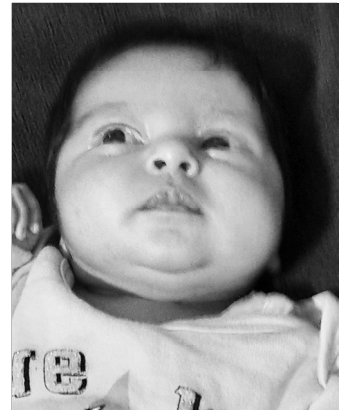

FROM THE DIARY OF A FIRST TIME DAIRY ENTREPRENEUR

Trust an engineer to get to the root of a problem. When his father was wary of the quality of milk supplied at their home, Vinod Kumar Dutt knew he had to solve the issue. The Engineer and an MBA from Kurukshetra University who was working as a teaching assistant dared to use this opportunity to step into the Dairy Industry. He launched HF (Hygienic Foods) Super in 1993 when the dairy sector was still in a nascent stage with challenges galore. HF Super started with an initial capacity to process 25,000 liters of milk per day, now stands tall with a capacity of 5 lakh liters of milk per day. Spread over an area of 10.5 acres, the plant is fully equipped to manufacture and pack Pasteurised milk, UHT milk, Butter, Ghee, Milk Powder, Paneer, Dahi, Lassi, Flavoured Milk, etc.

A leader of the dairy industry, Mr Dutt has one guiding principle - quality above all. He says, "Since the outset, we always focused on the quality of milk and likewise for all other dairy products; we invested heavily in technology and testing. Our unit is equipped with top machinery and has computerized reporting that eliminates the need for manual intervention. From the time of procurement to the final dispatch, we conduct rigorous checks to meet the desired quality," says Mr Dutt. His goals were clear. Change the low margin, high volume nature of the game. Introduce technology to disrupt the traditional ways of doing business and help farmers in augmenting their income. The company's powerful brand strategy, driven by innovation in mass product categories, turned out to be a game-changer and resulted in becoming a market-leading food brand in the Northern region.

Dutt focused on market penetration, rather than spread out. As he say, *"India is not a market where you can just throw capital expand and grow furiously. Regional players do get tempted or pushed to explore new pastures but 25% market share in one state is always better than 5% in multiple regions. My aim is to build a regionally strong brand and take it forward"*. Dutt bets on innovation to drive value to the customer. The company's proposition of UHT milk is compelling. "For consumers hooked onto the conventional practice of boiling the milk before consumption, 'no more boiling is a big hook," says Mr Dutt. Deemed the milk wave of the future, it comes in a unique three - layer Tripak packaging, with a black inner layer, keeping the milk fresh for up to 90 days. Dutt believes in investing in the brand through all times.



During the Covid-19 induced lockdown and disruptions he kept investing to expand into the UHT milk and ice cream businesses. He expects the revenue to touch INR 1,000 crores by FY 2026-27 for the continuous capital expenditure done in the last two years.

Dutt is committed to ethical, transparent practices. HF Super will stay focused on its 'purpose' of addressing the 'trust deficit' between consumers and food and provide fair value to farmers by eliminating middlemen. They have already tied up with Nationalised Banks to provide easy loans to farmers as part of their 'ethical milk-sourcing programme'. In recent years, it has forayed into bakery products to provide fresh and quality products to its consumers. The high-tech bakery plant, established in 2016, manufactures a delicious range of bread, buns, rusks, pav and cookies. The company had also launched a wide array of ice cream flavours like Vanilla, Choco Chip, Blackcurrant, Afghan Dry Fruit. Shahi Tukda, Royal Rabri, Paan, Kesar Pista and more.

Dutt's efforts have been acknowledged and recognized with National Awards for Outstanding Entrepreneurship by then Prime Minister Manmohan Singh and another one for Lean Manufacturing Techniques. Chanakya Dairy Products stood first in both these categories. They have also been bestowed with the Udyog Rattan Award and Indira Gandhi Sadbhavna Award. As Mr. Dutt plans to expand the company to the rest of North India, his sons and their wives, join his team to add muscle and help him realize his vision. Much is expected of Vidur and Vinni and Chanakya and Ruby Dutt, as they step in to take the company to newer heights. After all, they are chips of the same block.

ELECTIONS – JALANDHAR MOHYAL SABHA (REGD)

**MOHYAL ASHRAMS
HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN**

1. Rooms can be booked 30 days in advance, which can be done online, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited.
8. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Online booking facility for rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar is not available. Rooms can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.
14. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar (all meals), is available only to yatri's staying in the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Yatri's and NO other activity is permitted.
18. In case of any inconvenience, Yatri's are requested to speak to the Manager of the Ashram / Office bearer of GMS. Yatri's are requested to fill the feedback form before their departure.
19. Yatri's are requested to help in keeping the rooms and the premises of the Ashram clean.
20. Yatri's are also requested to maintain decorum, while dealing with the staff posted at the Ashrams.

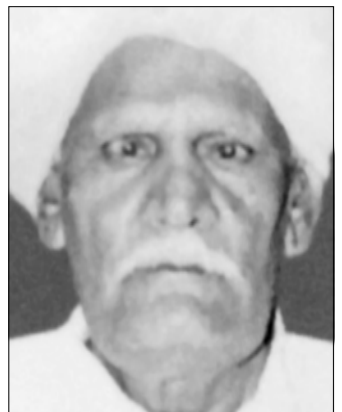
