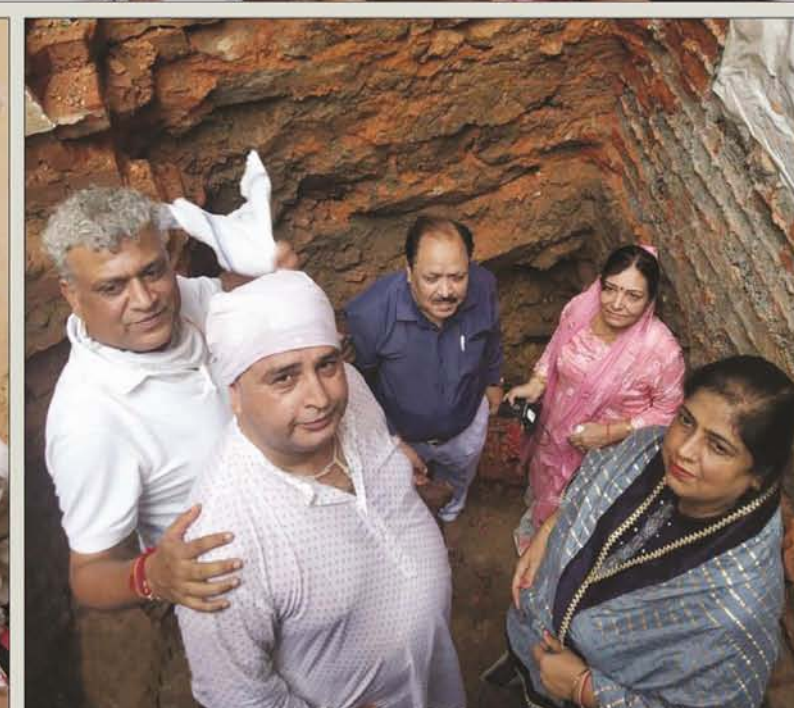



My dear Brothers and Sisters,
Jai Mohyal,

I am addressing you all, after nearly four months gap, to review and deliberate upon some important aspects, as are presently in focus for all of us.

It should be clear to us that the 'Pandemic', even after seven months of its onset in Mar 2020, is not 'going away' anywhere, any time soon. All the reliefs and relaxations permitted over the past few months by the Govt, had become unavoidable, in order to equally protect the 'Life' and 'Livelihood' of people. It, therefore, follows that in order to remain 'safe', while leading our 'near normal' lives we strictly adhere to the norms of 'hand wash, mask and social distancing', at all times.

As a 'community', our major and immediate areas of concern are two.

The 'first' relates to restarting as soon as possible our Ashrams, the Schools and the 'physical meetings at the local sabhas'. However, it appears that these would have to remain 'nonfunctional' for some more time, till conditions further improve, in due course.

The 'second' and the most important event awaiting to happen is the 'GMS Management Elections'. As you are aware, our elections are based on our EC despatching ballot papers to the 'Community Voters' and they returning them back to EC, after exercising their voting right. Both actions can only be done if the 'speed post' facility of the Postal Dept becomes dependably functional.

All of us have a very good reason to be very proud of the fact that our community is a generously 'sewabhav' oriented community. I say so, because a very large number of our brothers and sisters, happily and voluntarily, accept to take on all responsibilities, relating to the management of our institutions, which include GMS, local sabhas, the Ashrams, schools and so on, sparing their valuable time and giving the benefit of their expertise, without seeking or getting any thing, monetary or otherwise, in return. Additionally, as a matter of tradition, we, judiciously, avoid taking on board any high cost 'senior functionaries' from the market to support and manage any of our Institutions, including the GMS. We do so, based on our faith, belief and confidence that a good number of qualified, competent, dedicated and talented community members would come forward, get elected as part of the 'GMS Management' and would provide their expert services, together with their time and commitment, to serve their community. This would, then, enable us to optimally use our available monetary resources for the benefit of the needy within our community.

