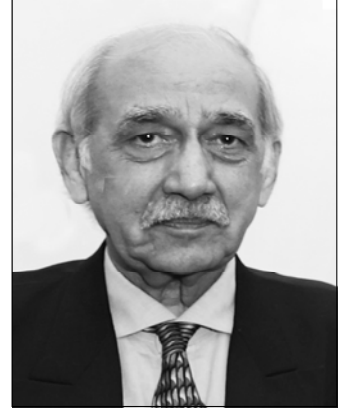
We have tried our best to make you all comfortable, and plan to complete today's proceedings by 2 pm. Ladies washroom is on the first floor and Gents washroom is on the second floor and lunch has been organized next door. The Business session will include, Report by the Secretary General, Presentation of Accounts by Secretary Finance, Resolutions to be adopted and Points from Members. After completing the AGM proceedings, we will have the Awards function to honour Shri O P Mohan, former Sr Vice President GMS and President 52nd Mohyal Conference with our highest award, Mohyal Ratna, also some members of our Community.

Education is very essential to make progress and to take the Community forward. GMS is committed to ensure that no Mohyal child is deprived of education for want of funds. Our Schools at Dehradun and Haridwar are running smoothly. Major K R Bali Mohyal School at Dehradun, started in 2007, is upto class 8, and has 281 students. Mohyal Public School at Haridwar, started in 2012, is upto class 5, and has 124 students. The activities of the School are regularly being printed in Mohyal Mitter. We will honour Headmistress, of these schools today, for their dedicated services. Financial help has been given for education to 24 needy students ie Rs 250/- pm to Rs 3000/- pm, depending on the class in which the child is studying. The financial aid is sent twice a year ie from Apr to Sep and from Oct to Mar.

Due to rapid development of technology, which is easily available to all, our children have to face tough competition, initially to get admission in colleges of their choice and later for suitable job placements. They have to be guided to excel academically, as well as in Sports and Cultural activities. Pratibhashalee Mohyal Vidyarthee Samman function was organized by GMS at Ambala City on 13 Feb 2022, where students scoring 80% and above marks, were honoured. There were total of 45 students, 27 (9 boys and 18 girls) from Class XII, and 18 (12 boys and 6 girls) from Class X. The students scored between 85% and 98.4% marks. Our youth, is actively involved in the activities of their respective Sabhas, which is a good sign. The next Pratibhashalee Mohyal Vidyarthee Samman function will

be held at Faridabad, on 5 Feb 2023, kind courtesy MS Faridabad.

GMS is committed to help the needy widows and the underprivileged members of the community. Financial assistance of Rs 1500/- pm has been given to 496 widows and 102 underprivileged persons. Financial assistance is being sent directly to the bank accounts of the individuals, once a quarter. Thanks to Shri Vinod Kumar Dutt, President GMS and Shri P K Dutta, Sr Vice President GMS, the needy members of the community have been helped by them, by giving them e-rickshaws and financial grant, to help them stand on their feet. Financial assistance for medical treatment, is also being given to the needy mohyals on, need to need basis.



Mohyal Match Making get-togethers were held at Mohyal Foundation on 11 June 2022, Ambala City on 7 Aug 2022 and at Jalandhar on 6 Nov 2022, which were a grand success, due to efforts put in by the Sabhas and Smt Neelima Mehta Datta, Secretary Matrimonial. Particulars of boys and girls for matrimonial alliance are also being regularly published in Mohyal Mitter, in order to encourage and facilitate marriages within the community.

Mohyal Milans were held by Mohyal Sabha Dehradun on 27 March 2022, Mohyal Sabha Mehrauli on 3 April 2022, Mohyal Sabha Ambala City on 17 April 2022, Mohyal Sabha Yamuna Nagar on 30 Oct 2022, Mohyal Sabha Jalandhar on 6 Nov 2022. It was very heartening to see members of the community interacting with each other and understanding each other. The aim of organizing Mohyal Milans is to build comradeship and to further bind the community together. Inauguration of Mohyal Bhawan Mehrauli was done on 3 April 2022, Mohyal Bhawan Yamuna Nagar on 30 Oct 2022 and Mohyal Bhawan Jalandhar on 6 Nov 2022. A big round of applause for the Sabhas who put in their heart and soul to make these monuments and dedicated them to the Community. Mohyal Sabha Prem Nagar will hold Mohyal Milan on 20 Nov 2022.

