





OUR REVERED ANCESTOR BHAJ MATI DASS CHHIBBER

The Community paid homage to our revered ancestor, Bhai Mati Dass Chhibber, who was born on 13 Jan 1641 and was martyred on 9 Nov 1675. His martyrdom has no parallel in the world history, for the supreme sacrifice made by him. Bhai Mati Dass, was a disciple of Guru Tegh Bahadur and fought against the Mughal rule. He was arrested on charges of sedition in 1675 and was tried in Kotwali Chandni Chowk at Delhi. He rejected the option to embrace Islam, as a result he was bolted between two planks of wood and brutally bifurcated into twain, from top to trunk, with a saw on 9 Nov 1675. Bhai Mati Dass, started reciting the Sukmani Sahib and his voice continued to come from the two parts of his body till the prayer was completed.

The cross road, popularly known as the Fountain in Chandni Chowk at Delhi, where Bhai Mati Dass attained Shahidi, has been named as Bhai Mati Dass Chowk, which is opposite Sis Ganj Gurudwara.

Late Rzd B D Bali, former President GMS, had reiterated that we should emulate our great ancestor, Bhai Mati Dass and collectively take all steps to take our great Community forward which is progressing rapidly.

Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM (Retd), President GMS, members of the Managing Committee and the entire Mohyal Community, resolve to take all possible steps to bind the Community together and move forward as one big joint family.



9th November 2020 was the 345th Martyrdom day of our Great Mohyal Legend Bhai Mati Dass Chhibber. A Shradhanjali Samaroh was organized by Jalandhar Mohyal Sabha at the office premises of its Bhawan Complex at 4.30 pm. Dr VK Vasudev of Lajwanti Hospital Jalandhar Fame and Samdhi of our Vice President Shri GK Bali was invited as Chief Guest. Gathering was limited to only 10 members in view of the Covid-19 precautions. The Chief Guest was welcomed by the Jalandhar team led by our President Shri N L Vaid. The Chief Guest went around the Bhawan Complex and appreciated the pace of progress of Bhawan in a very short time during Covid-19 and the elegance of undergoing construction work. Shri GK Bali our Vice President introduced all the members present at the venue to the Chief Guest Dr Vasudev. Most of the members spoke about their delightful experiences with Dr Vasudev.

Chief Guest Dr Vasudev opened the Martyrdom Day Ceremony by igniting the Mohyal Warrior Flame and by garlanding the portrait of Bhai Mati Dass. Shri Subhash Dutta, Samdhi of our President Shri NL Vaid supported the Chief Guest during this pious ceremony, Shri GK Bali apprised the Chief Guest about the Brave and Gallant Bhai Mati Dass. During that Era the Mughal Rulers were bent upon either forcefully converting the Hindus/Sikhs to Islam or face death. They informed the Mughals that if the sage Guru Teg Bahadur converts, they would also follow. But the Guru refused the dictate of Mughals. He was chained and brought to Chandni Chowk Delhi in a cage to terrorize his followers. They also brought three brave Mohyal Brothers Bhai Mati Dass, Bhai Sati Dass and Bhai Dayala. The Qazi present there offered Bhai Mati Dass to convert and marry the daughter of the then Nawab, as such their lives would be spared. But Bhai did not accept that proposal and was killed by cutting his body in two pieces from top to bottom on 9th November 1675. The holy place where Bhai was sacrificed is just opposite Gurudwara Sheeshganj and the Chowk there is named after the Martyr Bhai Mati Dass Chhibber. His two brothers also faced the death in a very brutal manner. The great Guru Teg Bahadur was also killed by the Mughals on 24th November 1675 by beheading. The supreme sacrifice of The Guru and His three followers to save the Hindu Religion resulted in frustrating and breaking the courage of the Mughals thereby saving the lives of large number of Indian Community. This great sacrifice of the Guru and His followers will be remembered by the coming generations with reverence.

Shri Ashok Dutta Secretary, Jalandhar Mohyal Sabha speaking at the occasion informed the gathering, how the title Bhai was given to the Chhibber Clan. Recognizing the sacrifices of the Chhibber Community, the tenth seer Guru Gobind Singh declared that this community was as good as brothers for Him and conferred them with the title BHAJ. Present day important personalities using this title include Bhai Mahavir ex Governor, Bhai Parma Nand the

great revolutionary and Bhai BKN Chhibber Lt General Retired and ex Governor.

The Chief Guest while speaking at the occasion said although he was not a born Mohyal, yet he was well aware of the Mohyal Community as four Mohyal Women two Dutts and two Balis were part of his family and the generation next to him had become half Mohyals. He also said with pride that his involvement with the Mohyal Community had gone deep since the daughter of Shri GK Bali became his daughter-in-law. The Chief Guest Dr Vasudev has rendered a very handsome financial support for our Bhawan Construction for which the Mohyal Community shall remain obliged. The community members present at the occasion interacted freely with the Chief Guest who stayed with us throughout the Samaroh.