From the above, it should be fairly apparent as to what would be in the best interests of the community, in respect of both the kind of candidates who should offer their services and contest the elections and the kind, that the community should lend its support to.

Please remember you have an 'onerous and sacred' responsibility, in as much, that the kind of 'management' the community gets for the next five years, would solely and exclusively depend upon you, the community members. So 'do and decide' wisely, focussing on, and 'only on', the 'good of the community' and no other considerations, whatsoever.

We are on the threshold of the 'Festival Season', with the Dussehra on 25 Oct and Deepawali on 14 Nov. It is my pleasure to extend warm greetings and good wishes, on behalf of myself and the entire GMS Management, to all community members and their families.

OPEN FORUM

(a) GMS Managing Committee Elections Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM (Retd), apprised the members that the tenure of the present Managing Committee will be over in September 2020. Since the scenario prevailing at present for holding the elections does not seem to be conducive for various reasons, a legal opinion has been received which suggests that the Managing Committee and its office bearers can remain in office for additional period of 3 months. After deliberations the following resolution was passed.

“ Resolved that in conformance with the provisions of Article 13 (c) (iv) of the Constitution of General Mohyal Sabha (GMS) on the issue of Elections, and taking due cognizance of various factors of prohibitive nature forbidding holding of elections at present at least in the near future, consent be and is accorded to postpone the elections for a period of three months post 20 September 2020 ie until 19 Dec 2020 and to take an appropriate decision in this matter around the said times”

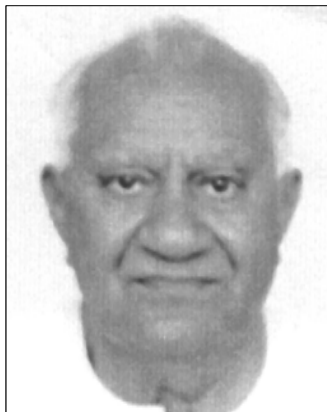

Hawan on eve of Guru Purnima at Parshuram temple

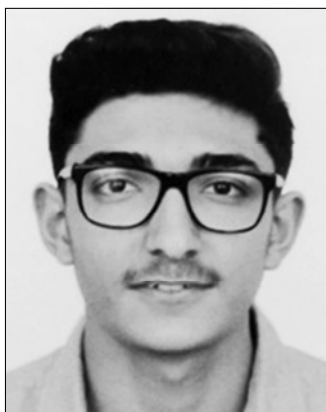

LIFE OF BHAI MATI DAS

Bhai Mati Das was a bastion of the Chhibbers (Mohyal Brahmins) and one of the greatest martyrs born in 1621 in Longowal in Nanka Village. They were five brothers namely- Bhai Sati Das, Bhai Dyal Das, Bhai Jati Das and Bhai Bal Mukund who were sons of Bhai Hira Nand and lived in the Jhelum District of Punjab. The reason behind him being called as 'Bhai' was that Guru Arjun Dev Ji, the 5th Guru of Sikhs was pleased with his services, who later on motivated him into the Sikh faith. His grandfather Baba Praga who had been given the command of the armed forces of Sikhs (Jatha) in the war against the Mughals by Guru Hargobind- the 6th Guru, was even titled as the Bhishma of the Mohyal Community. After Baba Praga's death, Bhai Hira Nand presented himself in the services of Guru Har Rai- the 7th Guru after whose death both Bhai Mati Das and Sati Das in accordance to the commands which Bhai Hira Nand had conferred on them of serving the Gurus and then they started following the Guru's directions. Both the brothers had presented themselves to the Guru Tegh Bahadur- the 9th Guru of Sikhs, on his manifestation.

After passage of sometime in 1674 AD, Aurangzeb- the ruler of the Mughals at that time had ordered Hindus to convert to Islam by force from the Kashmir side to take control over the entire nation. The prominent Brahmins of Kashmir appeared before the Guru and explained him (Guru) about their helplessness. The Guru on knowing the hardships of the people had ordered the Kashmiri Brahmins to convey Guruji's message to Aurangzeb that Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji was their leader, if Aurangzeb could get the guru converted into Islam then they shall become the Muslims of their own accord. After being informed by Guru's disciples, Aurangzeb ordered the arrest of the Guru, where both Bhai Mati Das and Sati Das came forward to get themselves arrested. Further Aurangzeb offered Guru to embrace Islam to which Guruji refused. In order to intimidate them, Aurangzeb had decided torturing the Sikhs.

