Padma Shri N. N. MOHAN Ji (Posthumously)

Padma Shri N.N. Mohan, son of Shri Desraj Mohan and Smt Karam Devi, was born on 25 October 1900 at Ballaharwal, District Ajnala, Punjab and left for his heavenly abode on 15 July 1969, at the age of 69 yrs. Hearing the sad news, people belonging to all walks of life in the country and abroad, who had any connection with the Mohan family or House of Mohan Meakin, sent their condolences, which included Prime Minister of India, Minister of Industrial Development & Company Affairs, Minister of Agriculture, Community Development & Cooperation, Governor of Uttar Pradesh, Embassy of USA, New Delhi.


Respected Narinder Nath Mohan Ji, started his business career in a modest way in Rawalpindi in 1920 and gradually built it up. At the time of Partition, he was forced to migrate to India and had to work very hard to re-establish himself literally from scrap. He joined Dyer Meakin Breweries Ltd (British owned Company), with which he was earlier associated in various capacities. He joined as Financial Adviser and ultimately took over as its Managing Director in 1949. At that time the Company had very limited activities with only a Brewery at Solan and a Distillery at Lucknow.

He was a self-made man who achieved great success in his life by his foresight, skillful planning and organizing ability. He not only expanded the existing activities of the Company manifold but entered into various other fields such as fruit products, breakfast foods, milk products, abrasives and glass factory. He was ably assisted in his endeavours by his three sons, late Padma Bhushan Col. V.R. Mohan, Brig Kapil Mohan, VSM and Shri Sukhdev Mohan. At the time of his premature demise in 1969, Padma Shri N.N. Mohan was also Managing Director of John Oakey & Mohan Ltd, Chairman of National Cereals Products Ltd and Director of Nahan Foundry (H.P.) and Royal Exchange Assurance. The present large and sprawling Industrial Complex and township at Mohan Nagar, is a living monument to Padma Shri N N Mohan's business acumen and entrepreneurship. The Company was rightly named after him as Mohan Meakin Ltd. in his life time and he is now remembered as the Father of the House of Mohan Meakins.

Padma Shri N.N. Mohan Ji, a dynamic person, was a strict tee-totaller, a non-smoker and believed in quality of high moral standards based on firm and solid principles. According to him the true worship of Almighty God was to love one's fellowmen. He treated his workers and staff with utmost care, affection and sympathy. He was actively engaged and associated with various charitable and social organisations and espoused and supported all good causes. He was a very widely travelled man and a great philanthropist, who donated large sums for Public Institutions and welfare of Defence Forces. Almost, while on death-bed, he conceived the idea of a hospital for service to the humanity. His dying wish was fulfilled, by his able and devoted sons, by completing the project at a cost of almost Rs 5 crores, and dedicating the same to the memory of their illustrious father, suitably named Narinder Mohan Hospital, presently functioning at Mohan Nagar.

Padma Shri N N Mohan Ji was a very devout Mohyal, who was a pillar of strength and fortitude for the Community. He came on the scene when the GMS was in complete disarray and he was mainly responsible for resurrecting and nurturing it, and helped GMS at every stage to find its firm footings after the havoc of partition. He gave employment to hundreds of Mohyals in his various establishments. He was President of two Mohyal Conferences held in Amritsar in 1953 and in New Delhi in 1958.

Mohan Meakin is a gleaming star on the horizon of Mohyal community and testimony to the entrepreneurship and hard work of one of its ablest sons – late Padma Shri N N Mohan Ji, who has made the entire Mohyal Community very proud by his achievements as an Industrialist, Philanthropist and father figure of the Mohyal Community. We bow our heads in utmost reverence to one of the greatest Mohyals of our times, and in recognition of his meritorious services and bringing glory to the Mohyal Community, the Managing Committee of GMS and the entire Mohyal Community honours, Padma Shri N N Mohan Ji (Posthumously) with the highest award of the Community “Mohyal Ratna”, and invite his daughter Smt Nita Bali Ji, wife of late Mohyal Ratna Rzd B D Bali Ji, to kindly accept the award on behalf of the Tallest and Greatest Mohyal of the Community.

