#### OPEN FORUM

(a) **Population Census of Mohyals** The modalities of carrying out the Population Census which is to be completed by 31 March 2018, were discussed in detail. Members of the local Sabhas will have to physically contact all mohyals in their areas and get the Census forms filled. Shri Ashok Chhibber, Secretary will coordinate and monitor the progress made. The broad guidelines for recording the data were formalised as under.

(i) Head of the Family would be each married person ie parent, son and daughter and his/her family would be the spouse and the dependent children. Therefore each Head of Family would fill a separate form .

(ii) The Local Sabhas are not only to collect data in respect of Mohyals residing in their territorial jurisdiction but also make strenuous efforts to collect data of Mohyals in adjoining areas which are not covered by an affiliated Local Sabha.

(iii) Local Sabhas may also contact other Mohyals who may be known to them and are staying in any part of our country or even abroad and are not covered by a Local Sabha.

(v) Local Sabhas may choose/nominate after persuasively coopting selected members of their Sabha to help in this task and may reimburse to some extent towards their transportation costs in executing this work from within their resources. Any assistance required from GMS in this respect would be available and could be availed off.

# MERIT

## NEWS

1. With the persistent follow up with the Directorate of Training & Technical Education (DTTE) of Delhi Government, we were able to obtain data of about 9000 applicants, who had applied online for various trades in the Government ITI's. By sending bulk SMS's to these applicants, and by pursuing with the nearby Government ITI's, we were able to boost our admissions, both in our COPA Course as well as the IGNOU course of BCA (Bachelor of Computer Application).
2. As a result of our efforts, our IGNOU Study Centre (07162), was allocated 108 students for BCA 1<sup>st</sup> Semester. Besides, 35 students were allocated for the MCA (Master of Computer Application) 1<sup>st</sup> Semester, 45 students for PGCGI (Post Graduate Certificate in Geo Informatics) and 11 students for CCITSK (Certificate Course on IT Skills), for the July – Dec 2017 session. Together with the students earlier allocated for the other semesters of BCA and MCA, the total number of IGNOU students in our Study Centre has gone up to about 400.
3. The Induction Meeting for the newly admitted students of IGNOU was held in MERIT premises on the 9<sup>th</sup> September 2017, which was largely attended by the students. Dr. D.B. Damle, Regional Director, RC-1 Delhi, participated as the Chief Guest. Besides, Dr. Benidahr Deshmukh and Dr. Kakoli Gogoi of the PGCGI Department of IGNOU, also attended. The Chief Guest and the other two representatives from IGNOU were received with bouquets and presented with mementoes.
4. After the self-introduction by the students, Shri Tusar Ranjan Sarangi, Programme-in-Charge of our Study Centre, gave the welcome address and made a presentation detailing the various activities of MERIT and the courses being conducted here. The students were then addressed by Dr. Rattan Datta, Director, MERIT, Dr. Benidhar Deshmukh, Coordinator, PGCGI Programme and Dr. D.B. Damle Regional Director, IGNOU, highlighting the various aspects of the IGNOU programmes. The meeting concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Shri S. Ranganathan, Chief Administrative Officer, MERIT, followed by the serving of light refreshments to all participants. The classes for these students commenced from the same date, i.e., the 9<sup>th</sup> September 2017. Classes for the other Semester students of BCA/MCA had already commenced earlier and are continuing.
5. We had an intake of 59 students for the COPA Course, August 2017 session. Two students are mohyals, Ms Pratima Datta and Ms Geeta Bakshi. A Freshers' Party for these students was organized in our premises on the 13th September 2017, in which, besides the faculty and members of staff, the Director, MERIT, and Mrs. Meena Datta also participated. Based on the



- performances, dress sense, body language and replies given to questions put to them by a panel of judges, Mr. Abinav Kanojia and Ms. Saloni Chandna, were declared winners and were presented with mementoes.
6. On the occasion of the 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Swami Vivekanand's famous Chicago Address, our Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, addressed the students all over the country through a nationally televised programme, on 11th September 2017. Arrangements were made in MERIT for the live webcast of the PM's speech, which was witnessed by our students.

