A GREAT LEGEND PASSES AWAY



Lt Gen H C DUTTA, PVSM (Retd)
(05 -11-1925 – 18-04-2020)

At 95 years, the age had bent the body but not dimmed the mind. He believed in himself and perhaps God. He was the best husband, the best father, the best son, the best brother, the best uncle, the best grandfather any family could wish for. He held a patent on the word 'Best'. He held strong beliefs and lived the life he wanted to. His life was a culmination of integrity, honor, compassion, discipline, hard work, and above all a loving heart. A Renaissance man, he could talk about anything from World History, Complex Science, Cosmic Theory, Global Economics, Art, Theater, and Spirituality.

Born to landowners family of Bhaun, Jhelum now in Pakistan and later based at Sri Ganganagar, Rajasthan, he was the third son of Mehta Dina Nath Dutta and Smt Ramrakhi Dutta. His early life was spent in the care of parents and brothers. The upbringing in the family was such that a very close bond existed between the five brothers and the families. The brothers grew up and each branched out to different vocations. He chose to follow his eldest brother, Col Romesh C Dutta, and joined the Indian Military Academy, Dehra Dun in August 1946 and got his commission in the 5th Battalion of the 8th Gorkha Rifles in Dec 1947. Nothing defined his life more clearly than his journey through the Army, serving it diligently and wholeheartedly, building lifelong bonds of love and friendship which gave him reason to be happy and proud. He was an Army man to the last and found great joy and contentment in reliving the encounters and experiences of his Army days which had given him an identity he fully deserved and felt proud of. His cheer and camaraderie were hard to miss – as he saw the years pass, he kept his walk and life on road, not one to retreat or be defeated by anything. He served the army for four decades before retiring as Central Army Commander in Nov 1983. With his reputation of the thinker General, he contributed avidly in various journals of strategic community. His thoughts on Armed Forces and its role in Nation building were compiled in the book Indian Military Power - A General Reflects.

A very staunch Mohyal, he became an active member of the community post retirement, as a life member of General Mohyal Sabha. He was genuinely interested in the well being of the community and was bestowed with Lifetime Achievement award during the 125th Sthapna Divas of GMS, held on 12 March 2017. He left for heavenly abode at Gurugram on 18th April 2020 at the age of 95 Years. He is survived by a loving and caring partner Shobha, son Aditya, daughters-in-law Sumita, Ritika and grandchildren Sarina, Arjun, Amay & Ayza. The Indian Army bid him farewell with full Military honours and 21 guns salute. His soul shall rest in peace, secure in the knowledge that a grateful nation and community acknowledge his service and life. The family has instituted a Trust for the needy Mohyal children, in the name 'General Harish Dutta Education Fund Trust', with an initial amount of Rs Five lacs. Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM (Retd), President GMS and members of the Managing Committee, pray to Almighty God, to grant peace to the departed soul and to give strength to the family to bear with this irreparable loss.



A Prestigious Assignment for V.P. Mohan

Shri V.P. Mohan, Indian Forest Service, (1963 Batch), superannuated in 1995 as Head of Forest Department, Himachal Pradesh from the post of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests. Born on 7th June 1937 in a family of forest lovers, he had the privilege of having been nurtured by his father, late Shri Gurdas Mohan, who retired as Conservator of Forests, Nahan Circle, HP in 1952 and his grandfather, who had retired as Superintendent in the office of Chief Conservator of Forests, Punjab.

After completing B.Sc. (Agri.) from Punjab Agricultural University, Ludhiana in 1957, he was selected by the Union Public Service Commission for undergoing training at the Indian Forest College, Dehra Dun positions. His various assignments included a foreign assignment from 1978 to 1982 to The Tanzania Industrial Studies and Consultancy Organization Dares Salaam (East Africa). Even after his superannuation in 1995, he had the opportunity to attend a range of international Conferences/Workshops on Forestry and allied topics as an Invitee/Resource person in a number of countries. His technical services were hired as a short term International Consultant with Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), Rome, in Vietnam in 2001-2002 to develop Criteria and Indicators for Forest Land Evaluation under a Five Million Hectares Reforestation Programme in Vietnam and in 2004 in Mauritius for developing a new Forest Policy.

Hon'ble High Court, HP. hired his professional services in 2004 for submitting a report on working of Stone Crushers and again in 2014 for addressing environmental havoc by unscientific muck dumping by Bagga Cement Plant in Himachal Pradesh.

