Let's move forward with Pride in who we are, and keep making a positive impact on the world. By doing this, we honor our past, improve our present, and ensure a bright future for everyone.

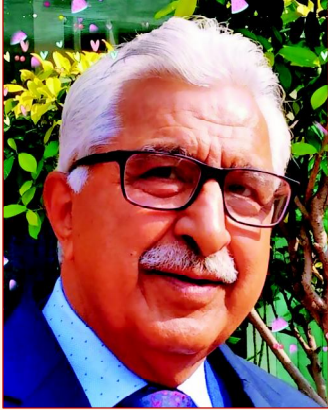

### Mehta Kasturi Lal Mohan (01 April 1922 – 05 June 1999)

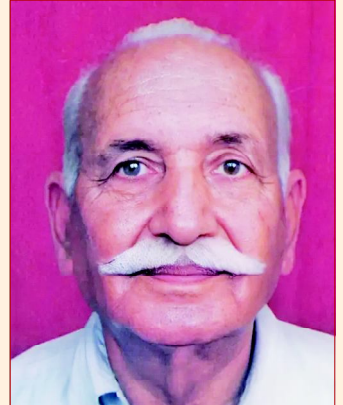

परिवार ने धार्मिक और सामाजिक संस्थाओं को कुछ दान भी दिया।

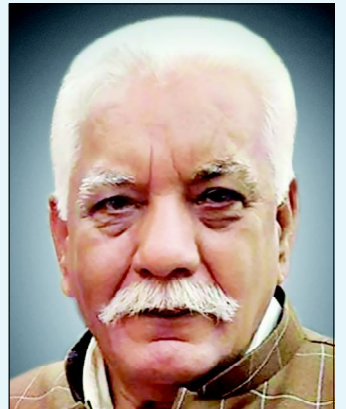