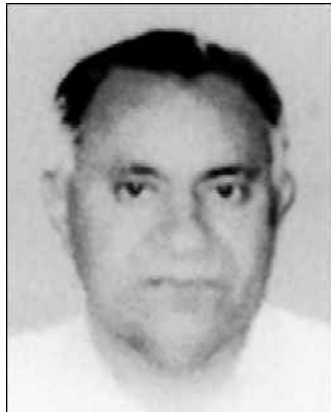

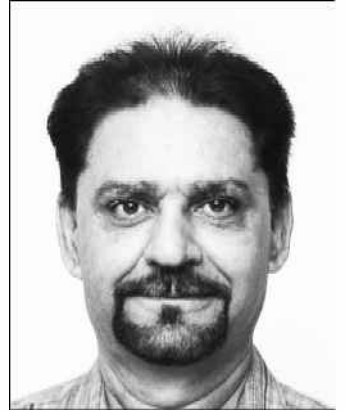

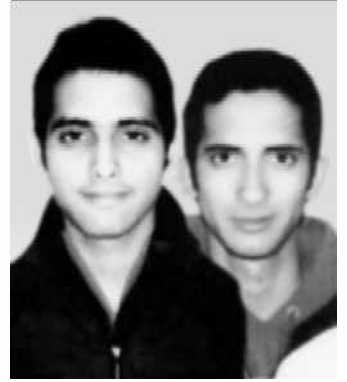

# BODY LANGUAGE AND OTHER ATTRIBUTES

Here are some guides to help prospective candidates, when they are called for interview by the Services Selection Board.

## Body Language

What is body language? It has been described as physical behaviour, as opposed to words, which are used to express or convey information. Such behaviour includes facial expressions, body posture, gestures, eye movement, touch and the use of space. Body language exists in both animals and humans, but here the focus is on interpretations of human body language. It is also known as kinesics.

It may be described as sum total of the overall impression that an individual conveys by his composure, demeanor and behaviour such as the manner in which he holds himself, looks at his interlocutor, the general air of confidence that he exudes and so on.

How to inculcate positive 'body language'. Try to learn how to stand without slouching and how to walk with confidence as against loitering. Cultivate a good carriage. Observe and copy somebody whose posture you admire – an actor or a person in real life. Seek help from an elder to teach you and check you. Most of us do not know as to what impression we convey by our "chal-dhal". We can't see ourself. If possible get a friend to take a video of you walking around which will tell you what your walk etc appear to others. It is also expressed as "presence".

## Eye contact

It is important to learn how to interact with others. Make a confident contact with another person. Make proper eye contact without being haughty or a 'show off' and give an impression that he has your full attention, whether to ask him or tell him some thing. Indeed, eye contact is an important part of body language. Look straight into his eye, not down or in a shifty eyed manner.

## Speech

How you speak or more important "how your speech will sound to the others". It is an essential part of body language. Learn proper 'voice modulation'. Record your speech and play it back to yourself. It often comes as an eye opener to most of us. Again, you have to take the trouble to learn to speak in an audible and coherent manner. Cultivate a good tone of voice. Again, select a role model. Watch for his correct pronunciation and his technique of proper pauses, emphases and so on. It takes a life time study and practice. It is amazing that we don't pay enough attention to learning to communicate properly, which plays such an important part in our life.

## Over all attitude

Lastly, remember that your body language and the manner of your speech, reflects your ability and attitude. It plays an important part in assessment, in a services selection board where you are watched by the assessors like hawks, all the time.

## EDUCATION LOAN SCHEME

I have retired from the services of OBC as chief manager. For the benefit of Mohyal youth pursuing higher education I am giving hereunder the list of education loan scheme of banks. Under this scheme called "Education Loan Scheme" loan is available at very affordable rates and on very simple terms that too without having to undergo too much of formalities. This scheme has been devised by IBA.

