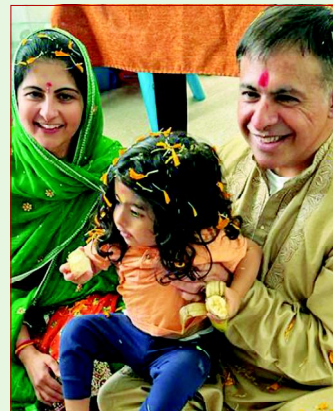

He was adorable and lovable to everybody having very fair and charming face with brown hair, and was fondly known by his nick name as “Chann”. He was very

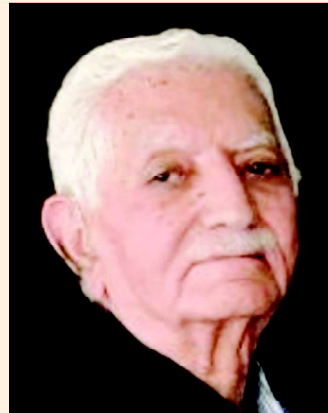

Shri Sharad Chhibber

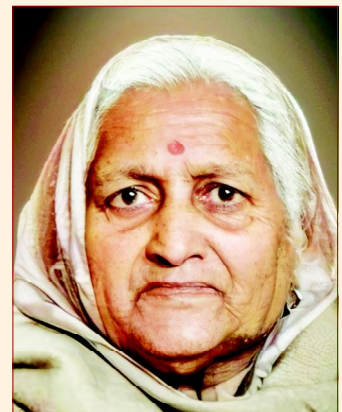