Annual General Body meeting was held at Mohyal Foundation, A-9, Qutab Institutional Area, USO Road, Jeet Singh Marg, New Delhi, on Sunday, 19 Nov 2023. The Programme started at 0900 hrs, with Registration, wherein members signed their attendance on arrival at the venue and cordially interacted with each other as a extended family. Since the quorum was not complete at the stipulated time, the meeting was adjourned for 15 minutes. Thereafter, Shri Rit Mohan, Secretary Public Relations GMS and Stage Secretary for this prestigious function, requested members to assemble for flag hoisting. 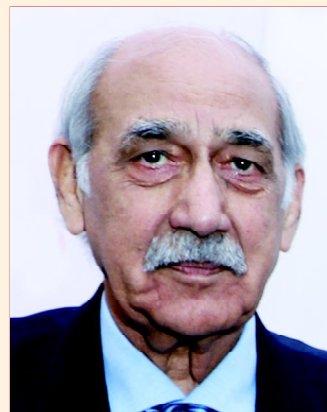
ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING HELD AT MOHYAL FOUNDATION ON 19 NOVEMBER 2023

REPORT BY SECRETARY GENERAL GMS

My Dear Brothers and Sisters, JAI MOHYAL

On behalf of Shri Vinod Kumar Dutt, President and Members of GMS Managing Committee, I extend a very warm welcome to you all. It is heartening to see members from Local Sabhas, some of you having travelled long distances to be part of this prestigious gathering. Personally it is a matter of great honour for me to be with you all today. We look forward to having a healthy interaction as an extended family, and finding workable solutions for the welfare, progress and prosperity of our great Community.

He said, the Business session will include, Report by the Secretary General, Presentation of Accounts by Secretary Finance, Points from Members and Resolutions to be adopted. After completing the AGM proceedings, we will have the Awards function, wherein we will honour, Padma Shri N N Mohan (Posthumously), with the highest award of the Community, "Mohyal Ratna", for his tremendous contribution in resurrecting and nurturing the Mohyal Community, and also honour some members of our Community.



I will now update you on the events which have taken place, since the last AGM, which was held at Mohyal Foundation New Delhi on 13 November 2022, details of which have been published in Mohyal Mitter November 2022 issue.

Education is very important to make progress and to take the family / community forward. GMS is committed to ensure that no Mohyal child is deprived of education for want of funds. Our Schools at Dehradun and Haridwar are running smoothly. Major K R Bali Mohyal School at Dehradun, started in 2007, is upto class 8, has 321 students. It is functioning under the guidance of our Managing Committee Member Shri Pramod Mehta (Vaid), President of MS Dehradun. Mohyal Public School at Haridwar, started in 2012, is upto class 5, has 139 students. It is functioning under the guidance of our Managing Committee Member Shri Girish Mohan. The activities of the School are regularly being printed in our monthly magazine Mohyal Mitter. Financial help is being given for education to 55 needy students ie Rs 250/- pm (Class KG) to Rs 3000/- pm (Post Graduation), depending on the class in which the child is studying. The financial aid is sent twice a year ie from April to September and from October to March.

Technology is developing rapidly, and is easily available to all, as a consequence our children have to face tough competition, initially to get admission in colleges of their choice and later for suitable job placements, which are available in many fields. They have therefore to be motivated to excel academically, as well as in sports, art and cultural activities. Pratibhashalee Mohyal Vidyarthee Samman was held at Faridabad, for academic year 2022 on 5 Feb 2023, kind courtesy MS Faridabad, details of which have been printed in Mohyal Mitter Feb 2023 Issue. Pratibhashalee Mohyal Vidyarthee Samman was held at Yamuna Nagar, for academic year 2023 on 8 Oct 2023, kind courtesy MS Yamuna Nagar where students scoring 80% and above marks, were honoured. There were total of 60 students, 29 from Class XII (boys 13 and girls 16) and 31 from Class X (15 boys and 16 girls). 14 students from Class XII (boys 6, girls 8) and 12 students from X (boys 7, girls 5), scored 90% and above marks.

