Members of the community headed by Rzd. B. D. Bali and Smt. Neeta Bali, friends, well wishers, civil servants, members of Judiciary and the Bar joined these celebrations and showered love and blessings on the young turbaned hero.

On this auspicious occasion, Bk. B. L. Chhibber donated Rs.11000/- to GMS for addition to the corpus of “Bakshi Harichand and Smt Sundari Devi Chhibber (Shamsabadwale) Memorial Trust”, established with GMS since 2006, in the sacred and perpetual memory of great Grandparents of Master Shivansh Chhibber, to take the total Corpus amount to Rs.1,37,200/-.

CHANGE IN THE LEADERSHIP OF THE GENERAL MOHYAL SABHA

We congratulate Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM for assuming the office of President of GMS, on the sad demise of Mohyal Ratna Rzd B D Bali on 12th July 2019 and wish him a successful tenure to carry on the good work done by Bali Sahab and fill up the gaps which remain uncompleted in the life time of Bali Sahab.

A brief history of GMS since its birth is narrated here to make known the background of the Sabha for the youth of today. It was over 128 years back on a hot afternoon of May 24, 1891 that a small team of wise men of the Mohyal Community led by Munshi Bakshi Ram Das Chhiber, got together at Lahore and established an organization then named as Mohyal Mitter Sabha on the lines of similar organizations like Congress and Arya Samaj etc. It was in 1858 after the failed first war of independence of India in 1857 that Punjab along with rest of India under the British East India Company was transferred to the British Crown under Queen Victoria. It is then that the period of modernization of the Punjab region inhabited by the Mohyal Community started. As compared to other communities in Punjab Mohyals were better educated in Persian, Urdu and Gurmukhi as they had very successfully served as senior bureaucrats both under the Muslim and Sikh Rulers. This qualification of Mohyals enabled them to adjust beautifully in the modern era started by the Britishers and better educated amongst them easily picked up the English language and manners and could conveniently interact with the new rulers.

When Mohyal Mitter Sabha was established in 1891 it had its own priorities to take care of its widows, students, matrimonial and communication. The average span of life expectancy at that time was below 40. Widows remarriage was a taboo and women lived longer than men with the result that there was a large number of Mohyal widows with almost no means of livelihood. The Sabha started to give two silver rupees a month to such widow applicants. A small nominal scholarship was given either by the Sabha or some rich Mohyal philanthropists to the deserving bright and poor Mohyal students directly. A matrimonial register was kept in the Sabha office of marriageable Mohyal boys and girls. In the field of Communication a monthly Mohyal Mitter magazine was started with its first issue in September 1891. All these activities cost money, the only source of which was voluntary donations from members of the community. When there was scarcity of money some or all of these activities including publication of Mohyal Mitter had to be stopped temporarily.

Lahore, being the capital of Punjab was the main centre of education where Mohyal students had to come from their villages and small cities for higher education. The main difficulty faced by them was the lack of living accommodation at reasonable price. The Sabha started a hostel from the rented premises but this experiment did not work which led to the most marvelous achievement of Sabha in its whole history i.e. collection of money, purchase of a plot of land and construction of a hostel with the name 'MOHYAL ASHRAM' at Lahore for both Mohyal and Non-Mohyal students. In the field of employment also the Mohyals did wonderfully well.

The biggest disaster for the country in general and for the Mohyal Community in particular occurred in 1947 in the form of partition of the country. Majority of Mohyals were inhabitants of the areas now in Pakistan and Pakistan occupied Kashmir. Many of them lost their lives, lands, homes, properties and business etc. and came to India as penniless refugees. The Sabha became the biggest refugee and had to abandon its loved creation Mohyal Ashram in Lahore. Fortunately one brave Mohyal Ch. Jagan Nath Dutt Mianiwala was able to bring all its records, accounts and old copies of Mohyal Mitter to India. A shelter was provided by Sardars Amar Singh and Sardar Shamsher Singh in their Amritsar Sugar Mills at Chhaharta on the outskirts of Amritsar. Another prominent Mohyal Ch. Amir Chand Dutt, the Editor of Mohyal Mitter at Lahore suffered a personal tragedy as his son was shot dead by a Muslim Police Officer and property was looted by the mob, He came to India empty handed but the first thing he did on reaching Amritsar, inspite of his personal tragedies, was to start working on the revival of Mohyal Mitter which started publication and distribution within a short period of two months. GMS started functioning from Amritsar with almost no financial resources. Shortly thereafter, with the support of Mehta N N Mohan, GMS shifted operating from a small room at Chabi Ganj, Kashmiri Gate, Delhi, a godown of Mohan Meakins. Then it was shifted to Inderpuri where now Inderpuri Mohyal Bhavan is located. This plot of land was purchased from the Inderpuri Society for an amount of Rs. 4,000/-. The registration papers were signed by Bakhsi Dhan Raj Chhibber, the then General Secretary, on behalf of the GMS.

From 1947 to 1978 almost 30 years, The GMS was functioning intermittently with a limp, with hardly having any young Mohyal taking interest in its functioning. It is at that time in 1978, the then President of the GMS Mehta Harichand Mohan, elder brother of Mehta N.N. Mohan, persuaded the young Mohyal Raizada B.D. Bali, son in law of Mehta N.N. Mohan to join the GMS and take over as its President. Thankfully, Bali Sahib agreed to this proposal and accepted the position of President of GMS and started attending meetings of the Managing Committee under a leaking tin shed sitting on coir or jute flooring in Inderpuri. The financial position of the GMS was very precarious. The total liquid assets was only few thousand rupees and trust money equal to around Rs 2 lakh. Bali Sahib put in his heart and soul, worked very hard at the expense of his valuable time from his business with his sincerity, devotion and leadership qualities, and his knack of choosing a competent team of workers to assist him in his hard work for the welfare and promotion of Mohyal community. The foundations laid by our elders Munshi Bakshi Ram Das Chhibers and others, was further strengthened and Bali Sahib brought stability, credibility and also consolidated the Community from all over the world after it was scattered in the wake of partition of the country.