Bhai Mati Das was the first in the list of the qazis (Islamic magistrates) whom they had planned to cut him through a saw. Hearing the order of the qazis, Bhai Mati Das sought Blessings from Guru Ji to absorb the atrocity of the qazis. He was even told by qazis "if you die as a Muslim, you will go to heaven, where there will be streams of milk, wines to drink and beautiful women to enjoy. If you don't embrace Islam, you will be cut into two pieces". At this Bhai Mati Das replied "I find happiness in the path of my faith and I can sacrifice thousands of such heavens for my faith. Allow me a last wish that my face be towards my Guruji so that I may contemplate about my Guruji till my last breath and Guruji may keep on seeing me so that he may be convinced how happily I reach my last destination." The executioners sawed Bhai Mati Das by keeping him bolted with two planks and bifurcated into twain from top to trunk on 9th November 1675 AD in Chandni Chowk, Delhi. It is because of his fearlessness to sacrifice for his community, he has been considered as one of the greatest martyrs.

The place where he has sacrificed his life has been named as Bhai Mati Das Chowk (Fountain) in Chandni Chowk,

Delhi. His loyalty towards his Guru, his affection to the entire Sikh community and his courage to resist the hegemony of the Muslims is still remembered not only by the Mohyal Community but also the people of the entire country.

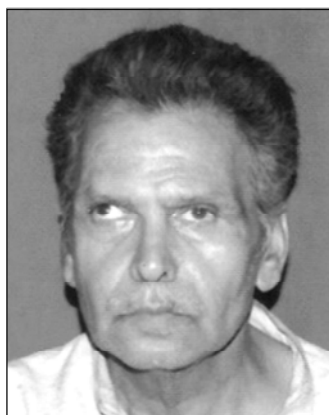

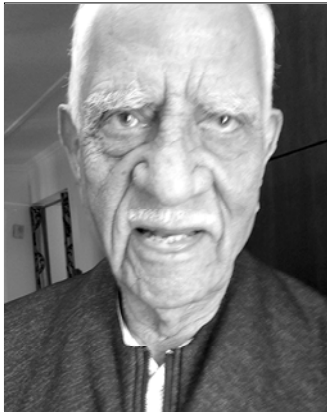

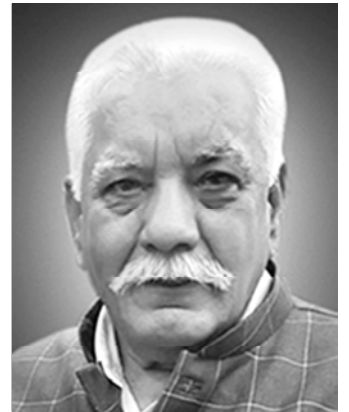

Shri Pramod Bakshi (Vaid)

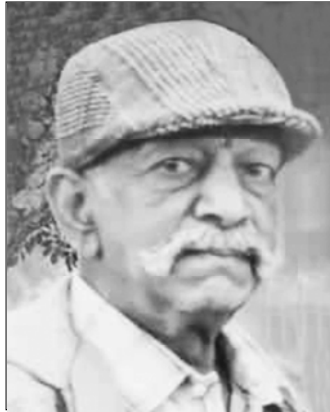

MEMORIES OF LOCKDOWN

We at Jalandhar Mohyal Sabha were in a very jovial mood on 11 March 2020 when foundation stone of our dream Mohyal Bhawan was laid. This day was of festivities in the history of our Sabha where large number of Mohyals gathered. Construction of bhawan started a week after that.