It is a healthy sign to see our Youth, actively involved in the activities of their respective Sabhas and GMS events. Mohyal Youth Camp was held at Amritsar on 25-26 November 2022, kind courtesy MS Amritsar and included a trip to Wagah Border, to witness the famous Beating Retreat Ceremony, Group Discussion, Cultural Evening and visit to Golden Temple. The next Mohyal Youth Camp, was organized by MS Prem Nagar and MS Dehradun on 26-27 May 2023, and included a Adventure activity, Shimpur River Rafting, in which 10 rafts were used and carried 8 members each, Cultural Programme on two evenings and a Yoga session.

GMS is committed to help the Needy Widows and the Underprivileged members of our Community. Financial assistance of Rs 1500/- pm has been given to 508 widows and 108 underprivileged persons in this Financial Year. Financial assistance is being sent directly to the bank accounts of the individuals, once a quarter. In addition, Shri Vinod Kumar Dutt, President GMS and Shri P K Dutta, Sr Vice President GMS, have been helping the needy members of the

community, by giving them e-rickshaws and financial grant, to make them financially independent with a regular source of income. Financial assistance for medical treatment, is also being given to the needy mohyals on, need to need basis.

In order to encourage and facilitate marriages within the community. Mohyal Match Making get-togethers are regularly held. The Last get-together was held at Mohyal Foundation on 16 July 2023, which was a grand success, due to efforts put in by Smt Neelima Datta Mehta, Secretary Matrimonial. Particulars of boys and girls for matrimonial alliance are also being regularly published in our monthly magazine Mohyal Mitter.

Mohyal Milans organized by the Local Sabhas, are a important platform, where Mohyal brothers and sisters get an opportunity to interact with each other, which help to further bind the community together. Mohyal Milans were organized by MS Prem Nagar Dehradun on 20 Nov 2022, MS Faridabad on 5 Feb 2023 alongwith Pratibhashalee Mohyal Vidyarthi Samman, MS Panipat 19 Feb 2023 alongwith Presidents and Secretaries Meeting, MS Rohini/Pitampura on 7 May 2023, MS Dehradun on 29 Oct 2023.

There has been some delay in completion of renovation work at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar, which has been due to unprecedented heavy rains and administrative constraints. We plan to complete the same, latest by Feb / March 2024. There is little work left to be done at Major K R Bali Mohyal School, Dehradun and Mohyal Ashram Vrindavan, which will be completed shortly.

MERIT was established at Delhi in Oct 1999 by GMS, to impart computer education, with emphasis on Information technology. It has been accredited to the National Council for Vocational Training for conducting Computer Operator & Programming Assistant course (COPA) since 2008. More than 650 students have been trained in COPA with pass percentage of over 99%. It is also conducted Data Base System Assistant Trade for which more than 45 students have been enrolled in the session. Four Mohyal Students have been enrolled in COPA trade. MERIT is also a Programme Study Centre of IGNOU for conducting their distance education courses in BCA/MCA/IT Skill etc and a testing centre for Test of English as a foreign language (TOEFL since 2007) and Graduate Record Examination (GRE since 2013). It became an IGNOU Exam Centre in 2014 for conducting exams for all the programmes offered by IGNOU. In July-Dec 2023, session more than 3300 students were allotted by IGNOU Regional Center, Delhi. As an incentive, no fees are charged from Mohyal students admitted to COPA course in MERIT. Mohyal students, who get admission in MERIT study Centre for BCA & MCA courses of IGNOU, are reimbursed 50% of the fees.

GMS has created fixed assets in the form of Ashrams/Bhawans at Haridwar, Vrindavan, Goverdhan, Inderpuri, Mohyal Foundation and Yamuna Nagar, over period of time. It is a matter of great pride for all of us, that no loans have been taken to create these assets, which has been done through donations received from our large hearted Community. I will like to name, Sdr Avtar Singh Datta who is a great philanthropist.

