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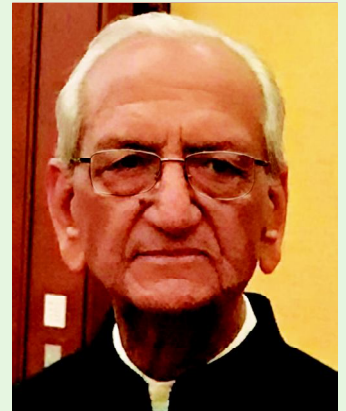

For a long time, it was desired within Mohyal Youth, especially of Delhi NCR, that they would like to meet and connect, especially since the successful conduct of the Cricket tournament held under GMS at Yamuna Nagar. 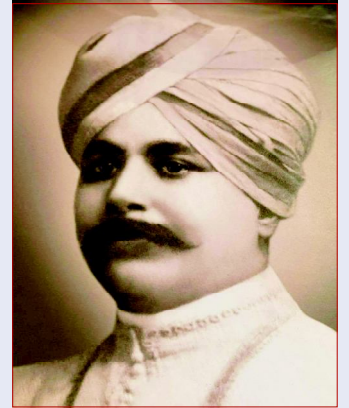

Hero of Sacrifice: Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt A Revolutionary Spirit Who Defied All Odds

Early Life and Childhood: Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt was born in the village of Veeram Dutta, Shakar Garh district, Gurdaspur (then in pre-partition Pakistan). He belonged to the proud Mohyal community and was a staunch Mohyal throughout his life. His sense of identity was deeply tied to his heritage, and all his siblings were married within Mohyal families, reflecting his strong belief in preserving community traditions. Growing up in a land that was simmering with unrest under British rule, he imbibed values of courage, sacrifice, and service from a very young age. His early years were marked by simplicity, but his heart burned with the desire to see his people free. Even as a youth, Dutt became actively involved in the freedom struggle of India. His boldness and clarity of purpose distinguished him from his peers. He was drawn towards radical thought and action at a time when the call for independence was echoing in every corner of the Nation.



The Revolutionary Journey and Gadar Party: In his formative years, Ram Singh Dutt joined the legendary Gadar Party, an organization of expatriate Indians who had sworn to fight British imperialism with revolutionary zeal. Through the Gadar movement, he connected with some of the most fearless freedom fighters of his era, gaining inspiration and comradeship that would guide his life's mission. Dutt was also a founding member of the Communist Party of India, where he worked to combine the principles of social justice with the struggle for independence. His belief was firm: political freedom would only be meaningful if accompanied by the upliftment of workers, peasants, and the poor. Carrying these convictions, Dutt's revolutionary spirit took him beyond India's borders. He traveled to Russia at a time when the echoes of revolution were reshaping the world. Inspired by global movements, he strengthened his belief that India's freedom was not just a dream but an achievable goal. Yet his return journey to India was filled with hardship. From Russia, as he tried to come back, almost every Arabian country denied him entry and deported him. His exile became his badge of honor, proof that his ideas and presence were feared across nations.

Prison Walls and Death Sentences: Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt endured 14 years of imprisonment and internment, passing through harsh jails where chains, torture, and humiliation were part of daily life. He faced the death sentence twice, ordered to be hanged by colonial authorities. In Afghanistan, his fate was even harsher — he was condemned to be executed by Sangsard, the brutal punishment of stoning. Yet destiny favored his courage. Each time he escaped death, his resolve grew stronger. Behind prison walls, he emerged not broken but hardened — a symbol of defiance. His endurance echoed the struggles of thousands of nameless patriots whose sacrifices lit the torch of freedom.

Service After Partition: After India achieved independence and Partition divided his homeland, Dutt returned not to rest but to serve. He devoted his life to the upliftment of the poor and downtrodden in the region of Gurdaspur. At a time when countless families were uprooted and scattered, he worked tirelessly to heal wounds, provide relief, and rebuild communities. Such was his impact that after his passing, almost every household in Gurdaspur kept his photograph as a mark of love and respect. To them, he was not just a leader but a protector, a friend, and a family member who stood by them in their darkest hours.