Floral Tributes were paid to Bhai Mati Dass, Bhai Mahavir and Bhai Parma Nand by the gathering. The graceful community members present at the occasion included Shri NL Vaid, President, Shri GK Bali, Vice President, Shri Ashok Dutta, Secretary, Shri Sunil Dutt, Finance Secretary, Shri Subhash Dutta reputed wholesale merchants, Dr Ravinder Dutta, Shri Shiv Sharan Dutta a retired Banker, Shri Ashwani Dutta a Bank Manager, Shri Rajiv Dutta and Shri Naresh Mehta. 
■ **Shri Badri Nath Vaid and Smt Prakash Wati Vaid:**



परम शहीद भाई मतीदास छिब्र

अपने धर्म की रक्षा के लिए जान कुर्बान कर देने वाले वीर सपूतों में भाई मतीदास जी का नाम बड़े आदर से लिया जाता है। इनका जन्म 13 जनवरी 1641 को करियाला तहसील चकवाल जिला जेहलम (पाकिस्तान) में हुआ था। इनके पिता जी का नाम दीवान कबूल दास तथा दादा का द्वारका दास था जिनका सम्बन्ध मोहयाल जाति, सारसवत ब्राह्मण से और इनका गोत्र भार्गव था। आपके पूर्वजों में सिंधु नरेश महाराज धार सैन और फिर भेरा नरेश राजा गौतम हुए। राजा गौतम के एक पुत्र पराग दास थे जो बाबा पराग के नाम से जाने गए, जिन्होंने गाँव करियाला की नींव 1526 ई. में रखी। गुरु हरगोविंद जी ने अपने पिता गुरु अर्जुन देव पर हुए अत्याचारों के विरोध में सेना का गठन किया और बाबा पराग जी को सेनापति नियुक्त किया। उस समय उनकी आयु 31 वर्ष थी, इस तरह भाई मतिदास बाबा पराग के पड़पोते थे।

जब गुरु तेग बहादुर गद्दी पर बैठे तो उन्होंने भाई मतीदास जी को अपना मंत्री नियुक्त किया और आनन्दपुर साहिब तथा कीरतपुर का शासन प्रबन्ध उन्हें सौंपा। इसी बीच मुगल शासक औरंगजेब ने सत्ता संभालते ही हिन्दुओं पर अत्याचार तथा जबरन धर्म परिवर्तन के लिए मजबूर किया, जिसका भाई जी ने विरोध किया। 5 नवम्बर 1675 को सूबेदार वजीर खान द्वारा इन्हें पकड़ कर दिल्ली लाया गया तथा आगरा से गुरु तेग बहादुर और भाई दयालदास को भी दिल्ली लाया गया। चौदनी चौक दिल्ली में जहाँ अब गुरुद्वारा शीसगंज है, वहाँ कोतवाली में तीनों को कैद कर इनके समक्ष दो प्रस्ताव रखे कि वह धर्म बदल कर वैभव पूर्ण जीवन व्यतीत करें अथवा यातना पूर्ण मृत्यु के लिए तैयार हो जाएँ। सबने मृत्यु का स्वागत किया। परिणाम स्वरूप तीनों को भिन्न-भिन्न प्रकार से 9, 10, 11 नवम्बर 1675 ई. को मृत्यु दंड दिया गया। सबसे पहले भाई मतीदास जी को गुरुद्वारा शीसगंज के सामने फौवारा चौक में आरे से चीरा गया। इसी जगह को भाई मतीदास चौक का नाम दिया गया है। गुरु हरगोविंद जी ने बाबा पराग जी की मृत्यु के बाद उनके पाते लखी दास जी को भाई की उपाधि से सुशोभित किया, इसीलिए उनके वंशज छिब्र जो करियाला गाँव से संबंध रखते हैं अपने नाम के साथ 'भाई' शब्द का प्रयोग करते हैं। और मुझे भी यह गौरव प्राप्त है।

यह घटना सन् 1965-66 की है, जब मैं बी 14/7 कृष्णा नगर (निकट घोंडली गाँव) के पास रहता था। मैं तभी कृष्णा नगर के सरकारी स्कूल में सन् 1960 में अध्यापक के रूप में नियुक्ती हुई थी। उन्हीं दिनों मेरे चाचा जी श्री सोमनाथ शास्त्री जी लव मेरे किराए के मकान में सुबह करीब 9-10 बजे आए और कहा कि चलो आज तुझे बिरादरी के अच्छे शुभचिंतकों के पास ले चलता हूँ। वह मुझे साथ लेकर झील कुरंजा इसी मकान के पिछवाड़े में ले गए जहाँ हमारे कृष्ण भक्त श्री वैष्णो दास लव एक चारपाई पर लेटे हुए थे। उनके चारों तरफ गाय खड़ी थीं। आपस में जय मोहयाल का अभिवादन हुआ और बातचीत शुरु हो गई उन्होंने कहा कि यह जगह जो लगभग 200 गज है मैंने मोहयाल सभा को दान कर दी है। मैं तब से सन् 1965 से मोहयाल सभा में जा रहा हूँ।

मेरा यह विचार है कि ऐसे कृष्ण भक्त परिवार का अभिनन्दन होना ही चाहिए "क्योंकि एक भी भैंस नहीं बंधी थी" यदि ऐसा हो जाए तो झील की उस सभा का गुणगान एक बार फिर से हो जाएगा। जिसने अपने मोहयाल सभा को दान कर दी है इसलिए इस सभा को उस कृष्ण भक्त के परिवार को बुलाकर अभिनन्दन कर देना चाहिए। मुझे आशा है और विश्वास है कि झील की इस मोहयाल सभा को अपने इस परिवार को अवश्य बुलाएगी और इनका अभिनन्दन करेगी। इनका चित्र भी सभा भवन में लगाया जाए।




