We aim to strengthen the local sabhas to enable them to play a much more dynamic role in the welfare chain and we are confident of fullest cooperation from all concerned.



Besides this the society was also awarded Best Credit Society "SAMMAN" by All Thrift and Credit Societies Association (Regd.) on 1st January 2017.

The society got itself registered with the Delhi Govt. on 20th March, 1987 with 31 members with capital of Rs. 3100/-. Society lends loan to a maximum of Rs.2,00000/- to its members without delay and with less formalities on 13.2% rate of interest. During the last 30 years, the society has made tremendous progress and had been distributing dividend to the members at the rate of 18% per annum for last 4 years. At present society has more than 3500 members and its working capital is around 26 Crores. The society has its own building which is well furnished. The society under the President ship of Sh. Ashok K. Chhibber is quiet vibrant and takes keen interest for its progress.

The President of the society, Sh. Ashok K. Chhibber was also awarded shield by Dr. Yoganand Shastri, Minister of Delhi Govt. for his self less services in the Co-operative field in the year 2000 and again Sh. J.N. Bhardwaj Memorial Award was also given by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Delhi in the year 2009.