Family Legacy of Service: Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt's spirit of patriotism and dedication to public service did not end with him. His family continues to uphold his values across generations. His son, Arjun Dutta, rose to the rank of Brigadier in the Indian Army, carrying forward the martial tradition with pride. Two of his grandsons are serving as Colonels in the India Army, continuing the family's distinguished record in uniform. Another son, Rabinder Dutta, served the nation in a different sphere, retiring as a Public Relations Officer from a government department. The family's contributions extend beyond India as well. His grandson Rishi Dutta has earned distinction as a bureaucrat in Australia, while another grandson, Swami Dutta, has established himself as a successful entrepreneur, running his own construction company in Australia. This living legacy of service in the Army, government, and global leadership reflects the enduring influence of Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt's values and sacrifices.

A Living Memorial: Recognizing his invaluable contributions, the Punjab Government established a memorial in District Gurdaspur, named the Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt Memorial. This monument stands as a reminder of his sacrifices, ensuring that future generations learn of the man who dared to dream of justice and stood unflinching in the face of persecution.

Legacy of an Unsung Hero: Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt's life embodies the spirit of India's unsung revolutionaries — men and women who were not always written in text books but whose sacrifices built the foundations of freedom. His story is not just history; it is a reminder that true courage lies not in survival but in sacrifice. Even today, his memory lives on in the hearts of people of Punjab, in the walls of his memorial, and in the stories passed down from generation to generation. His endurance of torture, exile, and repeated death sentences stands as proof that the struggle for justice requires unbending will.

"He suffered chains, exile, and near death not once but many times, yet he never bent his head.
Chaudhary Ram Singh Dutt's name will forever shine among the bravest sons of India."

5th Executive Committee Meeting was held on 27 July 2025.

President checked the attendance roll and since the quorum of EC was not complete deferred the meeting by 30 minutes in

conformity with provisions contained in Constitution of the Sabha.

Meeting recommenced at 11.30 am and since there is no requirement of the quorum President, MS Jammu & Kashmir accorded permission for proceedings to commence as per agenda circulated in advance.

President, Shri Anil Deep Mehta, putting the house in order requested all present to put their mobiles on the silent mode. Extending a warm welcome to all members with the slogan "Jai Mohyal" he expressed concern over the absence of some members despite the meeting notice being circulated seven days in advance. He emphasized the importance of punctuality and active participation and urged the members to realize roles and responsibilities of the office and larger service towards community's affairs. House unanimously agreed that the matter of continuous absence of EC members shall be forwarded to disciplinary committee for further appropriate decision as per the provisions of the Constitution.

President informed the members about tour of Nowshera undertaken by the members of MS Jammu & Kashmir and recorded appreciated mobilization support extended by Shri N.K. Bali, Shri Vishal Bakshi and Shri Pranav Dutta for making the event a great success. He also put on record appreciable strength and participation shown by local Mohyal members and the enthusiasm shown towards welfare of the baradari. President also appreciated the secretariat of the Sabha for undertaking preparations of forthcoming and AGM in a scientific and realistic manner by constituting several sub-committees and defining distinct roles and responsibilities to each sub-committee. It was decided to take periodic review of the preparations i.e. in the month of August on fortnightly basis and in the month of September on weekly basis.

Item No. 1

Approval of Minutes of 4th EC Meeting: General Secretary read out the minutes of 4th Executive Committee (EC) meeting and asked members to deliberate the changes required, if any. Members unanimously approved of the minutes.

President accords approval for adoption and taking the minutes on record.

Item No. 2

Financial Position – Report by Joint Treasurer: In the absence of Treasurer Shri Nandeep Bakshi, Shri Vijay Bakshi presented the financial position of the Sabha inter-alia including estimated budget for the upcoming AGM and Mohyal Mela. Members deliberated on all items of expenditure and income and decided that 10% contingency provision should also be incorporated to offset price rise etc.

The members then approved the following estimates present by treasury:

- Estimated Expenditure: Rs 5.81 lakh
- Estimated Income: Rs 8.40 lakh

The President put the suggestion that an imprest amount of Rs 50,000/- should be maintained by the Sabha Treasury as liquid funds to meet day to day emergent expenses up to culmination of both the events. In routine an imprest of Rs 10,000/- will be maintained. This proposal was also unanimously accepted by the house.

Presentation of Monthly Accounts and Patnitop picnic receipts / payments account: One of the members present Shri Rajinder Vaid stressed that financial receipt/ collection and payments account pertaining to picnic arranged at Patnitop should be briefed and taken on record as a matter of transparency. Shri Vijay Bakshi placed the following before the house:

- Collection from participants : Rs 94,000/-
- Total Payments : Rs 95,500/-
- Deficit : Rs 1500/-

While approving the receipt and expenditure incurred on arranging the picnic members approved the stand-alone account and approved that deficit/ shortfall may be met by the Sabha.