Portion of phase 1 of Mohyal Foundation has been given on rent for Rs Eleven lacs per month, less 10% given to DDA, wef 16 Jan 2019, which is a major and regular source of our income and is used to supplement, the welfare projects of the community. Property, B-64 Defence Colony Meerut, donated to GMS by late Major Amar Nath Chhibber, has been given on rent for Rs 18,000/- pm. This property is being looked after by our Managing Committee Member, Col S.K. Vaid, President Mohyal Sabha Meerut, for which we are grateful to him.

The Mohyal Community has made tremendous progress and has reached where it is today, only because of our Unity and Contributions made by all of us, over a long period of time. I wish to put on record, selfless services of our revered leader, great visionary, late Mohyal Ratna Rzd B D Bali Ji, former President GMS for more than four decades. Let us resolve to continue, to follow his footprints and the roadmap set by him for us, and make Mohyal Community the best Community in the World.

ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING 19 NOVEMBER 2023

Report by the Secretary Finance GMS

Accounts and Budget Proposals

GMS was founded at Lahore on 24 May 1891 by our illustrious forefathers amongst them was late Shri Ganesh Dutt, grand-father of Shri Vinod Kumar Dutt, President GMS and it has completed 132 years of its glorious existence and service to the community and humanity. It is a proud moment for all present in this august meeting. Thereafter, Shri Ashok Chhibber presented the audited accounts i.e. Income and Expenditure Statement and Balance Sheet for the Financial Year 2022-23, ended on 31.03.2023, copies of which were sent to all the members along with the notice of meeting and Budget proposals for the Financial Year 2023-24 sent by speed post on 13 Oct 2023.

Shri Ashok Chhibber stated that GMS is registered under the Indian Societies Act, 1860, and under Section 12AA of Income Tax Act, 1961 as "charitable" institution. Accordingly, regular books of accounts are being maintained as per the requirements of the legal provisions of the above noted two Acts and were audited by the Chartered Accountants M/s. H.S. Ahuja & Company who after thorough examination and scrutiny have certified as follows (though not sent along with agenda notice to keep low volume of agenda notice):

"We have examined the balance sheet of GENERAL MOHYAL SABHA (REGD) AAATG5350R [name and PAN of the trust or institution] as at 31.03.2023 and the Income and Expenditure account for the year ended on that date which are in agreement with the books of account maintained by the said trust or institution.

We have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of the audit. In our opinion, proper books of account have been kept by the head office and the branches of the above-named trust visited by us so far as appears from our examination of the books, and proper Returns adequate for the purposes of audit have been received from branches not visited by us subject to the comments given below.

In our opinion and to the best of our information, and according to explanations given to us, the said accounts give a true and fair view:-

- In case of the balance sheet of the state of affairs of the above-named trust as at 31.03.2023.
- In the case of the Income and Expenditure account, of the Income and Expenditure of its accounting year ending on 31.03.2023.

Explaining the salient features of the accounts, he submitted that main source of income is from rent which during the year 2022-23 was Rs 1,34,39,320/-. Income from general donations was Rs.2,34,44,829.95, in the year 2022-23. Income from bank deposits was Rs. 61,74,091/-, year 2022-23, which was low mainly on account of lowering of fixed deposit rates by the Banks. Similarly, subscription and membership fee was Rs 2,10,800/-. During the aforesaid year income from tuition fees/grant increased to Rs 93,45,202. Contribution from Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) was Rs 13,29,923. Affiliation Fee was Rs 30,000/-. The corpus fund of the trusts stood at Rs 9,69,49,000.97, as on 31.03.2023. Number of trusts, as on 31 March 2023, is as follows:

