1. The counselling session for IGNOU's BCA, MCA, MCA (New), PGDCA (New), PGDCA, CCITSK, CIT, PGDAST, and PGCGI programmes for the July-December 2024 session commenced on 14th September 2024. Approximately 3,000 students have been allotted to our Center for various programmes by IGNOU.
2. The results for the COPA (Computer Operator & Programming Assistant) and Database Trades (session 2023-24) have been declared. Students from both trades have achieved over 90%, with one student securing 91% marks in the DBSA Trade.

Shri Chander Mohan Vaid (12 May 1949 – 8 Sep 2024)

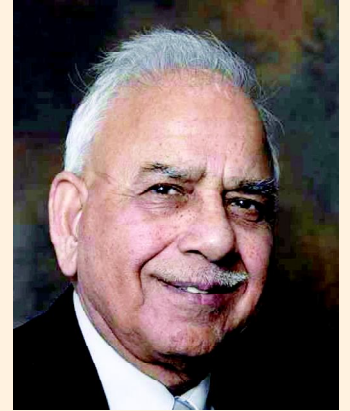

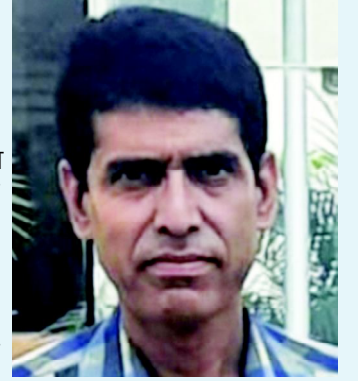

मोहयाल गाँव द्राबा का इतिहास

द्राबा की घाटी पीर पंचाल पहाड़ियों की गोद में स्थित है और अपनी समृद्ध परंपराओं और संस्कृति के लिए अत्यधिक जानी जाती है। आसपास की पहाड़ियों के आसपास एक बहुत ही खूबसूरत जगह। यह पुँछ शहर से 35 किमी दूर है और अब मुगल रोड के माध्यम से श्रीनगर तक 5 घंटे की यात्रा है। विभाजन से पहले आगंतुक, संत और यात्री पीर पंचाल दर्रे के माध्यम से बाबा अमरनाथ जी की पवित्र गुफा के दर्शन को जाने के लिए मार्ग में द्राबा में रुकते थे। यहाँ बाबा बिंदराबन जी महाराज जी के सिद्ध महा योगी हुए, उनके आश्रम में ठहरते थे, यहाँ तक कि छठे सिख गुरु, गुरु हरगोविंद सिंह जी महाराज द्राबा में रुके और इसी मार्ग से कश्मीर गए और रैनावारी कश्मीर में गुरुद्वारा छटी बादशाही का निर्माण किया। द्राबा के दत्त-संयोग से पंजाब के कंजरूड दत्तान, तहसील शकर गढ़, पंजाब के मेहता केसर मल जी के दो भाई कुछ परिस्थितियों में (लगभग 1820 ईसा पूर्व) कंजरूड छोड़कर राजौरी पहुँचे और वहाँ रहने लगे। यह जानकारी मिलने पर मेहता देव चंद जी लो थाना मंडी (राजौरी) पहुँचे और दो भाइयों में से एक मेहता पृथ्वी राम जी दत्त को द्राबा ले आए और बाद में उनकी बेटी के साथ बक्शी पृथ्वी राम जी दत्त का विवाह संपन्न हुआ। द्राबा दत्त परिवार बक्शी पृथ्वी राम जी दत्त के चार पुत्रों का वंशज है, जो पूरी घाटी में बहुत