The accounts of the year 2021-22 and these amendments shall be put before the annual general body meeting for approval. ■ **Professor VN Datta (25 May 1926 – 30 November 2020):** One of our country's most eminent historians



Professor VN Datta (1926-2020) passed away on 30 November 2020 in New Delhi. He was born in Amritsar to the leading businessman and renowned Urdu-Persian poet Padma Shri Brahm Nath Datta 'Qasir'. Datta was educated at Hindu College Amritsar, Government College Lahore, Lucknow University and Cambridge University UK. He was married to Kamala Mehta, daughter of

Dewan Chand Mehta (Mohan), the most respected and eminent IPS officer in Independent India.

A distinguished historian, VN Datta was Emeritus Professor of Modern History, Kurukshetra University, and formerly General President of the Indian History Congress, Resident Fellow of Fitzwilliam College, Cambridge, and Visiting Professor to a number of universities including Moscow, Leningrad and Berlin. Datta is the author of several pioneering works on Indian history. Among his much acclaimed publications are: *Amritsar Past and Present*; *Jallianwala Bagh*; *New Light on Punjab Disturbances, Vol I and II*; *Madan Lal Dhillon and the Revolutionary Movement*; *Gandhi and Bhagat Singh*; *Sati: A Historical, Social and Philosophical Enquiry into the Hindu Rite of Widow-Burning*; *Maulana Azad and The Tribune, 130 Years: A Witness to History*. He regularly contributed to academic journals and popular press; his column "Off the Shelf" in *The Tribune* won him great accolades. He was writing a book on Gandhi and Sarala Devi Chaudhurani, wife of Chaudhry Ram Bhaj Dutt, in his last days.

Indeed, VN Datta's passing is the end of an era. A life-long friend Harivansh Rai Bachchan dedicated one volume of his '*Autobiography*' to VN Datta and his wife, Kamala. On his death, former Prime Minister Manmohan Singh sent a wreath as tribute to the family of the renowned historian. A shining star of the Mohyal community, Professor VN Datta will be much missed by a wider community of family, friends, scholars all over the world. He is survived by his three daughters and two grandsons.

## MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatris, 30 days in advance, which can be done online, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran.
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Online booking facility for rooms in SewaSadon, Haridwar is not available. Rooms can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
14. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar (all meals), is available only to yatri's staying in the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Yatri's and NO other activity is permitted.
18. In case of any inconvenience, Yatri's are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / Office bearer of GMS. Yatri's are requested to fill the feedback form before their departure.
19. Yatri's are requested to help in keeping the rooms and the premises of the Ashram clean. Yatri's are also requested to maintain decorum, while dealing with the staff posted at the Ashrams.
20. Yatri's are requested to follow Covid 19 guidelines, and to also carry with them Vaccination Certificate indicating they have taken both doses of the vaccination.

परशुराम

“अश्वात्थामा बलिव्यार्यासो हनुमांश्च विभिषणः

कृपः परशुराम सप्तैते चिरजीविनः ॥”

पृथ्वी पर कुछ व्यक्तित्व ऐसे हुए हैं जिनके कृत्य आज भी प्रेरक एवं चेतावनी भरे होने के कारण भौतिक रूप से पंचतत्व में मिलने के उपरांत उन्हें आज जीवित मान जाता है। शास्त्रों में ऐसे सात महापुरुष माने गए हैं।

ऐसे चिरंजीवी परशुराम त्रेता युग (रामायण काल) में एक ब्राह्मण ऋषि के यहाँ जन्मे थे। पौराणिक वृत्तांतों के अनुसार उनका जन्म महर्षि भृगु के पुत्र महर्षि जमदग्नि द्वारा संपन्न पुत्रेष्टि यज्ञ से प्रसन्न देवराज इंद्र के वरदान स्वरूप पत्नी रेणुका के गर्भ से वैशाख शुक्ल तृतीय को मध्यप्रदेश के इंदौर जिला में ग्राम मानपुर के जानापाव पर्वत में हुआ। वे भगवान विष्णु के आवेशावतार हैं। महाभारत और विष्णुपुराण के अनुसार परशुराम का मूल नाम राम था। जब भगवान शिव ने उन्हें अपना परशु नामक अस्त्र दिया तभी से उनका नाम परशुराम पड़ा। वे जमदग्नि का पुत्र होने के कारण जामदग्न्य भी कहलाए।

