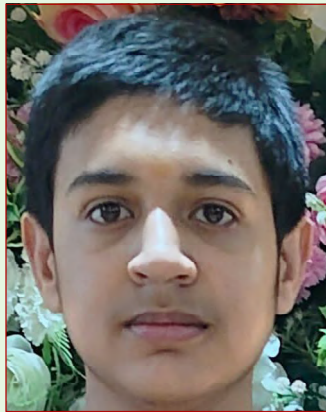

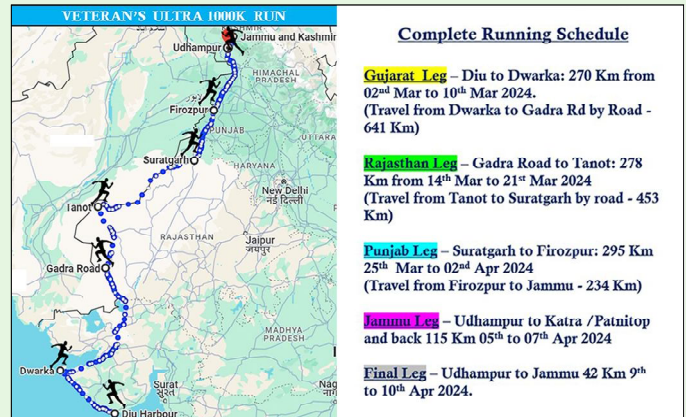

We used to start the run at 4 AM, run 30 to 32 Kms per day and thereafter rest the whole day. During the run, on the 26th day, having completed 810 Kms, at Sri Ganganagar, I developed a heart problem forcing me to abort it. I was evacuated to Medanta, Gurugram where two stents were placed in my artery.

Aim of writing this article in this magazine is to highlight following points:-

1. I had never run beyond 21 kms—I undertook this challenge primarily to challenge myself. Lesson—once you make up your mind, nothing is impossible.
2. I cursed Lord Almighty for doing this gross injustice shattering my life time dream of a 1 k run. But in retrospect, I now thank him for doing this at a time when I had a proper support system to ensure a hassle free medical help. I was in an Army Camp surrounded by my Comrades in Arm. What if this had happened while I was cycling alone in some remote area. Lesson—Don't doubt His way of dealing with you - always carry the feelings of Gratitude.

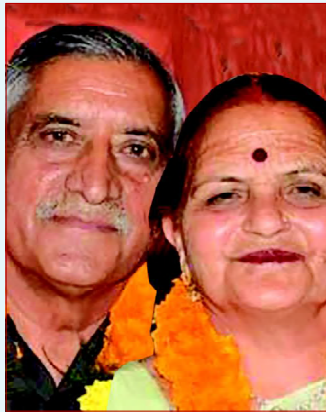

Wg Cdr Madan Mohan Bakshi (Retd) **(23 Mar 1931–21 April 2024)**



Wg Cdr Madan Mohan Bakshi (Retd), son of Shri Harbans Lal Mehta and Smt Leelavati Mehta, was born in Daska, West Punjab on 23 Mar 1931. Originally from Malkanwala, district Sialkot, his early childhood was spent in Dharamshala, Himachal Pradesh, where his father worked as a Prof in Economics in the then, Govt Intermediate College, Dharamshala. He did his Intermediate in Apr 1950 from this esteemed college. Later he was pursuing MSC

Physics at DAV College Kanpur when he finally realised his dream to become a transport pilot in the Indian Air force.

Wg Cdr Madan Mohan Bakshi (Retd) flew, Harvard Prentice and Tiger Moth Fairchild C-119G, known as the Packet, Dakotas, AN 12 and Avros. He was a Master Green Instructor and was active in the Line of Duty in the 1962, 1965 and 1971 Operations. He was also a qualified aeronautical Engineer from Yelahanka, a laurel which very few have achieved. He was sent on deputation to Hindustan Aeronautical Ltd as a Test Pilot especially for Hindustan Aeronautics HA-31 Basant, which first flew on 30 March 1972. He took premature retirement from the Air Force and joined the Directorate General Civil Aviation as the Chief Test Pilot in 1978, where he rose to the rank of Deputy Director General. He was involved in the calibration of both National and International airfields in the ASEAN countries. He was also in-charge of training and licence testing of various pilots including late Shri Rajiv Gandhi, former PM of India. He was sent on deputation to start the Druk Airline in 1982, the national airlines of Bhutan, at Paro, Dornier 228 aircraft. The airfield of Paro has been listed as one of top 10 difficult air strips in the world. He was awarded by the Royal Princess of Bhutan for his dedication and service to her Nation. Wg Cdr Madan Mohan Bakshi was instrumental in establishing Bhunter Airfield at Kulla and in establishing, calibrating and landing the first aircraft at Gagga, Kangra airfield. He always said that this was his biggest contribution to his hometown and State.

