## RISHI DUTT AMONG 50 TOP EXECUTIVES OF AUSTRALIA

Rishi Dutta, son of Shri Rabinder Dutta and Smt Vinny Dutta hails from known family of village Veerum Duttan of Shakkrgarh tehsil, of District Gurdaspur His grandfather Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt, a well known Freedom Fighter, graduated from Toilers of East University Moscow Russia in 1930 and was a founder member of Communist party of India. He was imprisoned many a time during freedom struggle and was inmate with Subhash Chander Bose in erstwhile Kalapani.



After independence, besides many other social works, Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt spear headed Muzara Movement (Right of Agriculture Labour), because of his contribution for welfare of Agriculture labour in Punjab, even today his photographs can be seen framed and hanging in many houses. After his demise he was cremated with full state honours and a Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt Memorial was made in heart of Gurdaspur city to give a befitting honour to his services in freedom struggle.

Rishi Dutt after completing his schooling from St Xavier School Chandigarh, did Masters Degree in IT from Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology Melbourne Australia. After completing his Masters Degree, he initially had a stint with IBM in Melbourne, thereafter he joined Victoria Transport (An Australia Government Enterprise). Because of his hard work and efficiency, very soon he rose to the top post of Chief Information Officer of Public Transport Victoria. Government Of Australia selects top 50 Executives of the Country every year to recognise their services. This year (2018-2019) Rishi dutt was adjudged 35<sup>th</sup> among the top 50 Executives.

In June 2017, Public Transport Victoria Data Analytics Platform (DAP) went live. This facilitated the visualisation of the whole public transport view of the stake holders, ensuring that decisions and their impacts are assured across all public transport modes. The data can now be modelled, shared and reused anywhere, at any time and from any device Victorians can now face the challenges of disruptions and diversions to their normal routes, effectively as a result of this innovative platform. His contribution to use technology in the field of Public Transport has been recognised world over. He has been a guest speaker in Paris and London..

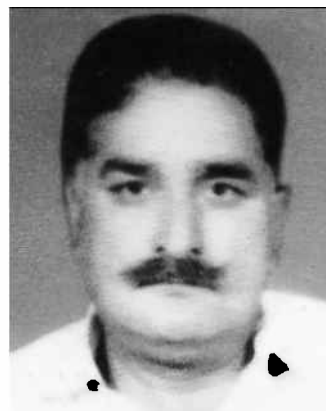

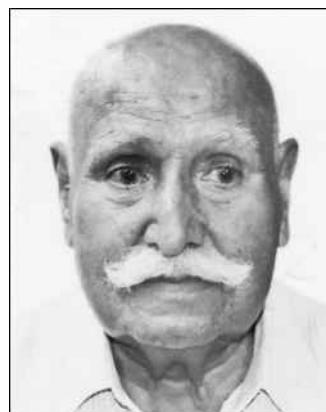

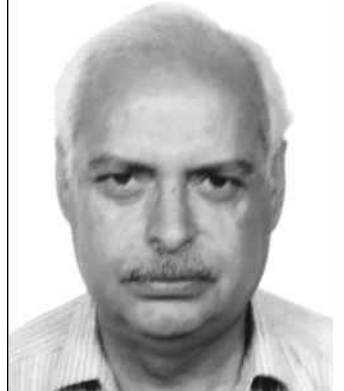

1. Rooms can be booked on line, 30 days in advance.

2. Bookings can also be done on telephone and at the counter.
3. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
4. Bookings can be done after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
5. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
6. Room donors to donate 25% of the standard room rates (Non Mohyal rates).
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non- vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashram is strictly prohibited.
8. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall.
10. Pets (Animals) are not allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Guests are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Guests are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Online booking facility for rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar is not available. Rooms can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
14. Guests are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar is available, only to residents of the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Guests and no other activity is permitted.