We are fully satisfied to note that the Managing Committee of the GMS in its meeting held on August 11, 2019, to pay homage to Rzd B D Bali, which was also his birthday, unanimously elected Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM, as President of GMS as proposed by Shri P K Dutta, Vice President GMS. 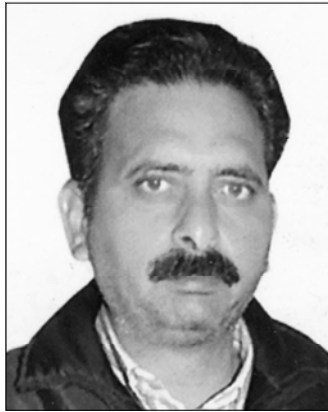
Om Shanti Om !

MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked on line, 30 days in advance.
 - Haridwar web site:
www.mohyalashramharidwar.mohyal.com
 - Vrindavan/Goverdhan web site:
www.mohyalashram.co.in
2. Bookings can also be done on telephone and at the counter.
3. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
4. Room bookings can be done after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
5. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
6. Room donors to donate 25% of the standard room rates (Non Mohyal rates) / pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
7. Donations can be made only in Indian currency.
8. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashram is strictly prohibited.
9. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
10. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dining Hall.
11. Pets (Animals) are not allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
12. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
13. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
14. Online booking facility for rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar is not available. Rooms can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
15. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
16. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
17. Facility of free langar (all meals), is available only to residents of the Ashram.

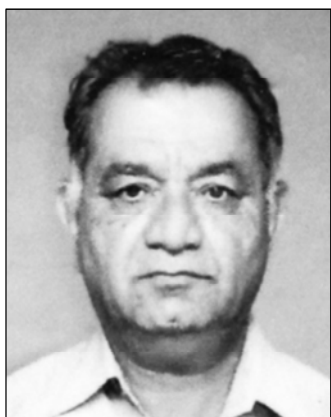

धनतेरस (धन त्रयोदशी) आयुर्वे के जनक श्री धनवन्तरी हैं। यह उन्हीं की जयन्ती के रूप में मनाया जाता है। अकाल मृत्यु से रक्षा हेतु इनसे आशीर्वाद माँगा जाता है। इस दिन श्री धनवन्तरी व यमराज के निमित्त घर के मुख्य द्वार पर दीप जलाकर आरोग्य व दीर्घायु की कामना करते हैं।

छोटी दीवाली (नरक चतुर्दशी) नरक यातना से बचने के लिए सूर्योदय से पूर्व स्नान करके नरक से बचने की कामना करें। एवं सांयकाल चार मुख वाला दीपक जलाएँ।

दीपावली इस दिन श्री गणेश, श्री लक्ष्मी, श्री कुबेर व माँ सरस्वती का पूजन किया जाता है।

गोवर्धन पूजा कार्तिक मास की शुक्ल पक्ष की प्रतिपदा को गोवर्धन पूजा व अन्नकूट का पर्व मनाया जाता है। इस दिन पशुधन व गोवर्धन पूजा का विधान है। जीवन में स्थायित्व व सुख समृद्धि ही इस पूजा का उद्देश्य है। विश्वकर्मा जी के प्रति दीप दान करें। घर में टूट-फूट से छुटकारा प्राप्त होगा। चित्रगुप्त जी की पूजा भी इसी दिन करते हैं।

भाई दूज दीपावली के बाद अंतिम त्योहार भाई-दूज के रूप में मनाया जाता है। कार्तिक मास शुक्ल पक्ष द्वितीया को भाई दूज या यम द्वितीया मनाया जाता है।

कार्तिक मास की अमावस्या तिथि व उस दिन के बार का नाम लें। कहें दिवी महालक्ष्मी को प्रसन्न करने का संकल्प लेता है/लेती हूँ।

कलश पूजन कलश में जल भर उस पर मोली लिपटा नारियल रखें व पूजा स्थान पर थोड़े चावल बिछाकर उस पर स्थापित कर दें। सभी देवी-देवताओं का निवास इसी कलश में होता है। फिर निम्न मंत्र बोलते हुए कलश पर अक्षत पर पुष्प चढ़ाएँ। ऊँ भूर्भुवः स्वः कलशस्थ देवताभ्यो नमः। गन्धं, अक्षतं, यत्रं पुष्पं समर्पयामि। वही पर एक दीपक भी प्रज्ज्वलित करें।

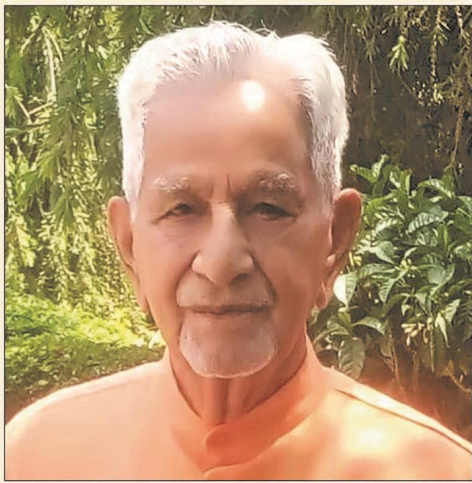