His wife, Mrs Nargis Bali-Bakshi, was a perfect combination of beauty with brains, having done her MA in Political Science in 1956. She, however, chose to be a homemaker while, with his wings, he rose to the skies. She lost the battle to Covid on 14 May 2021. The couple were blessed with two daughters. Their elder daughter, Maj Gen Rashmi Datta VSM (Retd) a renowned Anaesthesiologist, intensivist in the Army Medical Corps. She commanded the prestigious Command Hosp at Chandimandir. She is married to Surg Vice Admiral Rajat Datta, AVSM, SM VSM, PHS, ex-Director General Armed Forces Medical Services and a cardiologist of National and International repute. Their only son, Maj Shivesh Datta has followed the footsteps of his parents and is currently serving in the Army Medical Corps. Their younger daughter, Col Ritu Bakshi (Retd), also superannuated from the Army Medical Corps and is married

to Col Nand Kishore Subhedar (Retd), an Armoured Corps officer. They have two children, Nandita Subhedar-Harchand, a corporate lawyer working in a multinational firm, married to Naveen Harchand, a senior manager in Amazon. They are blessed with daughter Nayra, their son Natesh Subhedar has done his MSc physics from NIIT Rourkila, and after doing his MILS is working in an Institute in Dwarka.

Madan Mohan Bakshi is also survived by his two brothers Brig Brij Mohan Bakshi (Retd), an Engineer officer and Col Jag Mohan Bakshi (Retd) an Artillery officer.

His love for aviation was not just a profession but a passion that fuelled his spirit and shaped his legacy. His flights were not just journeys from one destination to another; they were stories of determination, courage, and dedication. essence of his passion, wisdom, and legacy. Beyond his achievements in the cockpit, Wg Cdr Madan Mohan Bakshi (Retd) was a beacon of strength, wisdom, and kindness. Wonderful son, son-in-law, father, husband, brother and friend. Since his father was away, he as the eldest son assumed the responsibility not only of his wife and daughters, but his brothers, sister and his in-laws. He touched all their lives with his warm smile, cheerful nature, positive attitude generous heart, and unwavering support. He was there with unflinching support in all the turmoil and tribulations. Always fighting fit was his motto!

He was a giver, rarely a taker. A tree not a creeper. As is life, when he was let down by those he went out of the way to help, he never cribbed about it. His motto was that when you deposit a Rs 100/- note in the bank, you will get Rs 105/-. Not the same note but the amount will be more than what you deposited. His words of guidance and comfort will forever echo in our hearts, guiding us through turbulent times and inspiring us to reach new heights. He used to tell us that whether we choose to be a cobbler or a gardener or a doctor, follow your passion and be the best in your field.

He has embarked on his final sortie on 21 Apr 2024 taking him to a new destination beyond our reach, re-uniting him with his beloved wife of 61 years! He was the youngest of three brothers, late Shri Anand Swaroop Mohan, late Shri Sarosh Mohan, and two sisters, late Smt Sushila Bakshi and late Smt Kunti Dutt. He was deeply attached and devoted to his mother whom all dearly called Bhabhji. He grew up in Shimla with his mother and elder brother since 1947, and

then in Delhi from early 1960s. In 1968, he was married to Smt Shashi Kiran Mohan, daughter of late Shri Amarnath Chhibber and late Smt Shanti Devi Chhibber. They raised five daughters and two sons, and are blessed with six grandchildren, all of whom he has loved very dearly.

Shri Naresh Mohan ji passed away for his heavenly abode on 16th May 2024, at the age of 82. His last rites were performed on 16th May at Lodi Crematorium, New Delhi, which was attended by members of his family, friends, and former colleagues.

