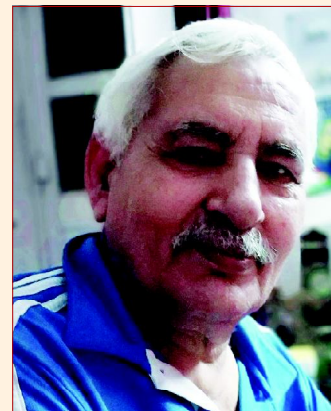


Rzd Baldev Kumar Bali

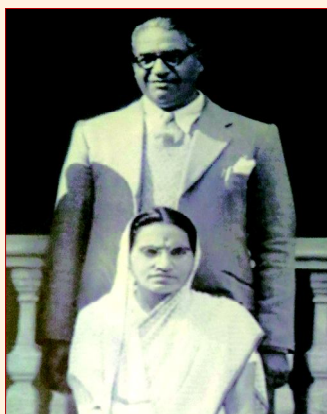

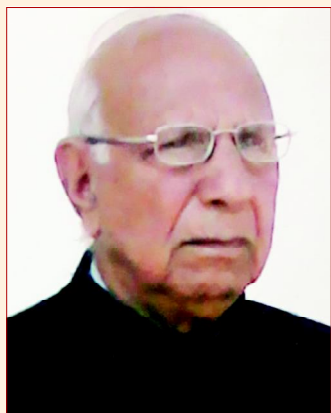

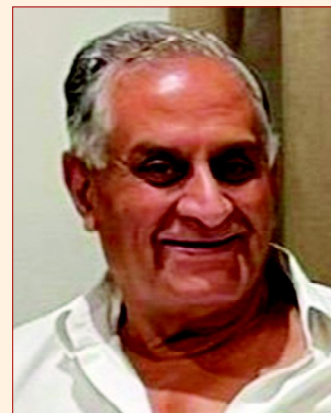
Smt Kiran Bakshi (Vaid)
