

MAHAKUMBH

Before I explain Mahakumbh, I feel it necessary to tell what is Kumbh. Kumbh means Kalash. When there was Samudra Manthan with Devtaz on one side and Danavz on the other. An Amrit Kalash came out of that Manthan. There was a fight between Devz and Danavz for owning that Kalash. During that fight some drops of that Amrit fell at four places Pryagraj Haridwar, Nasik and Ujjain. Thereafter the four areas became pious as per Sanatan scriptures. Devotees go to these places for attaining salvation on the occasion of Kumbh.

Mahakumbh happens only at Pryagraj after 144 years. The period of 144 years means 12 cycles of 12 years of Pooran Kumbh. Next Mahakumbh will come in the year 2169 at Pryagraj when none of us will be live. We are lucky that we are witness to this Mahakumbh of 2025. The Mahakumbh garners importance due to the reason that during the 45 days starting Makar Sankranti, the nine planets of earth rotate in one curve around the earth which is considered most auspicious. According to Satya Sanatan Dharm Faith when we observe KALPWAS of 15 days to one month during this period, we achieve Moksh or Mukti i.e, Salvation from our evils and finally come out of the vicious cycle of Birth & Death.

What is Kalpwas- Kalpwas is to learn the Course of Vedas and follow Worship at the shores of Sangam for one month specially during these 45 days and take the holy Snan there. Several crores of Sanatan devotees have been on pilgrimage to Kumbh, Ardh Kumbh, Pooran Kumbh at Pryagraj, Haridwar, Ujjain and Nasik & Mahakumbh only at Prayagraj since centuries. Devotees include a large number of Foreigners from all across the globe. Most relrvant face of the Mahakumbh 2025 is that of WIFE of founder of Apple Company Mr. Steve Jaubs. She is on Kalpwas at Pryagraj these days for accomplishing Salvation.

Nanga Sadhus- They are a very important ingredient of Kumbh. These Sadhus have shed the amenities of this materialistic world. They perform their last rituals during their life time. They are far away from the fobia of death. Sorrow Happiness, Loss Gain, Ease Difficulty, Sun Rain, Summer Winter etc do not affect them. They do not wear clothes except on private parts. Nanga Sadhus take part in Amrit Snan at Sangam in the morning and other devotees join after that. After death Nanga Sadhus are not cremated on the pyre. Instead they are given Jal Samadhi or Bhu Samadhi. This is the power and faith of Sanatan.

Raizada Prahlad Bali Marg

In the heart of Jammu, there lies a lane that stands as a testament to the life and legacy of an extraordinary man – Raizada Prahlad Bali Ji. Declared as 'Raizada Prahlad Bali Marg' by the Jammu Municipal Corporation, this road is more than just a path; it is a tribute to a life dedicated to noble causes, community service, and unwavering patriotism. Every year, on the 15th of August, this lane comes alive with patriotism and pride. For Dr. Surinder Mohan Bali, the elder son of Raizada Prahlad Bali Ji, this day holds a special significance – not only as India's Independence Day but also as the birthday of his beloved father. Born in 1921 in Trala, District Mahirpur, Pakistan, Raizada Prahlad Bali Ji was a man of courage and compassion. A gem of the Mohyal community, he dedicated his life to the welfare of society. From serving as Vice President of Mohyal Sabha Jammu to tirelessly working for the rehabilitation of refugees from Pakistan, his contributions remain unmatched. He was a beacon of hope for those who fled their homes in Pakistan and sought refuge in Rehari Colony. He fought not for personal gain but for the survival and dignity of his community. Despite his selfless service, he never asked for a single penny for himself.

In 1948, Raizada Prahlad Bali Ji married Shanti Devi, the daughter of Bhai Tolla Ram Dutta and Ram Rakhi. Together, they built a beautiful family filled with love, values, and traditions. They raised two sons, Dr. Surinder Mohan Bali and Ravinder Kumar Bali, and a daughter, Sushma Dutta, who continue to carry forward his legacy. We are immensely proud to be the children of such a remarkable man. He taught us the value of selflessness, courage, and service. His journey from 1921 to 2006 inspires us every day. Raizada Prahlad Bali Ji's legacy lives on through his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren, who proudly remember his sacrifices and achievements. His contributions to the Mohyal community and the people of Jammu will always be celebrated. Today, as we walk on Raizada Prahlad Bali Marg, we honor a life well-lived, a heart that beat for others, and a soul that continues to inspire generations. He may have left this physical world in March 2006, but his spirit will forever remain in the hearts of those who knew him. 


Shri Krishan Datta (30 Sep 1932 – 4 Jan 2025)

He was honoured for significant contribution in the field of sports journalism from the prestigious Delhi Sports Journalist Association and DDCA and gained more popularity for his regular column

'Different Strokes' which appeared for about three decades.