1. **Purpose** To provide financial support to meritorious students for pursuing higher studies in India & Abroad with affordable terms and conditions.
  2. **Eligible courses—Studies In India**
    - (a) Approved courses leading to Graduate/Post Graduate degree and post graduate diplomas conducted by recognized colleges/Universities approved/accredited by government of India/State Government/UGC/AICTE/AIBMS/ICMR or regulatory bodies.
    - (b) Courses like ICWA, CA, CFA etc
    - (c) Courses conducted by IIM's, IITs, IISc, XLRI, NIFT, NID etc.
    - (d) Approved courses offered in India by reputed foreign Universities.
  3. **Eligible Courses—Studies abroad**
    - (a) Graduation—For job oriented professional/technical courses offered by reputed universities.
    - (b) Post graduation courses like MCA, MBA, MS etc.
    - (c) Conducted by CIMA—London CPA in USA etc.
  4. **Components of Finance** Fee payable to college / hostel fee / examination fee / library and laboratory fee / security deposit/ travel expenses for studies abroad and bus fare for studies in India /Purchase of computers /Books uniform/ etc.
  5. **Amount of loan**
    - (a) For Category "A" Courses (Explained later)—Rs.25/ Lakh without collateral.
    - (b) For Category "B" Rs.10/ Lakh without collateral security and for other courses as per fee structure of institution.
  6. **Rate of Interest** Category "A" and "B" courses 8.45% and 8.95% pa respectively. For other courses it is between 9.95% and 10.45%.
  7. **Interest Subsidy** Under the "central scheme of interest subsidy on education loans" Full interest subsidy is available to students whose gross annual family income is up to Rs.4.50lakh. this is available during the moratorium period only i.e. Up to one year from the date of completion of course or six month from the date of getting a job whichever is earlier. This is available for studies in India only.
  8. **Margin** Category "A" and category "B" courses—NIL For other courses—Up to Rs.4/ lakh NIL—above Rs.4 Lakh—5% for studies in India and 15% for studies abroad.
  9. **Security clause** For Category "A" and "B"—No collateral security is required. For other courses—up to Rs.4/ lakh—NIL; above Rs.4/ LAKH AND UPTO Rs.7.5 lakh—personal guarantee of one satisfactory third party. And above Rs.7.5 lakh—Mortgage of immovable property or any other tangible security having value equivalent to 100% of loan amount.
  10. **Co-obligants** Father and Mother of the borrower and In laws in case of married women have to be made co obligants in all the education loans.
  11. **Category "A" courses** at present there are 41 courses listed under this category like IIMs IITs BITS and others the list can be downloaded from website of OBC "www.obcindia.co.in"
  12. **Category "B" courses** there are presently 71 courses like IIFT, ICFAI, NIT again a complete list may be downloaded from above website.
  13. A concession of 0.50% pa is available for girl students also a concession of 1% pa is available to all students who service the interest every month during the moratorium period.
  14. **Repayment Upto 15 years** Repayment starts after one year from the date of completion of course or six month after the student getting the job whichever is earlier.
  15. Simple interest is charged during the moratorium period and thereafter compound interest is charged.
  16. An application received under this scheme cannot be declined by Branch concerned without the concurrence/ permission of their respective controlling office. Still it is desirable to apply on line.
  17. It is better if the loan is applied online this will remove the chances of delay in processing.
  18. A student can apply only to a bank near his place of domicile e.g. a student of Faridabad pursuing study at Mumbai has to apply at Faridabad.
- So one will appreciate that finance is no problem for meritorious and deserving students. Still in case any Mohyal student finds any problem in sanction of education loan he/she/parents may contact me and I shall help them complete the process.

There are two types of

Brahmins Yayawats and Shaleen. Yayawats were those who did rituals and pujapath. ...Shaleens were Bhoopati Brahmans—Mahipal in sanskrit meaning owner of land Mahiwals, etymology of the word Mohyal. G.D. Bakshiji shared that he had the opportunity of visiting the 'Indian Space Research Organisation' where he saw the Satellite mapping of river Sarawati which showed a width of 5 to 8 kms and abundant waters.

It was a mighty River which started from Shivaliks. In 1900 BCE a massive earthquake lifted the region of the Shivaliks. Saraswati flowed from Shivaliks passed thru Kurukshetra region, Rajasthan, Sindh Province and emptied into the Arabian Sea in the Rann of Kutch being its Delta. This mighty river disappeared due to movement of the Earths tectonic plates which made some its tributaries now known as the five rivers of Panjab. Saraswati is the cradle of Indian Civilization. The Mohyals are also known as Saraswat brahmins due to the fact our clans settled and lived on the banks of the River Saraswati.

King Porus too was a Mohyal. Puru Vaid a Great Mohyal King who fought with Alexander. It is said Porus had a massive physique...he was 7 ft tall Mohyals were looked upon with honour by the Greeks.

The Mohyal clans established themselves in the areas along with the river banks some went back with greeks and settled along the way in Afghanistan Iran along the Indus Valley Civilization.

They continued to keep their clan relationships by intermarrying in their seven clans only.

G.D. Bakshiji shared that he got an invite from Patna last month by the Shia Muslims alongwith Gen. B.K.N. Chhibber former Governor of Punjab to honour the Mohyals for our association with Prophet Hussain. Mohyals are also known as Hussainy Brahmins non - muslims.

3. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis for a maximum of 3 days. Checkout time is 12 noon.
4. Booking Amount is Rs.300/ per room. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The deposit can be refunded or kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
5. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior approval of GMS.
6. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashram is strictly prohibited.

