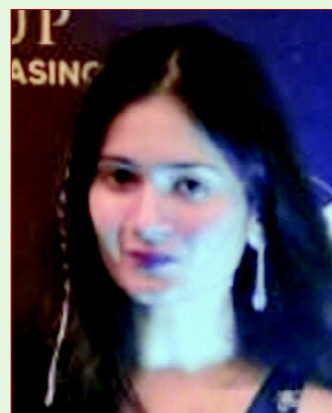

As such, the meeting was presided over by Shri Satish Kumar Mehta. After Mohyal prayer, he formally asked the Secretary to proceed on the Agenda of the Annual General Body Meeting, and the Secretary proceeded further.

The proceedings of the last meeting held on 13 April 2025 were read out and passed unanimously. The accounts for the month of Mar and Apr 2025 were presented and were also passed unanimously.

The House conveyed its greetings to the members and their spouses who have their birthdays and wedding anniversaries in the month of May 2025 and wished them good health and lots of happiness.

The cashier Shri Rajeev Dutta presented the Audited Statement of Accounts for the period from 1.04.2024 to 31.03.2025. This was proposed by Shri Pardeep Mehta and Seconded by Shri Gagan Chhibber and was finally approved by the House.

As per the constitution of the Sabha, there should have been 14 Members in the governing body. Due to the death of Shri Surinder Dutta and the Resignation of Shri Pardeep Mohan on health grounds, which was accepted by the President, had fallen vacant. For irregularities and lapses, if any, the previous Governing body up to 2003 was responsible. He further specifically mentioned three shops of whose rent was not enhanced for years together. He further explained the timely enhancement of rent of each and every shop from 2004 to 2024.

Advice to Senior Citizens by Shri G K Bali, Senior Vice President: Be Careful to Prevent Falling and Choking: A Senior Citizen of 62 years was admitted to hospital for choking in his lungs after drinking a glass of water at 11:00 pm. He was rushed to hospital for emergency treatment but unfortunately died. His sudden death tells Senior Citizens that no matter what they do, they must pay attention to two things:

- One is to Prevent Falling
- And the other is to Prevent Choking

After 60 and beyond, one has to begin to train themselves:

When drinking water - Stop everything and concentrate on drinking water carefully and slowly.

The elderly are prone to choking because the throat and swallowing muscles have degenerated and lack muscle strength.

The following information is passed on by a doctor who is still active in the medical field. It is worth reference, especially when

- Use a straw, if possible, while drinking water and keep your head down when swallowing.
- Please drink thick soup instead of dilute one. Dilute soup flows quickly and it is easy to choke when breathing is not smooth.
- Please do not drink liquid while there is still solid food in your mouth, or while chewing. If the water stays in the mouth for some time, it will flow into the trachea and cause choking if you are not careful.
- Do not speak or turn your head when there is food or water in your mouth.
- Old people do not have the same physical strength and endurance as young people.

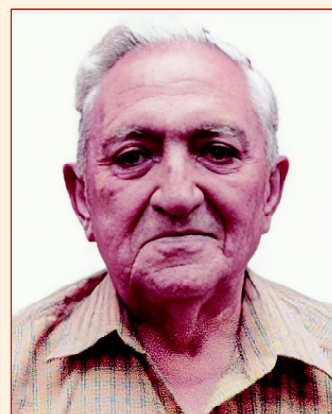

Shri Harsh Dev Bali (21 Sep 1921 – 4 May 2021)

Shri Harsh Dev Bali, was born in Samba, J&K on 21 Sep 1921. He was the eldest of six children – two boys and six girls – born to Shri Lekh Raj Bali. The family was based in Rawalpindi, after partition, they moved to New Delhi. Coming from a humble background, Shri Harsh Dev Bali chose to continue his education beyond school, even though his family was struggling to support itself. He became a science graduate and for the rest of his life, pursued science and technology as his passion.



He joined service with the Punjab Police as a technician in the Wireless Department, serving in Dharamshala, Simla and finally in Chandigarh. In 1952, he married Sneh Prabha Bali, whom he had known during his childhood in Rawalpindi. Mrs Bali, now well past 95 years of age, was a teacher and moved along with her husband, teaching English and Social Studies in several government schools. The couple was blessed with two children. Their son Neeraj Bali joined the Army and rose to the rank of Major General. Their daughter Anju followed in the footsteps of her mother and became a teacher.

The defining characteristics of Shri Harsh Dev Bali were his shining positivity, inclination to serve the community and a great sense of humour. Post his retirement, he devoted himself to Panchkula's Mohyal Sabha, initially as its Secretary and then as the President. He served the Mohyal community for decades and was instrumental in welding it together with hard work and spreading the message through a monthly journal that he single-handedly compiled, edited and published. The couple lived a fiercely independent life till 2011, when their son, now a Major General, insisted that they live with him. Shri Harsh Dev Bali spent the remaining years with his son and daughter-in-law and passed away on 4 May 2021 at Dera Bassi.

(17 Sep 1936 – 14 May 2024)



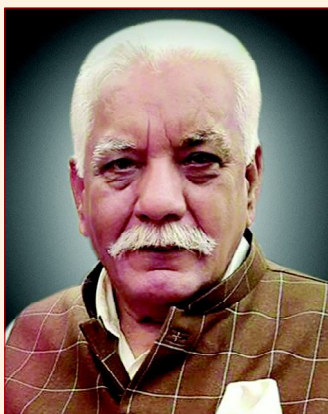

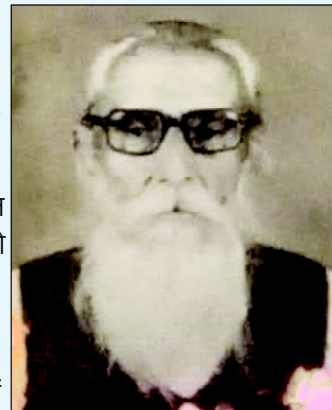
