साहसी बालक गुल्लू

देश के बंटवारे के कारण करनाल के पास, सलारू नामक छोटे से गाँव से सभी परिवार पाकिस्तान चले गए व उधर से आने वाले कुछ हिंदू सिख परिवार इधर आ कर बस गए, तो जाना कि इधर बनिया जाति का भी एक संयुक्त परिवार है, जो खेती बाड़ी के साथ करियाना की दुकान भी करता है। उनकी हवेली के बाहर वाली दीवार के साथ कुआं था, जिसका आधा हिस्सा घर के भीतर व आधा घर के बाहर, जिससे गाँव के अन्य लोग भी पानी ले सके।

उधर से इधर आकर बसने वालों में एक परिवार ऐसा भी था, जिनके दो छोटे बच्चे अर्थात बेटी व बेटा, जिनकी आयु क्रमशः 10, 7 वर्ष थी। जब भी ठंडा पानी पीने की इच्छा होती, तब गृहिणी कुएं से पानी भर कर लाती। ऐसे में बच्चों की भी इच्छा होती कि कुएं से पानी की बाल्टी भरे और देखें कि पानी कितना नीचे है। पर माँ समझाती कि ऐसा कभी भी नहीं करना। बच्चों को ऐसा करने से जितना भी रोका जाता, उनकी लालसा और भी तीव्र हो जाती।

एक दिन पिता किसी जरूरी काम से करनाल गए, और माँ तनिक सुस्ताने के लिए आंखें मूंदे चारपाई पर लेटी थी। तभी दोनों बच्चे कुएं पर गए और बाल्टी से लेंज बांध, उसे कुएं में डाला। फिर बहन देखने लगी कि बाल्टी में पानी भरा की नहीं। उसी पल भाई भी आँधे मुँह झुक कुएं में देखने लगा, कुएं में गिर गया। यह देख बहन सहम गयी और उसी पल घर आकर माँ को यह बात बताई।

दोपहर का समय और उस समय तक सभी पुरुष, खेतों में काम करने जा चुके थे। माँ रोती चिल्लाती खेतों की ओर भागी और सहायता के लिए गुहार लगाई। अपना काम छोड़कर सभी कुएं के पास गए और बड़े से टोकरी में रस्सियों बाँध कुएं में लटकाया और झांक कर देखा कि गुल्लू कुएं की दीवार के साथ चिपका हुआ था। असल में बात यह थी कि कुआं बनाते समय कारीगरों ने इसकी दीवार के साथ सांकल भी लगा दी थी कि यदि कोई अनजाने में इस में गिर जाए तो इसे कस कर पकड़ ले। अब गुल्लू नामक बालक जब कुएं में गिरा तो एक बार तो वह इसकी सतह तक गया, पर जब दूसरे की पल जब ऊपर आया तो सांकल उसके हाथ लगी और उसे कस कर पकड़ लिया। लोगों ने जब टोकरी को कुएं में डाला तो बालक को समझाया कि घबराना नहीं और बड़े ध्यान से एक हाथ से सांकल को छोड़, दूसरे से रस्सी को कस कर पकड़, बड़े ध्यान से टोकरी में बैठ जा। शाबास हिम्मत नहीं हारना।

उसी पल कुएं से उस बच्चे की आवाज आई कि, “ओए! तुम सब चिंता ना करो। मैं तो एक दम होशियार खबरदार हूँ। बड़े ध्यान से टोकरी में बैठ जाऊंगा पर आप सब होशियारी से अपना काम करना। ऐसा न हो कि तुम्हारे हाथ से रस्सी छूट जाए।” इतना कह बड़ी सूझ बूझ से, बच्चे ने सांकल छोड़कर, रस्सियों को पकड़ कर टोकरी में बैठ, सही सलामत बाहर आ गया।

टिप्पणी, मुश्किल के उस दौर में भी गुल्लू ने साहस नहीं छोड़ा और मौत के मुँह से बच निकला। इस सच्ची कथा से हमें भी याद रखना चाहिए कि, “ठीक समय पर बुद्धि से काम लेने से, मुश्किल से बच सकते हो।”