It is matter of great honour for the community, that the road in front of the house in Malviya Nagar, of late Shri G.L. Datta 'Josh' Sahib was named and inaugurated, G L Datta Marg, on 5 Feb 2022. Inauguration of 'Kamal Kishor Dutt Marg' at Amar Colony, Lajpat Nagar, New Delhi was done on 28 Feb 2022, in memory of late Shri Kamal Kishor Dutt, father of Shri Abhishek Dutt, Municipal Councilor, Andrews Ganj, New Delhi.



Construction of additional rooms on third floor of Mohyal Ashram Haridwar started on 12 May 2022, which we plan to complete by March 2023. So far we have received contributions of Rs 3 lacs each from 33 members, towards one room each, for which we are extremely grateful to them. Renovation work, though slow, is in progress at our Ashrams and Mohyal Bhawan Inderpuri.

MERIT was established at Delhi in Oct 1999 by GMS, to impart computer education, with emphasis on Information Technology. It has been accredited to the National Council for Vocational Training for conducting Computer Operator & Programming Assistant course (COPA) since 2008. More than 600 students have been trained in COPA with pass percentage of over 99%. It is also a Programme Study Centre of IGNOU for conducting their distance education courses in BCA/MCA/IT Skill etc and a testing centre for Test of English as a foreign language (TOEFL since 2007) and Graduate Record Examination (GRE since 2013). It became an IGNOU Exam Centre in 2014 for conducting exams for all the programmes offered by IGNOU. As an incentive, no fees are charged from Mohyal students admitted to COPA course in MERIT. Mohyal students, who get admission in MERIT study Centre for BCA & MCA courses of IGNOU, are reimbursed 50% of the fees.

We have fixed assets in the form of Ashrams/Bhawans at Haridwar, Vrindavan, Goverdhan, Inderpuri, Mohyal Foundation and Yamuna Nagar. It is a matter of great pride, that no loans have been taken to create these assets, which has been done through contributions, received from the Community. Portion of phase 1 of Mohyal Foundation has been given on rent for Rs Eleven lacs per month, less 10% given to DDA, wef 16 Jan 2019, which is a major source of our income and is used to fund the welfare projects of the community. Property, B-64 Defence Colony Meerut, donated to GMS by late Major Amar Nath Chhibber, has been given on rent for Rs 17,000/- pm. This property is being looked after by Col S.K. Vaid, President Mohyal Sabha Meerut, for which we are grateful to him.

We have been able to create these assets over a period of time. I quote our revered leader, great visionary, late Mohyal Ratna Rzd B D Bali Ji, former President GMS, who said, "The Community has made tremendous progress over the years which has been possible because of our unity and that should be maintained at all costs". We also wish to put on record, the services rendered by Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM (Retd), former President GMS, 11 Aug 2019 to 4 Sep 2021, who did not contest the last Managing Committee elections, on account of old age. It is a matter of great honour for the community that we had such a senior officer to head our organization and we learn't a great deal from him. We always look forward to his guidance and blessings, and will continue to be in touch with him.

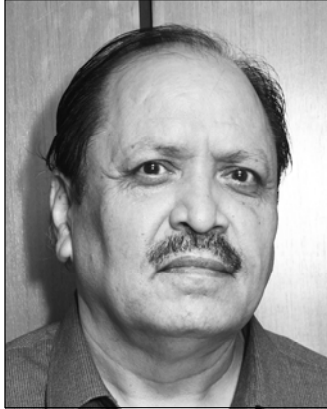

# ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING 13 NOVEMBER 2022

## Report by the Secretary Finance GMS Accounts and Budget Proposals

GMS was founded at Lahore on 24 May 1891 by our illustrious forefathers amongst them was late Shri Ganesh Dutt, grand-father of Shri Vinod Kumar Dutt, President GMS and it has completed 131 years of its glorious existence and service to the community and humanity. It is a proud moment for all present in this august meeting. Thereafter, Shri Ashok Chhibber presented the audited accounts i.e. Income and Expenditure Statement and Balance Sheet for the Financial Year 2021-22, ended on 31.03.2022, copies of which were sent to all the members along with the notice of meeting and Budget proposals for the Financial Year 2022-23 sent by speed post on 5 Oct 2022.