## IN MEMORIAM

■ **Shri Balbir Datta (17 Dec 1946–11 Sep 2016):** 11<sup>th</sup> September 2017 marks the first anniversary, of the passing away of Shri Balbirji Datta, an inspirational visionary & 'Karam Yogi' in the global Mohyal community. He was a very proud and ardent Mohyal, and a substantial donor. Born on 17 Dec 1946 in pre partition Fatehpur, Balbirji



was the eldest son of late Shri Iqbal Rai Datta from Kanjroor and late Smt Rama Rani Datta. In a life dominated by travel, at only a few months of age, he crossed the Indian Ocean by ship with his family to start a new life in Kenya. He undertook his early studies in India where he proved to be outstanding in academics gaining entry to the prestigious IIT Delhi to read engineering. After completing degrees in Engineering and Masters in Business from UK Universities in Bradford and Aston, he was appointed the youngest ever director in an industrial British company - an incredible feat for an Indian in the late 1960s. Balbirji was an exceptionally entrepreneurial & innovative personality and before reaching 25 yrs he had already bought his own home in UK. With an sense of adventure, Balbirji lead a party of four to drive from the UK to India crossing many countries in Europe & Asia along the way. It was with the same group of friends that Balbirji formed 'Hindu Swayamsevak Sangh', the UK branch of RSS in the late 1960s.

In 1974 Shri Balbirji married Smt Sunita Datta, daughter of late Shri Devi Das Vaid & Smt Shanti Vaid of Ludhiana and decided to commence married life with his extended family in Nairobi. In 1983, he took responsibility for moving his extended family out of politically unstable Kenya to the UK with his wife and 3 young children. By now he had successfully progressed a career working for multi-national companies but being very free spirited he yearned to create his own business ventures. He lead the development of highly successful family mushroom farming businesses in India, Kenya and later in the UK. His incredible powers of persuasion enabled him to secure land and development grants to create a highly innovative farm in inner London. Once he and Sunitaji had successfully settled their 3 Children, to enjoy hugely successful professional careers and family lives, at the age of 50yrs he decided to retire from business. He wanted to use his incredible armoury of skills to build capacity amongst the most underprivileged communities in India. He had a strong belief that improving the lives & dignity of fellow humans less fortunate than himself was his true calling in life.

In the early 2000s ably assisted by Sunitaji, Balbirji worked closely with with BJP founder Padmabhushan Shri Nanaji Deshmukh to support the work of Deendayal Research Foundation. By bringing highly skilled UK professionals and their abundant skills, he was able to build the capacities of local people in villages in Chitrakoot. This has lead to the admirable work carried out today by the Chitrakoot Health care Charity in the UK. In 2006, Balbirji formed a UK charity, Rama Foundation in the memory of his late mother. Over 10 yrs under Balbirjis leadership as CEO and very ably assisted by Sunitaji and his children (as trustees) the charity has benefitted thousands of underprivileged children in Rishikesh and Haridwar through initiatives in education, health and nutrition. Motivated by Balbirji, hundreds of volunteers in the UK & India have given their precious time and resources to support the work of Rama Foundation and it's partner charities in India & the UK.

Balbirji was a distinguished human being with a very unique set of characteristics rarely found in combination in one person. Above all else he was supremely self less. Of the many legacies he is remembered by, he will be most proud of the charitable work he has bequeathed to the volunteers in all the charities he was involved with. In October 2016, hundreds of Balbirjis family, friends and charity partners gathered in UK and India to pay tribute to him. We celebrate Balbirjis incredible life and use it as an eternal example to continue to unleash the full potential of our skills and resources to act at grass roots level for the betterment of underprivileged people. 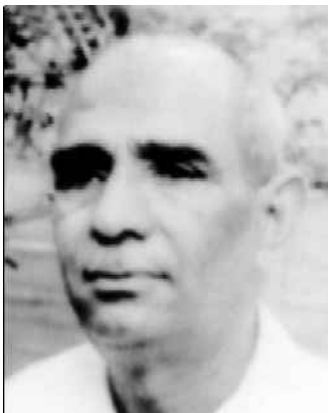

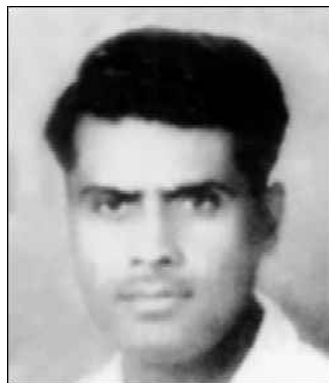
