
Rzd R.K Bali



MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatris, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after full payment of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran .
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
14. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar, is available only to yatri's staying in the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Yatri's and NO other activity is permitted.
18. In case of any inconvenience, Yatri's are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / Office bearer of GMS. Yatri's are requested to fill the feedback form before their departure.
19. Yatri's are requested to help in keeping the rooms and the premises of the Ashram clean. Yatri's are also requested to maintain decorum, while dealing with the staff posted at the Ashrams.
20. Yatris are requested to follow Covid 19 guidelines as per existing orders of the local government authorities.



होली पर्व की हार्दिक शुभकामनाएं

आईए जाने होली क्यों मनाते हैं?— यह त्योहार कृषि (Agriculture) से सम्बन्धित होने के कारण केवल हिन्दुओं का त्योहार नहीं, मनुष्यों का त्योहार है:—

दो प्रकार की *सस्य (=crops)* होती हैं:

1) वसन्त की सस्य (Spring Crops)- होली

इसके अन्तर्गत—गेहूँ (Wheat), जौ (Barley), मटर, चना, सरसों आदि अन्न आते हैं, *इन सस्यों को होला भी कहा जाता है*

इन सस्यों को *कार्तिक—मार्गशीर्ष = अगहन (Oct-Nov)* मास में कम तापमान—में बोया (sown) जाता है, और कटाई (Harvested), वसन्त ऋतु के आसपास *फाल्गुन—चैत्र (Feb-Mar)* में होती है। इस उपलक्ष्य में 'फाल्गुन पूर्णिमा' को 'वासन्तीय नवसस्येष्टि = होली' पर्व मनाया जाता है।

नव = New सस्य = Crops इष्टि = यज्ञ = हवन

2) शरद की सस्य (Autumn Crops)- दीपावली

इसके अन्तर्गत—धान (Rice), मकई, ज्वर, बाजरा, तूर, मूँग, उड़द (= माष), कपास, जूट, मूँगफली, सोयाबीन आदि अन्न आते हैं। इन सस्यों को *आषाढ—सावन (June-July)* में बोते (sow) हैं, और 'शरद ऋतु के आश्विन—कार्तिक (= Sept-Oct) मास ' के आस पास काटते (Harvest) हैं। इन सस्यों को बाते समय अधिक तापमान एवं आद्रता—नमी =humidity) की तथा पकते समय शुष्क (Dry) वातावरण की आवश्यकता होती है—इस उपलक्ष्य में 'कार्तिक अमावस्या' को 'शारदीय नवसस्येष्टि—दीपावली' का त्योहार मनाया जाता है।

*वसन्त ऋतु में आने वाले अनाज का जो छिलका (wrapper) होता है, उसे होलिका कहते हैं। होलिका दहन में छिलका तो जल जाता है, किन्तु छिलके के अन्दर प्रहाद—अन्न नहीं जलता, आयुर्वेद के अनुसार—वसन्त ऋतु में वात—पित्त—कफ आदि दोषों को सम रखने के लिए होलक (नए अन्न) को भून कर खाना चाहिए।

होलिका दहन को 'सम्बत् दहन (Combustion of the old year)* भी कहते हैं, 'चैत्र मास में ही भारतीय नववर्ष का प्रारम्भ भी होता है'।

वसन्त ऋतु में वृक्षों में नए पत्ते आ जाते हैं, और धरती रंग—बिरंगी, हरी—भरी हो जाती है। होली में हमें केमिकल वाले रंगों से दूर रहना चाहिए जो कि skin disease उत्पन्न करता है, अतः प्राकृतिक और सुरक्षित रंगों का उपयोग करना चाहिए—
