REPORT ON PRESIDENTS AND SECRETARIES MEETING OF AFFILIATED MOHYAL SABHAS HELD AT NEW DELHI ON 17 NOV 2019

The programme started after Registration and Refreshments by the members, who had come for this event having travelled long distances. The traditional lamp was lighted by Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM, President of GMS and honourable members, which was followed by chanting of the Mohyal Prathana by the House, led by Smt Krishan Lata Chhibber, Secretary Matrimonial. Shri Ashok Chhibber, Secretary GMS, explained the administrative arrangements made for the this meeting.

Lt Col L R Vaid, Secretary General, extended a warm welcome to all the members and said that he looked forward to having a fruitful interaction. We all appreciate the tremendous progress made by the community, from being literally unknown after the Partition and now having an identity of our own. This has been possible because of the unity of our great community, which has to be maintained at all costs. We are grateful to our visionary leader, late Rzd B D Bali, who was a great human being and rendered selfless service to uplift the community, for over four decades and created assets for the community for which he will be remembered for generations with great respect. Col Vaid then welcomed Shri Sanjiv Bali, son of late Rzd B D Bali and said that he was very talented and dynamic person, a very successful entrepreneur whose multi skills will help the community in its march forward. Col Vaid said that God is great. He has taken away one gem from us, but has given us another gem in Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM, our President, who was born on 31 July 1936 at Ahmedgarh (undivided Punjab), excelled in studies, joined the Army where he held several prestigious appointments. Post retirement, he was happily settled at Noida with his close knit family, was President MS Noida since Jan 1998 when Bali Sahib spotted him and motivated him to become an active member of GMS, made him fight the GMS Managing Committee elections in 2015 and he joined his team as Sr Vice President of GMS. Col Vaid then invited Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM, President GMS, to give the welcome address.

Gen Bakshi warmly welcomed the Presidents and Secretaries of affiliated mohyal sabha's and said, that todays meeting was an important event where we will discuss and evolve

programmes for the welfare of our community, and also take stock of our ongoing welfare projects. He said that he was looking forward to hearing them and getting to know their ideas and thoughts, since they were connected at the grassroots level and knew the community well. Local Sabha's were the backbone and limbs of the GMS and therefore their feedback was very important in order to reach out to the underprivileged members of our community and help in formulating the welfare projects for the benefit of the community. Gen Bakshi fondly remembered late Rzd B.D Bali and the tremendous progress made by the community under his guidance and leadership, and appealed to the community to remain united and work in the best interests of our dynamic community.

Col Vaid then explained the conduct of the programme and requested the speakers to be brief so that everyone could get a chance to give their views. He informed the House that Shri Vinod Dutt, Vice President GMS, could not (d) Skill training be organized for the youth and come for the meeting since his wife was very unwell. Members prayed for her early recovery. He then requested the members to share their views on the following subjects which had been circulated to them earlier.

Subjects for Discussion

- 1. Welfare Activities How to improve our welfare activities, in order to provide substantial aid / relief to the needy members of our community ie support to widows, support children for their education and medical relief to the needy.
- 2. Our Institutions There is a need to streamline functioning of our Institutions to make them financially self sustainable, (j) without losing our charitable status.

3. Projects in hand

- (a) Mohyal Bhawan at Yamuna Nagar Utilisation and early completion, for which donations are solicited.
- (b) Expansion of Mohyal Ashram at Haridwar Utilisation and early commencement of the construction, for which donations are solicited.

4. Mohyaliat What does it mean, how to further strengthen it and reach out to the less privileged members of our community. Consider, each one of us devoting 10% of our skills/time/wealth etc. in order to develop a healthy mohyal community.

The following points emerged after discussion

- (a) Affiliation fee of the local Sabha's be increased to Rs 1000/- per year wef 1 Jan 2020 .Shri Vikas Bali, Secretary MS Chandigarh deposited the fee, which was accepted with grateful thanks and thus MS Chandigarh became the first Sabha to give the revised affiliation fee.
- (b) Interaction Committees should be strengthened and programmed to make contact at the grassroots level.
- (c) Modern mohyal history should be written covering the period after the Partition.
- young widows.
- (e) Neighboring Sabha's should have close interaction with each other.
- (f) Form a committee to study and recommend, on steps to be taken to make our Institutions self sustainable.
- (g) Review the langar fund donations at our ashrams.
- (h) Form a committee to review and energize the financial status of our organization.
- Charges for the extra mattress taken by the yatris at our Ashrams needs a relook.
- Youth Camps be organized for different age groups and should have activities of interest to them.
- Members be encouraged to Adopt Widows and children for education. Shri Vipin Mohan, President MS Yamuna Nagar, has made a beginning by adopting one widow for one year through GMS.
- Financial help given to widows and children be increased. Students availing of financial

aid from GMS should be encouraged to help other children whenever they are suitably employed.

- (m) Shagun given to Sabha's organising Mohyal Milans be increased.
- (n) Review the Charitable activities being done and add more events like providing medical facilities at the Ashram.
- (o) Local Sabha's should properly scrutinize applications recommended by them, for financial help to widows, students and medical treatment to needy.
- (p) Sabha's should carry out social impact projects simultaneously in their respective areas on fixed days as decided.
- (q) We should show restrain while using social media sites and avoid unhealthy criticism.
- (r) Sabha's should study the government welfare schemes, give it wide publicity to help needy members of our community.
- (s) Maintenance / House keeping at the Ashrams should be looked into.
- (t) Local Sabha's should themselves resolve their issues amicably. GMS is committed not to interfere in the affairs of the Sabha's.
- (u) Presidents and Secretaries meet should be held twice a year.
- (v) Suggestions made by members should be practical and possible to implement.
- (w) Local Sabha's should make telephone directories containing contact details of all mohyals in their areas.
- (x) Organise youth activities in different areas and form career counselling teams in each Sabha.
- (y) Hold some GMS functions outside Delhi also.
- (z) Shri Vipan Mohan, President MS Yamuna Nagar made a appeal to members to come forward and donate liberally for Mohyal Bhawan at Yamuna Nagar.

Lt Gen R K Mehta, President MS Noida suggested, to consider doing Shramdan at Haridwar when the extension project is undertaken, and to start planning to organise a major event in 2022 ie 75th year of our Independence.

Gen Bakshi in his closing address said, that he would like to complement and thank everyone for the whole hearted participation and sharing of views and thoughts transparently and with honesty. "We have indeed benefitted and learnt from you all and therefore I consider that this has been a very good, useful and satisfying interaction and has achieved the aims set for this programme", were his closing remarks.

Shri P K Dutta, Sr Vice President GMS, in his vote of thanks, expressed his satisfaction and said that it was a very good session and mohyals should consider contributing ten percent of their time, money, guidance etc towards well being of our community. This was followed by group photograph and lunch, and members left for their homes happy, with a resolve to do something for the community.