In the mean time Corona Virus started spreading its wings in our country and as a preventive measure Govt of India proclaimed Lockdown from 24/25th of March. It was a right step for the health of Nation. Railways, Airways, Road Transport, Trade Industry, Schools, Colleges, Malls, Shopping Complexes, Marriage, Resorts and every thing came to a standstill and Migrant Labour started feeling the pinch. कोराना : सावधानी और सतर्कता ही उपाय

कोराना वायरिस ने पूरे विश्व को दशकों पीछे धकेल दिया है। इन दिनों घरों में बंद रहने में ही सुरक्षा है। मास्क पहनकर निकलने, सोशल डिस्टेंसिंग रखने, बार-बार साबुन से हाथ धोने, सैनेटाइजर का प्रयोग करने में ही समझदारी है अन्यथा कोराना आक्रमण करने को तैयार बैठा है। कौन कब कैसे इससे संक्रमित हो जाएगा, कोई नहीं कह सकता। आज पूरा विश्व को घुटनों पर लाने का यह षडयंत्र हज़ारों-लाखों निर्दोश लोगों को मृत्यु के मुख में पहुँचा चुका है। यह सिलसिला कब तक चलेगा, कोई नहीं कह सकता।

हमने अपने जीवन में ऐसी स्थिति की कल्पना भी नहीं की थी। कि हज़ारों-हज़ार लोग सड़कों पर पैदल चलकर, भूखे-प्यासे अपने-अपने गाँवों-नगरों की ओर जा रहे थे। महीनों तक रेलगाड़ियों बंद रहीं, बसें रुक गईं, राज्यों की सीमाएँ बंद कर दी गईं। स्कूल-कॉलेज बंद हो गए, सिनेमा हॉल, मॉल, होटल बंद हो गए, दफ़तर बंद हो गए। सब कुछ अद्भुत था।

धीरे-धीरे हम कोराना के साथ जीने के अभ्यस्त हो रहे हैं। मृत्यु का भय तो है, पर अब हमने इसे स्वीकार कर लिया है। यह समय सतर्क रहने का है। खरगोश की तरह छलांगें लगाने का नहीं अपितु कुछए की भाँति अपनी रक्षा करने का है। आज की स्थिति के लिए कछुए का उदाहरण बहुत उपयुक्त है। जब कछुए पर संकट आता है तो वह अपने सभी अंगों को अपने 'कवच' में समेट लेता है। उसका कवच (खोल) इतना कठोर होता है कि उस पर चोटों का प्रभाव नहीं पड़ता श्रीमद्भगवद्गीता में भी कहा गया है—

एदा संहरते चायं कूर्मोअंगानीव सर्वशः।
इंद्रयाणी द्वियार्थेभ्यस्तस्य प्रज्ञा प्रतिष्ठिता॥
(अध्याय-2, श्लोक-58)

—जिस तरह से कछुआ आकर्षित करने वाली वस्तुओं से अपने अंगों को कवच (खोल) में समेट लेता है, उसी प्रकार स्थिर बुद्धि वाले व्यक्ति अपनी इंद्रियों को आकर्षित करने वाली वस्तुओं से हटा लेते हैं।

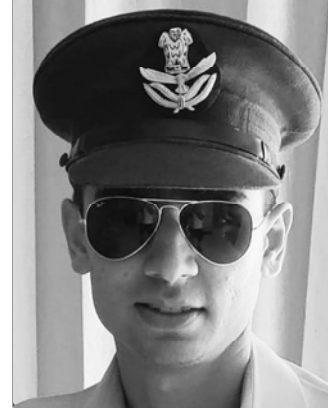

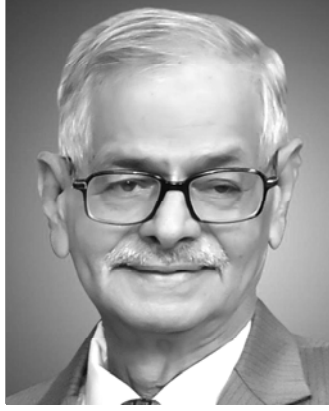