Financial Position: Members stressed maintaining the books of accounts regularly to have transparency. It was also advised that the financial statements for financial year 2024-25 be got audited by a Chartered Accountant before the AGM scheduled for 31 Aug 2025.

Item No.3

Review of the progress against the roadmap: Members were desirous to know about the progress achieved towards finalizing the blueprint and assessment of cost towards the property of the Sabha in terms of promises made by the committee concerned in previous EC meetings. Since the designated head of the committee Shri Arun Chhibber was not present General Secretary informed the house that an architect has visited the Sabha recently and taken the stock of proposed plan, undertaken the measurement of the space. The blueprint and estimates of cost are expected to be submitted within a period of 10 days.

Members desired that the committee should expedite the process and complete the assignment at the earliest as it must be recommended to the EC for adoption before taking it to the AGM for formal approval.

Item No. 4

Assessment of preparations of AGM and Mohyal Milan (Mela): Though most of the members of EC are members of the sub-committees also formed for the purpose of undertaking seamless preparations for forthcoming AGM and Mohyal Mela, yet Gen Secretary held it imperative to inform the house that preparations are going ahead as per laid down plan and role / duties allocated to different sub-committees. Last review of the preparation was taken on 21 July 2025 at the office of the Sabha and next to that series will be held on 3 Aug 2025 immediately after the monthly meeting of the baradari.

Detailed discussions were then held on organizing the upcoming events in a cost-effective and professional manner. The committee decided:

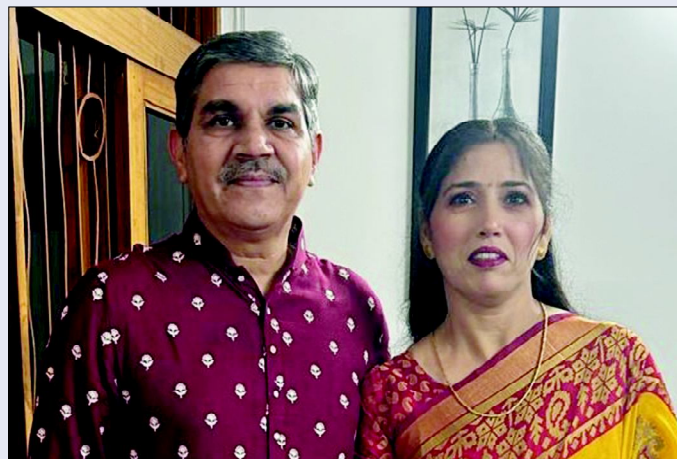

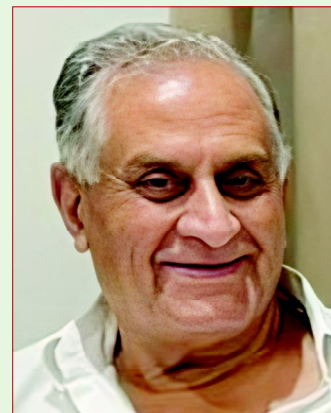

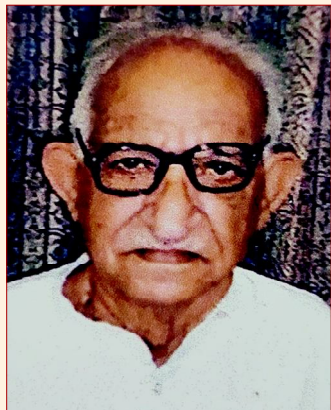

Smt Jyoti Vaid (25 July 1964–30 Aug 2025)

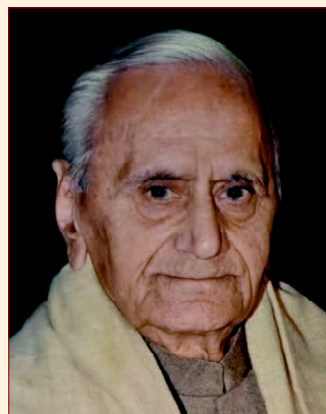

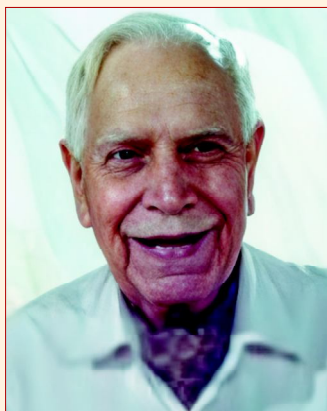