Shri Ashok Chhibber stated that GMS is registered under the Indian Societies Act, 1860, and under Section 12AA of Income Tax Act, 1961 as "charitable" institution. Accordingly, regular books of accounts are being maintained as per the requirements of the legal provisions of the above noted two Acts and were audited by the Chartered Accountants M/s. H.S. Ahuja & Company who after thorough examination and scrutiny have certified as follows.

"We have examined the balance sheet of GENERAL MOHYAL SABHA (REGD) AAATG5350R (name and PAN of the trust or institution) as at 31.03.2022 and the Income and Expenditure account for the year ended on that date which are in agreement with the books of account maintained by the said trust or institution.

We have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of the audit. In our opinion, proper books of account have been kept by the head office and the branches of the above-named trust visited by us so far as appears from our examination of the books, and proper Returns adequate for the purposes of audit have been received from branches not visited by us subject to the comments given below.

In our opinion and to the best of our information, and according to explanations given to us, the said accounts give a true and fair view:-

- In case of the balance sheet of the state of affairs of the above-named trust as at 31.03.2022.
- In the case of the Income and Expenditure account, of the Income and Expenditure of its accounting year ending on 31.03.2022.

Explaining the salient features of the accounts, he submitted that main source of income is from rent which during the year 2021-22 was Rs 1,23,47,500/-. Income from general donations was Rs.1,19,81,242.56, in the year 2021-22. Income from bank deposits was Rs. 60,62,586/-, year 2021-22 which was low mainly on account of lowering of fixed deposit rates by the Banks. Similarly, subscription and membership fee declined Rs 1,32,337/- mainly due to Covid-19. During the aforesaid year income from tuition fees/grant was Rs 45,37,301.83. Contribution from Indira Gandhi Open University was Rs 20,52,524/-. Affiliation Fee was Rs 72,000/-. The corpus fund of the trusts stood at Rs 9,40,08,400.97, as on 31.03.2021. Number of trusts, as on 31 March 2022, is as follows:

After giving analysis of the main sources of income, Shri Ashok Chhibber analyzed the salient features of expenditure during the year. Pension to widows was given to the tune of Rs. 48,93,000/- to 479 widows in the year 2021-22. Relief and welfare to Needy and Destitutes was to the tune of Rs.12,79,000/- in the year 2021-22 to 94 beneficiaries. Financial aid for education was to the tune of Rs. 4,89,000/- in the year 2021-22 to 46 beneficiaries. Relief and welfare by way of free Langar at the Ashrams was to the tune of Rs. 29,10,445/- in the year 2021-22. Expenditure on staff welfare stood at Rs. 97,054/- in the year 2021-22. Further an amount of Rs. 92,40,312/- was spent on account of establishment in the year 2021-22. A sum of Rs. 18,53,692/- was spent on Building Repair and

Maintenance in the year 2021-22 and Rs. 11,02,439/- was spent on property tax in the year 2021-22. A sum of Rs. 3,01,396/- was spent on insurance of buildings in the year 2021-22. A sum of Rs. 7,61,250/- was spent towards lease and ground rent of Mohyal Foundation building in the year 2021-22.

Coming to the budget proposals, Shri Ashok Chhibber submitted that a sum of Rs.90,00,000/- has been earmarked for widows welfare; Rs.20,00,000/- has been earmarked for relief fund. A sum of Rs.70,00,000/- for MERIT; a sum of Rs. 1,10,00,000/- for Ashram Fund at Haridwar; a sum of Rs. 63,00,000/- for Vrindavan Ashram; provisions of Rs. 3,00,000/- Yamuna Nagar Community Hall Fund. Similarly adequate funds have been provided under different heads in the detailed budget. The budget estimates for the Financial Year 2022-23 shows a surplus of Rs. 1,20,842.50 (Receipts Rs. 7,58,99,842.50 and expenditure Rs. 7,57,79,000/-).