After giving analysis of the main sources of income, Shri Ashok Chhibber analyzed the salient features of expenditure during the year. Pension to widows was given to the tune of Rs. 81,04,500/- to 506 widows in the year 2022-23. Financial Relief and welfare to Needy and Destitutes was to the tune of Rs.18,42,500/- in the year 2022-23 to 109 beneficiaries. Financial aid for education was to the tune of Rs. 4,43,250/- in the year 2022-23 to 62 beneficiaries. Relief and welfare by way of free Langar at the Ashrams was to the tune of Rs. 57,89,045/- in the year 2022-23. Expenditure on staff welfare



stood at Rs. 1,21,584/- in the year 2022-23. Further an amount of Rs. 90,15,681/- was spent on account of establishment in the year 2022-23. A sum of Rs.37,67,662/- was spent on Building Repair and Maintenance in the year 2022-23 and Rs. 10,13,700/- was spent on property tax in the year 2022-23. A sum of Rs. 1,64,521/- was spent on insurance of buildings in the year 2022-23. A sum of Rs. 9,97,500/- was spent towards lease and ground rent of Mohyal Foundation building in the year 2022-23.

Coming to the budget proposals, Shri Ashok Chhibber submitted that a sum of Rs. 90,00,000/- has been earmarked for widows welfare; Rs. 22,00,000/- has been earmarked for relief fund. A sum of Rs.65,00,000/- for MERIT; a sum of Rs. 1,00,00,000/- for Ashram Fund at Haridwar; a sum of Rs. 60,00,000/- for Vrindavan Ashram; provisions of Rs. 7,00,000/ Yamuna Nagar Community Hall Fund. Similarly adequate funds have been provided under different heads in the detailed budget. The budget estimates for the Financial Year 2022-23 shows a surplus of Rs. 32,10,350.86 (Receipts Rs. 8,52,20,350.86 and expenditure Rs. 8,20,10,000/-).

In conclusion he reiterated that the accounts of the GMS are being maintained most meticulously both in traditional form by Double Entry Book Keeping as well as through computer and every paisa of money received and expenses incurred have been duly accounted for as per the statutory provisions and under the guidance of expert chartered accountants. He called upon the members to donate generously and augment the various funds of the Sabha by opening Trusts in the memory of their ancestors and dear and near ones. Only interest on trust money is used for activities of the GMS keeping the capital intact. He further added that these Trusts are a matter of sacred faith and all possible care has been taken to maintain these and carry out the wishes of the donors in letter and spirit. The way the Community has added to the number of Trusts and the Trust Money reflects the confidence of the Community in the working and credibility of the GMS under the visionary, dedicated and devoted leadership of our late illustrious President Mohyal Ratna Rzd B.D. Bali, which has been continued by Shri Vinod Kumar Dutt, President GMS

He further added that Trusts are being augmented and money added every day by more and more donors. Trust money is sacred, eternal and perpetual; the donations are put in fixed deposits and only interest accrued thereon is utilized for the purpose for which the Trust is created. He exhorted the Audience to be proud of the legacy of our illustrious and farsighted forefathers and count on their blessings and put concerted efforts to carry on the rich legacy for further generations to come.

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatri's, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams. There is no online booking at the Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after full payment of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran .
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation, only on written request by the senior citizens giving details of their permanent postal address and next of kin, alongwith their medical fitness certificate.

Prof Shyam Sunder Chibber (20 July 1932 – 16 October 2023)

Prof Shyam Sunder Chibber, 91 yrs, son of Bakshi Onkar Nath Chibber of Bhera, Punjab and Smt Vidya Wanti Chibber, was born on 20 July 1932 in New Delhi. He left for his heavenly abode at Gurgaon on 16 October 2023.



After completing his M.Sc in Organic Chemistry from University of Delhi in 1956, Prof. Chibber joined as Lecturer in Chemistry at Hansraj College, University of Delhi. Thereafter he went on a Fulbright scholarship to Cornell University, USA to

complete his Ph.D in Organic Chemistry, which he completed in 1962. On his return to India Prof Chibber was appointed as Lecturer in Department of Chemistry, University of Delhi. Subsequently he was appointed as Reader in Department of Chemistry in 1972, and was promoted as Professor in 1980. He was Head of the Chemistry Department during 1989-1992. Thereafter, he was appointed as the first Principal of Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences, New Delhi.

