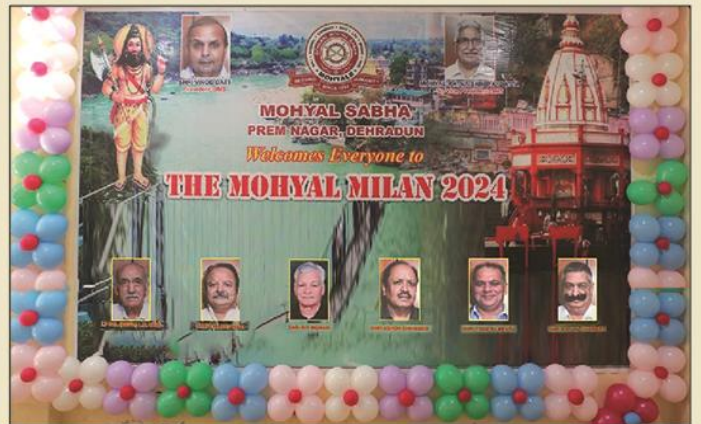

A deeply spiritual and compassionate woman, Smt Vimlesh Bali led her life with unwavering faith, kindness, and generosity. She was

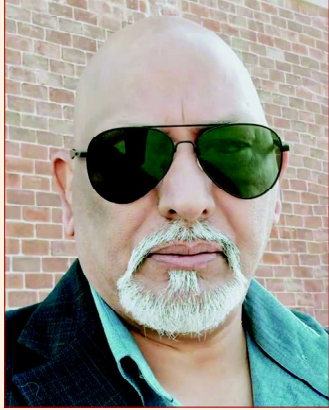

## Shri Pal Bali

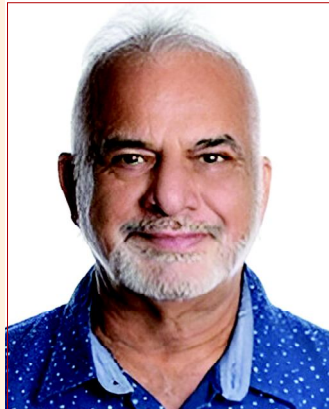
