SPECIAL RESOLUTION PROPOSED, PASSED AND ADOPTED IN THE MANAGING COMMITTEE MEETING OF GENERAL MOHYAL SABHA(REGD) NEW DELHI, HELD AT MOHYAL FOUNDATION ON 9 SEP 2018

SPECIAL RESOLUTION

The Managing Committee authorizes Rzd B D Bali, President, Shri P.K. Datta, Vice President, Lt Col L R Vaid, Secretary General, Shri Sushil Chhibber, Secretary Finance or any other member nominated by the President, to lease the Ground Floor, First Floor and Second Floor in Mohyal Foundation Phase 1, including the front compound with separate entrance and parking area, to a suitable party on terms and conditions, as mutually agreed between the parties, on best available terms and rent mutually agreed to between the parties, ensuring that the interests of GMS are fully safeguarded and protected in all respects, and to negotiate and enter into said Deed of Lease and sign the same.

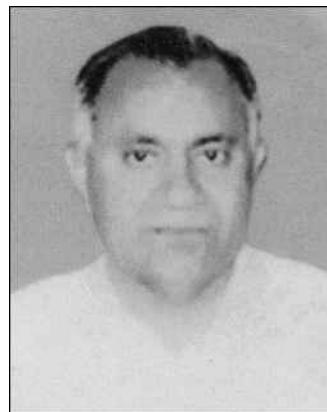

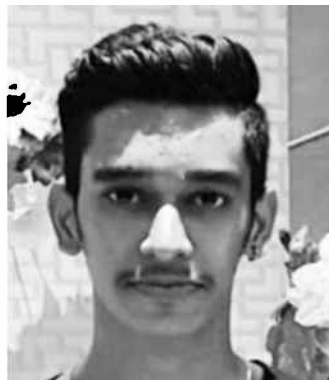

Dr Rohit Chhiber: The Young Mohyal Scientist

Parents do feel proud and elated when the young in the family achieve success in what they set out to accomplish. Col Pran Chhiber, President MS Jaipur and Smt Deepti Chhiber found yet another such an occasion when their elder son Dr Rohit Chhiber, grandson of Major JK Chhiber and Mrs Raj Chhiber of Jodhpur completed his PhD in Physics from University of Delaware USA with his Thesis Title "Studies in Multiscale turbulent dynamics of the Solar Wind". To add another feather to his cap Dr Rohit's proposal for further research in pure science with particular reference to "Solar Physics" has been accepted for full funding by NASA, USA. Dr Rohit now looks forward to an enviable and a fruitful stint with NASA, USA at their Maryland Washington NASA facility. On this happy occasion the proud parents Col Pran Chhiber and Smt Deepti Chhiber donated Rs 1000/- to MS Jaipur and Rs 1000/- to GMS.

Dr Rohit has a rich portfolio of early accomplishments. While completing his schooling from Army Public School Ahmednagar, he topped his class and was amongst the top 1% students of CBSE at an all India level who had scored the highest. After completing his graduation with Physics (honours) from Jaipur, he enrolled himself for his Masters in Pure Science (Physics) at the prestigious Jawaharlal Nehru University. On completing his Masters, his efforts to further enroll himself for a PhD programme got him an invitation to pursue his research aspirations from Indian Institute of Science. But he had his aims set still higher and because of his excellent results in JNU, he was invited to enroll himself into a PhD programme with full scholarship at University of Delaware USA. While pursuing his PhD Dr Rohit was fortunate to get multiple opportunities to acquire insights into his research from his interaction with groups of scientists and researchers from across the world whom he met while attending various scientific conferences and workshops conducted under the aegis of various prestigious educational Institutions at different cities and states of USA.

It was the hard and dedicated work and late hours put in during numerous nights to write high quality Research Papers, which was taken note of by the editorial committee of highly reputed and internationally acclaimed "American Scientific Journal" and many research papers written by Dr Rohit Chhiber were published in the American scientific journal. In addition to excelling in academics and research Dr Rohit is a keen photographer, a self taught and an enthusiastic guitar player, and an active outdoor personality. He took out time from his studies while doing his PHD to frequently visit a number of trekking and camping sites in different parts of the USA to pursue his extracurricular and outdoor activities. Dr Rohit has been greatly influenced by his most revered Dada ji, Maj J K Chhiber and has been a staunch mohyal from his early childhood days. He always made it a point to attend all the Mohyal Sabha meetings with his Dada ji whenever he visited his grandparents at Jodhpur. He was probably amongst the first few mohyal children, pan India, to become a permanent member of Mohyal Mitter as well as Life Member of the General Mohyal Sabha. A copy of Mohyal Mitter was being posted to him regularly even while he was in USA doing his PhD.

Dr Rohit Chhiber will continue to be a source of inspiration to the Mohyal youth. Our best wishes go out to this young scientist from the Mohyal Community for his endeavours in pursuing his research aspirations both during his stint with NASA and subsequent years of his life.

Chand, who passed away in 2003. He worked in Hindustan

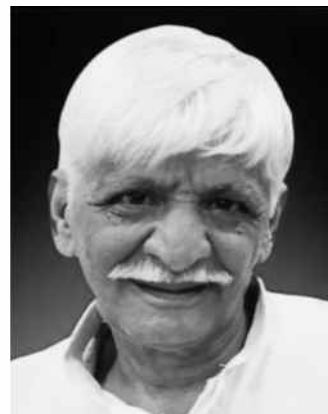

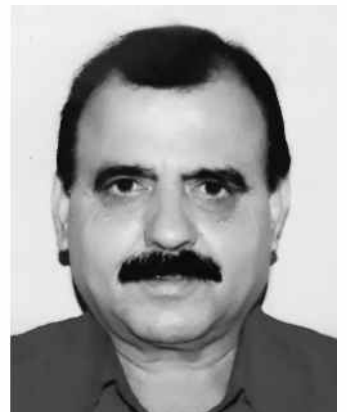

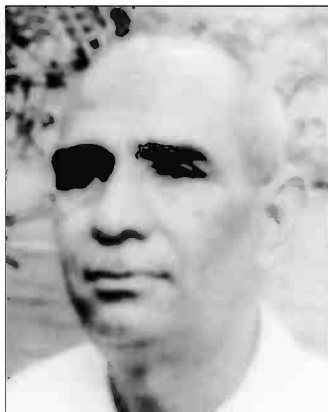

2. Bookings can also be done on telephone and at the counter.
3. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
4. Bookings can be done after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The deposit can be refunded or kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
5. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
6. Room donors will be charged 25% of the standard room rates (Non Mohyal rates)
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashram is strictly prohibited.
8. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall.
10. Pets (Animals) are not allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Guests are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant , of each room.
12. Guests are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to Guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Online booking facility for rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar is not available. Rooms can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
14. In case of any inconvenience Guests are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / GMS.
15. Guests are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
16. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram .
17. Facility of free langar is available , only to residents of the Ashram .
