OUR INSPIRATION, MENTOR AND VISIONARY LEADER

Rzd B D Bali Ji, was the tallest and most respected leader of our Community. He nurtured the Community and brought it to the present glory, by dedicating his entire life to uplift the Community, who were devastated and had got scattered, after the unfortunate partition of the country.

Our revered leader, was son of late Rzd Tek Chand Bali and late Smt Leela Wati Bali. He was born on 11 Aug 1930 at Guliyana, Tehsil Gujar Khan, Distt Rawalpindi. He married Smt Nita Bali Ji, daughter of a great legend, late Padma Shri and Mohyal Ratna Shri N.N. Mohan (Founder Mohan Meakin Ltd), and Smt Ram Rakhi Mohan on 1 March 1959. He was blessed with three talented sons, Shri Rajiv Bali, Shri Sanjiv Bali (Vice President GMS) and Shri Monish Bali. Mohyal Ratna, Rzd B D Bali was Chairman, Mount Shivalik Group of Industries.

GMS, the apex body of Mohyals, was established by our forefathers on 24 May 1891 at Lahore. After partition, GMS first shifted to Amritsar in 1947, and then to Delhi in 1955. The first three decades were almost spent in hibernation due to lack of resources. Mohyal Ratna Rzd B D Bali Ji, was elected President of GMS on 20 Aug 1978 and continued to serve the Community till his last breath. His first address to the Community was made on 17 Sep 1978, which is printed in this issue.

Our visionary leader, created landmarks like Mohyal Ashrams at Haridwar and Vrindavan, Bhawans at Inderpuri, Yamuna Nagar and Goverdhan, and schools at Dehradun, Haridwar and MERIT at Mohyal Foundation, which also houses the GMS Secretariat. These assets were created by him through voluntary contributions from the Community. No loans have been taken to create these assets of the Community. We are grateful to members who have contributed Rs 3 lacs or more, for addition of rooms on the Third Floor of Mohyal Ashram Haridwar, which is being inaugurated today. Names of the donors have been printed in this issue.

Bali Sahib's, greatest asset was his Humility. He was a compassionate and understanding person who was easily accessible. We will always remember Bali Sahib, with great Respect and Gratitude, for being a great human being and for the Selfless Services rendered by him for more than four decades and resolve to follow the footsteps and roadmap set by him.
