

It is with great grief and profound sorrow, we learnt about the sad demise of, Rzd J.C. Bali, former member of GMS Managing Committee, who left for his heavenly abode on 18 October 2022, due to cardiac arrest, leaving us all in shock and tears. His last rites were performed at Lodhi crematorium, New Delhi on 19 October 2022, which was attended by large number of members of the Community.

Rzd J.C. Bali, son of late Shri Moti Ram Bali and late Smt Nanki Devi Bali, was born on 7 Aug 1938 at Rawalpindi. He married Smt Manorama Bali, on 10 Dec 1969 and was blessed with a daughter and son Shri Nitin Bali, daughter-in-law Smt Bhavana Bali and grandson Yodhin Bali.

He was a thorough Gentleman, a caring person, always ready to help the members of the community and made it a point to keep in touch with them. He inculcated good value systems in his family. He is greatly respected by the Mohyal community, for being a straight forward person and a very good human being. He will always be missed, and remembered fondly with great reverence and respect.

Rzd J.C. Bali, was a social person and a very active member of GMS for nearly four decades. He was Sarprast Trustees of GMS. He was honoured by GMS with the award of Mohyal Gaurav in 2012, Lifetime Achievement Award during 125th Sthapna Divas held on 12 March 2017, and recently with 'Pride of Community Award' during Annual General Body Meeting on 19 Dec 2021, for his selfless contribution and dedicated services to the Community. He had donated towards a room at Mohyal Ashram Vrindavan and Langer funds for Mohyal Ashrams at Haridwar and Vrindavan. His wife, Smt. Manorama Bali has donated Rs 1,35000/- to GMS, in fond memory of Rzd J.C. Bali Ji.

MOHYAL ASHRAMS HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatris, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran.
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Online booking facility for rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar is not available. Rooms can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation.