प्रसिद्ध, बहादुर और प्रभावशाली व्यक्ति थे। वे जमींदार थे, वह बहुत बड़ी जमीनों के मालिक थे, उनकी बुद्धिमत्ता के कारण उन्हें आसपास के सभी क्षेत्रों में बहुत सम्मानजनक लोकप्रियता मिली। बक्शी लाल मुन और बक्शी गंगाराम को पुँछ दरबार में राजा मोती सिंह जी, राजा सुख देव सिंह जी और राजा बलदेव सिंह जी द्वारा सम्मानित किया गया था। अन्य मोहियालों के साथ दत्तों के संबंध-द्राबा के दत्त वहाँ पर बाली, छिब्वर, वैद परिवारों को लाए और वह भी द्राबा में बस गए। द्राबा एक मोहयाली फूलों का बगीचा है। हाल के समय में बक्शी ईशर दास जी दत्त, बक्शी विशंवर दास जी दत्त एक कवि और प्रसिद्ध नेता, बक्शी शंभू नाथ जी दत्त नंबरदार, मास्टर मोती राम जी दत्त एक प्रसिद्ध ज्योतिषी और उन्होंने मोहयाल सभा द्राबा का गठन किया और वो जनरल मोहयाल सभा दिल्ली से भी जुड़े रहे, बक्शी टेक राम जी दत्त एक प्रसिद्ध राजनीतिक और सामाजिक लोकप्रिय नेता, बक्शी योग राज जी छिब्वर (पंडित जी), उनका द्राबा मंदिर में बहुत बड़ा योगदान रहा और वह धार्मिक कार्यक्रमों में बहुत रुचि रखते थे, बक्शी शाम लाल जी वैद, बक्शी मदन लाल जी वैद, रायजादा जय राम जी बाली, बक्शी बालम कंध जी दत्ता, बक्शी राम चांद जी दत्ता सभी क्षेत्र के अत्यंत लोकप्रिय व्यक्तित्व थे। अब भी द्राबा के मोहयाल जीवन के सभी क्षेत्रों में प्रसिद्ध हैं। वे डॉक्टर, इंजीनियर प्रोफेसर और सशस्त्र बलों में उच्च शिक्षित हैं। उनमें से अधिकांश सरकारी सेवाओं, व्यापार और व्यापारियों में द्राबा के मोहयाल हैं। कवि बक्शी विशंवर दास जी दत्त, बक्शी बलदेव राज जी वैद रहबर, डॉक्टर शिव रत्तन लाल जी वैद बर्क पुँछी और बक्शी अविनाशी लाल जी दत्ता शिक्षाविद् लेखक और कवि उल्लेखनीय हैं। कुछ युवा इंजीनियर और डॉक्टर मोहयाल युवा कनाडा और ऑस्ट्रेलिया में भी बसे हुए हैं। 1952-1953 में दिल्ली से कंजरूड के चौधरी चुन्नी लाल जी दत्त द्वारा संपादित मोहयाल इतिहास में द्राबा के बारे में एक लेख का भी उल्लेख किया गया है- बक्शी पुनीत कुमार दत्ता एई, द्राबा, जम्मू-कश्मीर

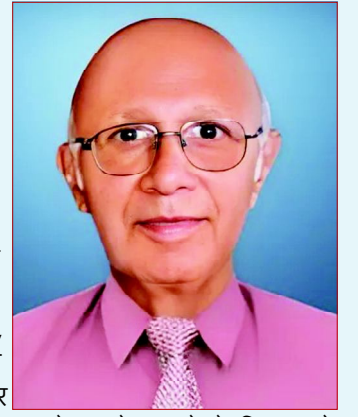

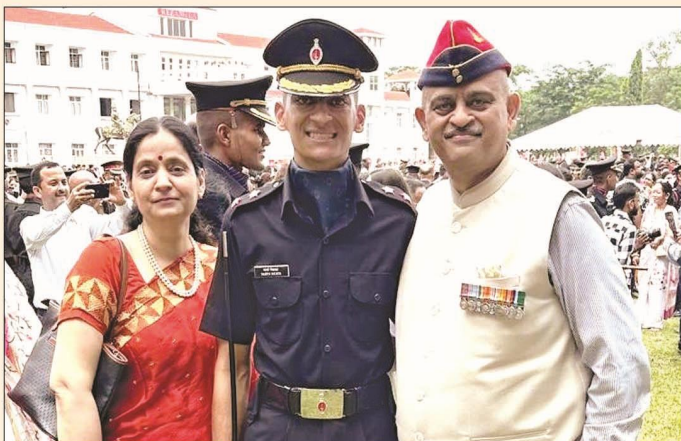