In conclusion he reiterated that the accounts of the GMS are being maintained most meticulously both in traditional form by Double Entry Book Keeping as well as through computer and every paisa of money received and expenses incurred have been duly accounted for as per the statutory provisions and under the guidance of expert chartered accountants. He called upon the members to donate generously and augment the various funds of the Sabha by opening Trusts in the memory of their ancestors and dear and near ones. Only interest on trust money is used for activities of the GMS keeping the capital intact. He further added that these Trusts are a matter of sacred faith and all possible care has been taken to maintain these and carry out the wishes of the donors in letter and spirit. The way the Community has added to the number of Trusts and the Trust Money reflects the confidence of the Community in the working and credibility of the GMS under the visionary, dedicated and devoted leadership of our late illustrious President Mohyal Ratna Rzd B.D. Bali, which has been continued by Shri Vinod Kumar Dutt, President GMS

He further added that Trusts are being augmented and money added every day by more and more donors. Trust money is sacred, eternal and perpetual; the donations are put in fixed deposits and only interest accrued thereon is utilized for the purpose for which the Trust is created. He exhorted the Audience to be proud of the legacy of our illustrious and farsighted forefathers and count on their blessings and put concerted efforts to carry on the rich legacy for further generations to come.

After giving item wise explanations in the audited accounts and the budget proposals, Shri Ashok Chhibber, put the following six resolutions to vote which were passed unanimously.

Lie baby face down across your lap when holding or burping. Place a hand on baby's bottom to help calm them.



#### Eye Level Smile

#### Tummy to Tummy

Place baby on your chest or tummy so that baby is face to face with you. Lay down flat or propped up on pillows. Always hold firmly for safety.

Slide one hand between baby's legs and stomach. Use other hand to support baby's head and neck. Nestle baby close to you for comfort and support.

### B. ABOVE 3 MONTHS

Place safe objects and toys close to your baby. Move them from side to side in front of your baby's face. This encourages your baby to move, lift and turn their head

Get down on the floor next to your baby. Turn pages in picture books or magazines. This develops your baby's eye strength and keeps them interested.

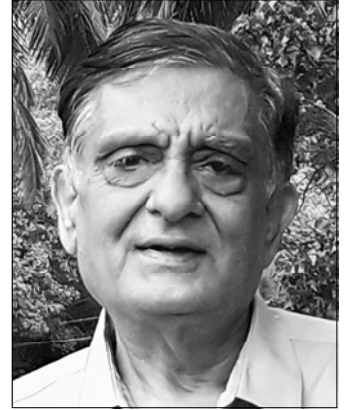
## Shri Ashok Datta

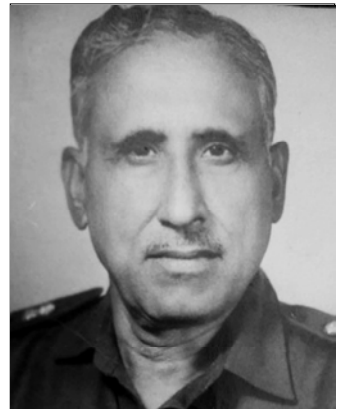

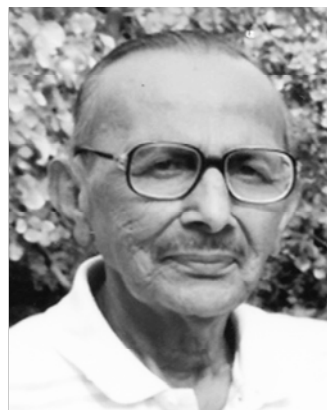

## MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatri, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran .
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Online booking facility for rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar is not available. Rooms can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
14. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar, is available only to yatri's staying in the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Yatri's and NO other activity is permitted.
18. In case of any inconvenience, Yatri's are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / Office bearer of GMS. Yatri's are requested to fill the feedback form before their departure.
19. Yatri's are requested to help in keeping the rooms and the premises of the Ashram clean. Yatri's are also requested to maintain decorum, while dealing with the staff posted at the Ashrams.
20. Yatri's are requested to follow Covid 19 guidelines as per existing orders of the local government authorities.