आरंभिक शिक्षा महर्षि विश्वामित्र एवं ऋचीक के आश्रम में ली। महर्षि ऋचीक ने शाकड्ग नामक दिव्य वैष्णव धनुष और ब्रह्मर्षि कश्यप से विधिवत अविशनाशी वैष्णव मंत्र प्राप्त हुआ। शिवजी से उन्हें श्रीकृष्ण का त्रैलोक्य विजय कवच, स्तवराज स्तोत्र एवं मंत्र कल्पतरु भी प्राप्त हुए। चक्रतीर्थ में किए कठिन तप से प्रसन्न हो विष्णु ने उन्हें त्रेता में रामावतार होने पर तेजोहरण के उपरांत कल्पांत पर्यंत तपस्यारत भूलोक पर रहने का वर दिया था।

परशुरामजी का उल्लेख रामायण, महाभारत, भागवद पुराण और कल्कि पुराण इत्यादि ग्रंथों में भी किया गया है। उन्होंने अंहकारी और धृष्ट हैहय वंशी क्षत्रियों का पृथ्वी से 21 बार संहार किया और यह कथा जग प्रसिद्ध है। वे धरती पर वैदिक संस्कृति का प्रचार प्रसार करना चाहते थे। ऐसा माना जाता है कि भारण के अधिकांश ग्राम उन्हीं के द्वारा बसाए गए हैं। जिसमें कोंकण, गोवा एवं केरल का समावेश है। पौराणिक कथा के अनुसार भगवान परशुराम ने तीर चला कर गुजरात से लेकर केरल तक समुद्र को पीछे धकेले हुए नयी भूमि का निर्माण किया था।

वे भार्गवा गोत्र के सबसे आज्ञाकारी संतानों में से एक हैं। वे माता-पिता, गुरुजनों और बड़ों का सदा आदर करते थे। उनकी आज्ञा की कभी अवहेलना नहीं करते थे। वे समूची प्रकृति को जीवित

मानते थे। वे एक ब्राह्मण के रूप में जन्मे थे पर कर्म से क्षत्रिय माने जाते थे। परशुराम ने अधिकांश विद्याएँ बाल्यावस्था में अपनी माता की शिक्षाओं से सीख ली थी। वे पशु-पक्षियों की भाषा भी समझते थे। भगवान परशुराम शस्त्र विद्या के धनी थे। उन्होंने कलरीपायट्टु या वथक्कन कलरी विकसित किया। और सप्त ऋषि अगस्त्य ने इसे आगे बढ़ाया। आज के युग में इसे मार्शल आर्ट कहते हैं। भगवान परशुराम मार्शल आर्ट के जनक मानते जाते हैं। उन्होंने सैन्यशिक्षा केवल ब्राह्मणों को दी। भीष्म, द्रोण एवं कर्ण अपवाद हैं।

परशुराम जी शस्त्रविद्या के महान गुरु थे। उन्होंने एकादश छंदयुक्त “शिव पंचत्वरिशनाम स्तोत्र भी लिखा। इच्छित फल प्रदाता परशुराम गायत्री हैं... “जामदग्न्य विदग्धे महावीरायः धीमहि, तन्नः परशुरामः प्रचोदयात्”। उन्होंने अत्रि की पत्नी अनसुया, अगस्त्य की पत्नी लोपामुद्रा और अपने शिष्य अकृतवण के सहयोग से विराट नारी-जागृति अभियान भी चलाया था।

परशुरामजी मोहयाल ब्राह्मणों के सप्त ऋषियों में से एक माने जाते हैं। छिब्वरों का गोत्र भी भार्गव या भृगु मानता जाता है। छिब्वर परशुराम के वंशज माने जाते हैं। भार्गव ब्राह्मण भी परशुराम के वंशज हैं। भगवान परशुराम अजर अमर हैं।
