2. Bookings can also be done on telephone and at the counter.
3. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
4. Bookings can be done after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The deposit can be refunded or kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
5. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
6. Room donors will be charged 25% of the standard room rates (Non Mohyal rates)
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashram is strictly prohibited.
8. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall.

IN MEMORIAM

■ **Smt Krishna Mohan and Vishwa Mitra Mohan:** Dr Vishwa Mitra Mohan, not just a “Dad”, but the backbone of our family. Born in Zaffarwal Duttan on 2nd April, 1927,



he moved to Delhi after the upheaval of 1947. He was a self-made man of dignity, who lived an honest life, working hard till his last days. Having lost his parents, father Mehta Gokul Chand Mohan and mother Durga Vati Mohan, along with his younger brother, during the partition, he accepted his loss and the trauma of partition. Taking this challenge, he moved forward to give himself the best he could. He made sure he completed his education from Graduation to Masters and then Doctorate. Also did a specialized course in Education from Norway (Oslo), excelling everywhere he went. Education and Sports were his field. He served the Education department of MP in Bhopal, and was the Additional Director of education for MP, when he left us on 16 Jan 1984. In addition to his government job he was also the elected President of “School Games Federation of India” and the “MP education officers’ association”. He was also the State Chief Commissioner for MP “Bharat Scouts and Guides”.

He was a staunch Mohyal, we still remember he would pick up the telephone directory of Bhopal and call all the numbers listed with the Mohyal surname. He would invite them home for a meal, which eventually enabled him to form/start a Mohyal Sabha in Bhopal. Even today people remember him as a warm, jovial, generous and helpful person who encouraged everyone to be happy under all circumstances. Our memories of the time spent with him will never fade. We feel blessed, to have such a great man as our dear father, who gave us values to respect each and every one, to be humble and honest in life and never give up no matter what challenges we face.

Mrs Krishna Mohan, our humble, quiet loving mom cannot be compared to anyone in this world. Born on 30 October 1933 at Ferozepur (Punjab), she spent her childhood at Paprola, near Dharamshala. Her parents

Devi Dyal Bakshi and Rama Pyari Bakshi were simple hardworking people whose influence stayed with her till her last days. Having lost her father at a young age she was looked after by her brothers, six of them, being elder to her. Her marriage was also arranged by the support and finances of her brothers. Her second brother Mr Prithvi Raj Bakshi made sure she got everything that her father would have provided. Infact after she lost her husband in 1984, her brothers made sure she was not left alone, giving her all support, be it emotional or financial. 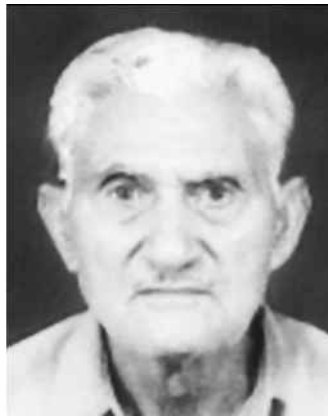

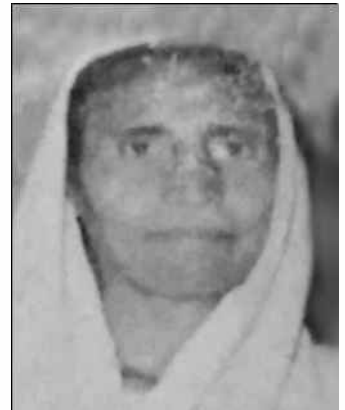

अभिषेकः जल, बेल पत्र, भस्म, यज्ञोपवीत, कुशोदक, दही, गन्ने का रस, चीनी, शहद, घी, दूध, तीर्थ के जल, पंचावृत आदि से किया जाता है। प्रेम भाव से किए गए अलाभिषेक से विद्या, रोजगार, धनधाना की प्राप्ति होती है।

गन्ने का रस, चीनी, शहद चढ़ाने से लक्ष्मी व सौभाग्य की प्राप्ति होती है। घी से मोक्ष, तीर्थ के जल से पित्रों को मोक्ष, चंदन से शान्ति, पंचामृत से, लोभ, मोह व अहंकार का नाश होता है।

धार्मिक मान्यता है कि भगवान् विष्णु के नाभि से उपजे कमल से ब्रह्मा जी की उत्पत्ति हुई, अपनी उत्पत्ति का कारण जानने के लिए जब ब्रह्मात्री, भगवान् विष्णु के पास पहुँचे तो उन्होंने ब्रह्मा जी की उत्पत्ति का रहस्य बताया और कहा कि उन्हीं की वजह से ब्रह्मा जी की उत्पत्ति हुई है। किन्तु ब्रह्मा जी इस कथन को मानने को तैयार नहीं हुए और भगवान् विष्णु से युद्ध करने लगे। दोनों में भयंकर युद्ध हुआ। युगों तक चले इस युद्ध से नाराज भगवान् रुद्र ने लिंग रूप में प्रकट हुए। इस लिंग का आदि अन्त का कहीं पता नहीं चला तो दोनों ने हार मान ली। दोनों ने लिंग का अभिषेक किया जिससे भगवान् ने प्रसन्न होकर दोनों का कल्याण किया। यही से रुद्राभिषेक की परम्परा की शुरुआत मानी जाती है।