He was a very proud Mohyal and was ardently committed to the Mohyal biradri. He was a philanthropist, always ready to help needy members of the Community. Shri Naresh Mohan ji was a warm, large hearted, kind, and generous human being who touched and transformed many lives. His charismatic radiating personality left people in awe and admiration even if they met him for a few minutes. He has been a guiding beacon, mentor, and pillar of strength for numerous people from all walks of life. He had a unique way of making everyone feel valued and respected and his sense of humor and positive spirit sparked brightness among all those he met. He immensely enjoyed cricket, films and music, food, and travel, and had wide-ranging interests including sports, politics, and current affairs. He had razor-sharp memory and encyclopedic deep knowledge on any topic of interest.

Shri Naresh Mohan ji was a well-known media leader, and widely recognised as the doyen of the newspaper and media world. Media industry persons refer to him as 'Bhishama Pitahmah' and 'Iron man' who dedicated with all sincerity his life fighting for the growth and upliftment of the newspaper industry. Countless benefits and facilities that the newspapers are enjoying today would not have been possible but for the efforts put in by him. The industry will remember his contributions for ages. Shri Naresh Mohan ji served the Hindustan Times in various management capacities, including as Executive President, for almost three decades. Naresh Mohan ji became synonymous with Hindustan Times in the 80s and 90s, becoming its Executive President in 1982. By 1986, under his leadership,

Hindustan Times underwent a technological transformation, and rejuvenation. He led Hindustan Times in expanding beyond the national capital for the first time in its 62-year history, spearheading the launch of a new venture in Patna, Bihar, overseen by Shri Naresh Mohan ji personally. Within couple of years of his taking over, by 1984, Naresh Mohan's professional acumen became evident in the remarkable growth of the readership across all HT Group publications.

He was a pillar of the Indian Newspaper Society from 1982 until his retirement in August 2023. He was the foremost authority on government media policies and had an unparalleled understanding of the historical battles fought by media institutions since Independence. Naresh Mohan ji's vision and strategic leadership uplifted the Indian print media. Furthermore, Shri Naresh Mohan ji was on leadership and Board Director roles in The Tribune, The Statesman and Jagaran among others leading newspapers across India. He was also a member of The Tribune Trust for several years and served with distinction on the boards of The Statesman Limited and Jagran Prakashan Limited. Over the course of a career spanning more than five decades, he served as Chairman of the Audit Bureau of Circulations and United News of India and President of INS in the early 1990s. He has also been a member of the Press Council of India and the industry representative on Wage Boards. His distinguished and dedicated decades long career left an indelible impact on the media industry.

Shri Naresh Mohan ji is fondly remembered as incomparable humanitarian manager, as well as for his visionary exceptional leadership, and profound impact on media industry that benefitted immensely from his guidance and strategic insights.

Union Minister Anurag Thakur, Information and Broadcasting Minister also paid his respects in a heartfelt post on 'X', where expressing his sorrow he said: "Saddened by the demise of Naresh Mohan ji, a distinguished media personality who, in his career spanning decades, held numerous posts and left an indelible impact through his works and erudition. 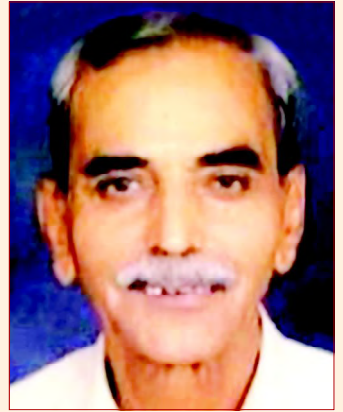
Smt Savita Bali

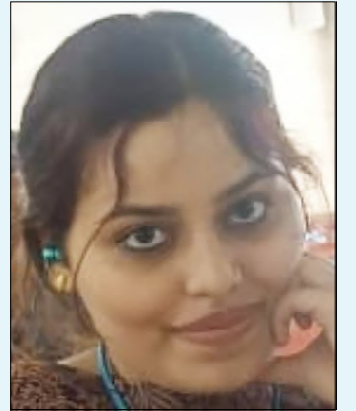