Prof Chibber was a great teacher and a thorough gentleman. He contributed to the academic development of the university. As Head of Department, he helped in the establishment of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Center for Biomedical Research in March 1991 and organised two major international conferences: "Current Trends in Chemical Research" and the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry Conference on Enzymes in Organic Synthesis.

He valued objectivity and cultivating a scientific temperament. Many remember him for his witty sense of humor. He had wide ranging interests including Urdu poetry and painting. The latter was a hobby that he pursued late in life and surprised others with his skill. He leaves behind his wife, Dr (Smt) Hirday Jyoti Chhibber, mob 9811047386, and sons Dr Sumeet Chhibber and Shri Sameer Chhibber.

एक्टर बनने का सपना ऐसे साकार हुआ—एक दिन अपने बड़े भाई सुभाष वैद के साथ मार्केट गया। रास्ते में मेरे भाई जिस मोटर स्पेयर्स के लिए काम करते थे, उस के मालिक चोपड़ा जी से परिचय करवाया। बातों बात में चोपड़ा जी ने मेरी प्रतिभा का अनुमान लगाने के बाद कहा आपके भाई के लिए लुधियाना नहीं मुंबई हैं। ऐसे में मेरा उत्साह बढ़ा और एक दिन लुधियाना से मुंबई के लिए तैयार होकर स्टेशन पर पहुँचा तो बड़ी संख्या में मोहल्ले के लोग जिनका मैं चहेता था बाबू एक्सप्रेस अब दादर एक्सप्रेस पर छोड़ने के लिए पहुँच गए। स्टेशन पर भीड़ को देखकर एएसएम से स्टेशन मास्टर ने पूछा? “भीड़ क्यों लगी है”, एएसएम ने बताया—एक लड़का फिल्म एक्टर बनने के लिए मुंबई जा रहा है। स्टेशन मास्टर पुरी ने मुझे देखा और गाड़ी को रुकवाकर अपने हाथ से एक पत्र लिख कर दिया और कहा मेरा भांजा फिल्म डारेक्टर हैं उसे यह पत्र दे देना। मैंने वह पत्र डारेक्टर मौला को दिया वह खुश हो गए कहा यह पत्र मेरे मामाजी का है उनकी मदद से एक फिल्म में रोल मिल गया। मुझे अविनाश जी की सिफारिश से फिल्म पत्रिका में काम करने का अवसर मिला तो मैंने पत्रकारिता करते हुए उस समय के नामीगिरामी फिल्म निर्माताओं और निर्देशकों से जान पहचान बढ़ाते हुए फिल्म जगत में मेरे लिए स्पेशल रोल लिखे जाने लगे। अब तक लगभग चार सौ फिल्मों में कमेडियन का रोल कर चुका हूँ।

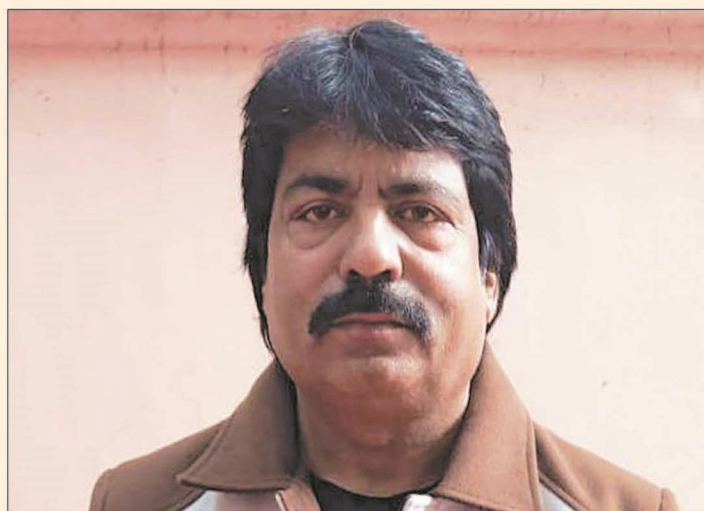
