## START OF NEW COURSES ON JOURNALISM & MASS COMMUNICATION AT MERIT

Newspaper, radio and television broadcasting, which includes the production and transmission of educational, entertaining and news-related programming, is a practical application of audio and video technologies. Broadcasting is both a large and diverse field. Job functions vary by category, company size and personal talent, thus educational requirements also vary. Due to the competitive nature of radio and television broadcasting, getting your foot in the door with a job oriented course at a competitive cost or an internship is a common way to enter the field.

Jobs in these fields range from on-air personnel's, such as correspondents, reporters, anchors and hosts, to behind-the-scenes workers like producers, directors, camera operators and technicians.

**Broadcast journalism** is the field of news and journals which are "broadcast", that is, published by electronic methods instead of the older methods, such as printed newspapers and posters. Broadcast methods include radio (via air, cable, and Internet), television (via air, cable, and Internet) and the World Wide Web. Such media disperse pictures (static and moving), visual text and sounds.

MERIT has launched two courses, one **PG Diploma in RTVJ & New Media (Digital & Social)** and the other **Diploma in Mobile Journalism (MoJo)**. First course is for Graduate's and is for one year duration with a fee of Rs 45000/-. Attached brochure shows the course content. The second course is for undergraduates and is for 6 months with a fee of Rs. 20000/-. Both courses will have internship in the proper TV/Radio or Newspaper domains.

These courses will contribute significantly in meeting the manpower requirements of the electronic media industry in the country. The students are given conceptual understanding, along with training in professional skills by senior professionals of national repute. The syllabus is highly practical-oriented, with strong industry linkages with on the job training. This gives the students a cutting edge over similar courses run by other institutions. The program emphasizes the development of critical thinking, professional writing skills and effective communication. The course prepares students for a wide variety of careers in Television, Radio, New Media, Digital and Social Media.

These courses provide in-depth knowledge and understanding of mass media by professionals and experts. These courses will forklift the skills of an individual to use his/her imagination, creativity & innovation. Provide opportunities to get practical exposure through projects assignments and other curricular activities. Mass communication is pervasive into our life as an indispensable part, through its medium with new Innovations and Improvisations. Television, Newspaper, Radio, Advertising, PR, News portals, Blogs, etc. are such a medium which always has appetite for New and innovative minds with great career opportunities. Social media has brought about the biggest revolution in the way news is produced and consumed. New media is changing the way people across the world are entertained and consume information. This module imparts to the student, the basics of using social media – both from the technology end, and from the ethics and verification perspective.

As a part of the program, students will have exposure to live telecasting of events in the media world.

Media Industry Experts are engaged in imparting education and industrial training to our students. All the experts are led by Mr. Rajneesh Ranjan of News 24 TV.

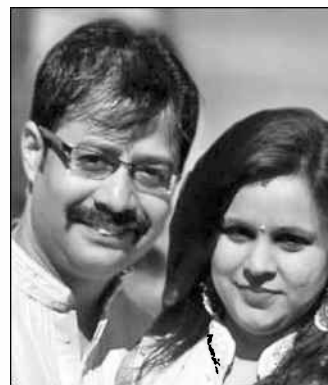

2. Bookings can also be done on telephone and at the counter.
3. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
4. Bookings can be done after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
5. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
