REPORT ON PRESIDENTS AND SECRETARIES MEETING OF AFFILIATED SABHAS HELD IN DELHI ON 16 DECEMBER 2018

The programme started with the chanting of the Mohyal Prayer by the members, led by Smt Sunita Mehta and roars of JAI MOHYAL, after Deep Prajwalan by Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM, Sr Vice President, and honourable members.

Lt Col L R Vaid, Secretary General, warmly welcomed the Presidents and Secretaries, who had assembled in the auditorium after registration and refreshments. They were requested to introduce themselves which they did. He explained the details of conduct of the programme and said that he looked forward to a meaningful interaction. He told the House that Rzd B D Bali, our inspiration and our revered leader is indisposed and will not be able to come for the meeting. He also said, that Shri P K Dutta will not be able to attend the meeting being unwell. He then invited Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM, Sr Vice President, to give the welcome address.

Gen Bakshi extended a very warm welcome to all members who had come for the meeting despite the cold weather. He said that the local sabhas were the backbone of the GMS, since they were interacting with members of the community at the grassroots level to understand their difficulties and we look forward to hearing their views and suggestions. He said that, above all, it was important to be a good human being and respect each other. Shri B L Chhibber, Vice President spoke on the financial management of GMS and motivated members to open Trusts to perpetuate the memory of their dear ones. Shri Vinod Dutt, Vice President, said that strength was in unity which would benefit everyone. He offered his services, to help youth get loans from the Bank for education purposes and updated the members, on progress of construction of Mohyal Bhawan at Yamuna Nagar which is likely to be completed in three to four months. Shri Rattan Datta, said that MERIT was conducting skill development courses and gave details of the diploma courses being launched in Journalism and Mass Communication next year. The brochure giving details of these courses has already been sent to all Sabhas. Shri Yogesh Mehta. Chairman vouth and cultural affairs, said that the youth was active and the next youth camp is being planned to be held next year after the exams of the children.

Shri Rahul Datta from MS Dehradun was honoured with a Shawl by Lt Gen G L Bakshi, for developing the website for Mohyal Ashram Haridwar. MS Mohali, invited members to the Mohyal Milan being organized by their Sabha on 23 Dec 2018. They also presented to the GMS, framed portraits of our Sapt Rishi's. Shri D N Dutta, President MS Prem Nagar Dehradun and Shri J K Dutta, Secretary MS Dehradun, invited members to Mohyal Milan being jointly organized by their Sabhas on 29 Dec 2018. Shri Gulshan Vaid, President and Shri Rajinder Bali, Secretary of MS Karnal, invited members to the 64th Mohyal Milan being organized by their Sabha on 30 Dec

2018.Members were divided into four groups ie Group 1 – Team Leader Shri J P Mehta, President MS Ambala City, Group 2 – Team Leader Shri Ramesh Datta, President MS Faridabad, Group 3 – Team Leader Shri K K Bali, former President MS Janakpuri and Group 4 – Team Leader Shri T K Bali, President MS Naraingarh. They were given the following topics to be discussed in their groups and were requested to nominate speakers from their group to present their views on all the four subjects.

1. Role of Local Sabhas

- (a) How to empower our Youth (Education and Skill Development), and make them active members of the Community.
- (b) Suggestions to empower young widows to make them financially independent.
- (c) Steps to be taken to reach out to the Mohyals in the area of jurisdiction of the Sabha and identify under privileged members.
- **2. Mohyaliat** What does it mean and how to promote interaction within the Community.
- **3. Our Ashrams/Institutions** Steps to be taken to make them financially self sustaining.
- **4.** Future Objective of our Community Your views on how to ensure welfare, progress and prosperity of the Community.

The following points emerged after discussion

- (a) Physical verification should be done, by visiting individuals wanting financial help from GMS before recommending the cases .
- (b) Youth can be integrated into the main stream by organizing activities which are of interest to them ie sports activities, cultural programmes, social get togethers etc.
- (c) Students availing of financial aid from GMS, should be encouraged to make donations to GMS, when they are suitably employed.
- (d) GMS should also organize functions in different areas / locations to attract members of that area.
- (e) Youth should be helped to avail of loans from Banks for education/ starting business.
- (f) Young widows should not be given pension and instead be helped to acquire skills to make them financially independent.
- (g) Efforts should be made to remarry young widows.

- (h) We should visit rural areas to identify needy persons since mohyals in urban areas are financially well off.
- (i) Langar fund donations should be increased since the interest rates are gradually going down.
- (j) Car stickers should be designed indicating that the vehicle owner is a Mohyal
- (k) Encourage children in cultural activities ie singing, dancing, acting, playing musical instruments etc.
- (I) Career counseling group should be formed in each Sabha.
- (m) New Sabha's should be formed, keeping in view the travel time by the individuals
- (n) Efforts should be made to revive defunct Sabha's and resolve disputes in the local Sabha's.
- (o) Neighboring Sabha's should interact with each other.
- (p) Forms of widows seeking widow pension, should also be recommended by their children.
- (q) Families receiving more than one copy of Mohyal Mitter, should surrender the extra copies.
- (r) Census of mohyal population should be completed at the earliest.
- (s) The youth should be helped to find suitable jobs where our entrepreneurs can help.
- (t) Martyrdom of our ancestors should be observed by the community.

Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM, expressed his satisfaction over the deliberations and said that it was a very good session and that all the suggestions made will be examined. He thanked the members for having come for this important meeting and having a meaningful interaction. This was followed by Group Photograph and lunch, and members left with a sense of pride and satisfaction.