A ban on green felling was imposed by Hon'ble Supreme Court on 12th December 1996 in many States in India. Hon'ble Supreme Court, while accepting assurances and submissions made in I.A No 3840 of 2014-filed on 15th January 2015 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202 of 1995 (under Article 32 of the Constitution of India) by the Himachal Pradesh State Government has permitted in its orders dated 16th February 2018 on an Experimental basis Silviculture felling including thinning and other cultural operations for two years i.e. 2018-19 and 2019-20, by laying down strict guidelines and particularly stipulating that *"This entire programme of experimental Silviculture Felling shall be done under the supervision and guidance of a two-Member Committee headed by Shri V.P. Mohan, IFS (Retd.), former Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Himachal Pradesh. The second member of this Committee shall be nominated by the Vice Chancellor, Dr. Y.S. Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry, Nauni, Solan, Himachal Pradesh. The second Member shall be a Professor of Silviculture. (SILVICULTURE means, practice of controlling the growth, composition, health, and quality of forests).*

Shri VP Mohan has been entrusted with this challenging professional work at the age of 80 plus after 23 years of his retirement. It had been a humongous task to conceptualize the practicalities of implementing the entire programme in a sequential time frame after a dormancy

of over two decades. Clearly, the Apex Court has permitted relaxation to ensure that the underlying objective of ensuring regeneration achieved after Silvicultural fellings under strict monitoring by putting in place enabling conditions for regeneration.

The way we work gets broken when talented people are not able to attend to their basic human needs. Here are few such strategies to try when you have less time.

1. Password change exercise

This technique is a form of preparing – creating cues in our environment to prompt us to act in a certain way. We can use this specific password change technique to start our day smiling. I changed my password to *Life1sbe@utiful*, and it worked. My next password was *Enjoy@moments*, and it helped me enjoy small moments of life. Make your password express something which will help you create a positive environment.

2. Hug someone

Hugs are so important that there is a Hug day which falls on January 21, since 1986. Give Someone a Hug every day. Hugs are a good source to relieve stress. Hugging someone allows you to release oxytocin. A hormone that promotes pro-social behaviour, contribute to relaxation, trust and compassion. Dr Paul Zak says at least 8 hugs a day allows us to maintain a strong relationship. If you feel weird about hugging your colleagues at work, then save those hugs for friends and family.

3. Pet an animal

More people are recognizing the impact of petting an animal has on reducing their stress. As we burned out, our panic attacks increase. And we stop exercising because a fast-beating heart causes our brain to trigger panic. To help, we should spend time with our retriever pet. Petting animals increase our levels of serotonin, dopamine, neurotransmitters that have calming properties.

4. Try 6-3-8 breathing

Many busy professionals share they don't have enough time to practice meditation. This is the closest thing I've been able to do, and it has helped me relax in many stressful situations. If you have a focus problem or having a knee-jerk reaction to stressproducing events. You can try this breathing technique. You can do while sitting in a chair or on the floor with a straight back. Breathe in for a count of 6, hold your breath for a count of 3, then exhale for a count of 8. Repeat this five times and increase the same over a while.

5. Savour something

Savouring involves consciously engaging with our thoughts or behaviour. This heightens the effects of positive events or positive emotions. Look forward to a positive event. Extend the enjoyment of the current happy experience, and revisit a past event to restore a positive feeling. Are you looking forward to an outing planned with your loved ones? Take a few moments and think about the happiness you will get from this outing.

6. Smile

Emotions are very contagious in our life. We may not feel happy at our workplace or going through a tough time in your

life. Smiling not only makes us feel better, but we'll also give a signal to others that we want to stay connected.

7. Brain dispose of

Counterproductive thoughts and emotions build up throughout the day. This could be a feeling of anger towards a friend. Anxiety about missing an important work deadline, or disappointment upon not receiving promotion. All these need to be in our brain. Our worstcase scenario thinking won't get better until we dispose of it from our head. It's amazing how different a problem looks when we put it on paper. Put all your thoughts on the paper and you will feel relaxed after this exercise.

8. Mental game

Our brain notices and remembers negative events and information. It's called negativity bias. If you're having a stressful day in your routine. Chances are your brain will revisit stressful events after the stress has passed. Mental games are fun and easy brain activities to help you lessen confusion. You can recite your favourite song lyrics. This can also try by creating a sentence where every word must begin with the same letter. Starting with "A." For example, "All angles are awesome." Then go onto "B." "Bose buy big boat." This can be continued with the next alphabet until you can make sentences. You can also use this when you are not able to sleep at night.

Pick the strategies that echo most with you on this list and try incorporating into your routine. Finding the best stress relief strategy which suits you may take some time. Some strategies may take extra practice too. It's important to keep looking for the tools that help you manage life's unavoidable ups and down with good health. Keeping stress at a manageable level is important for our well-being. Rather than choosing one technique. We recommend sampling several to see which one works best for you. Try to practice at least a few minutes a day. But the longer and the more often you practice these techniques, greater the benefits.
